I. PURPOSE

To receive the 36th presentation of a Thanksgiving turkey to the nation's first family from the National Turkey Federation.

II. BACKGROUND

The National Turkey Federation is the only national trade association representing the turkey industry in the United States. Members of NTF produce and market 96% of the nation's turkey crop.

NTF has presented a Thanksgiving turkey to the nation's first family every year for the past 35 years in commemoration of the Thanksgiving season. Over the years, these presentations have drawn national attention by focusing on our rich heritage and the many blessings and opportunities we have in our great country.

NTF has been supportive of your economic recovery programs and the Administration in general.

Mr. Morgan will make an informal presentation and you converse while the press corps takes photographs.

2:40 p.m. You thank Mr. Morgan and the other guests and return to the Oval Office.

BACKGROUND/SUGGESTED TALKING POINTS FOR
MEETING WITH NATIONAL TURKEY FEDERATION REPRESENTATIVES

Note: Since no remarks are required, what is provided as background information is for your personal information only.

- Mr. Mervin Amerine is formerly of the Amerine Turkey Breeding Farms which were located in Oakdale, California. During your campaign for Governor of California, Mr. Amerine provided his company's DC-3 airplane for your use. This DC-3 was informally known as the "Turkey Bird." On several occasions during your gubernatorial campaign, Mr. Amerine's wife, Nancy Amerine, served as a stewardess on the "Turkey Bird" and remembers those occasions very well.
- You addressed the National Turkey Federation convention in San Diego, California in 1979 (Town and Country Hotel).
- The live turkey will weigh approximately 50 pounds. The two dressed turkeys which will be on the table will weigh approximately 30 pounds each. The dressed turkeys will be in plastic wrap with the message "Happy Holidays, Mr. President" attached to this wrapping.
