Congresswoman Shirley Chisholm

Congressman Chalmers Wylie (R-Ohio) believes that Representative Shirley Chisholm might endorse President Nixon.

Chalmers advises that in several conversations with Mrs. Chisholm, including lunch, she expressed a strong dislike for McGovern and the way his people treated her at Miami.

She also commented, according to Chalmers, that she might possibly endorse the President as he was doing well in a difficult task.

Congressman Wylie doesn't have a specific recommendation for pursuing this possibility, but wanted the White House to know the opportunity exists.
