The 1983 International Summer Special Olympics Games will be held on the campus of Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge July 12-18, 1983. This video tape will be a 30-second public service announcement distributed to television stations in Louisiana to air at a later date.

More than 4,000 mentally handicapped athletes from all 50 states, 40 foreign countries, and 4 U.S. territories, are expected to compete in 13 official athletic events.

The purpose of the Special Olympics is to promote the social and psychological development, as well as the physical fitness, of the mentally handicapped. The program insures that each athlete is a winner.

Governor David Treen is up for reelection in 1983. He faces a strong opponent in former Governor Earl Edwards. Throughout the last two years Treen has not waived in his support for you and your policies.

Governor Treen has requested this opportunity to meet with you to raise some issues of concern. He may mention the 1983 New Orleans World's Fair which is progressing on schedule and has been supported by the Administration. In addition, he may mention Louisiana's request for federal help in purchasing property in the Achafalaya swamp, an issue important to local environmentalists. Secretary Watt has shown interest. OMB has indicated some preliminary opposition.
