Dear Mr. Hart:

As his second term gets underway, the President has asked me to renew his offer of the facilities of the Western White House for the use of government and certain other groups. While the area offers generally pleasant weather in a secluded, informal setting, the 10 fully-equipped offices, conference room, private beach and bath house, helipad, and excellent communications system provide ideal conference accommodations for up to 40 persons. (The attached booklet will give you a clearer picture of the complex and its geographical location on the southern California coast.) Of course, the costs of all transportation to and from the Western White House, housing in any of several nearby motels, and whatever catering services are required must be borne by the sponsoring organizations.

Requests for use of the Western White House should be submitted to the Office of the Military Assistant to the President at least three weeks in advance of desired dates of occupancy. When this is done we will make every effort to determine the President's travel plans, and respond to you within a 7-day period. Advice and assistance in logistical planning will be provided when needed.
