SATURDAY, MARCH 15, 1986

- I certainly thank you for your strong demonstration of support for democracy in Nicaragua and a secure America. Mi amigos. Gracias.
- I understand your main speaker today is a young refugee from the Communist repression in Nicaragua. What is at stake is not only her future, but the future of young people throughout this Hemisphere. We can't let Communists steal their freedom away.
- You, more than many others, have a keen understanding of the dangers we face. I appreciate your commitment to spread the word about the dangers of communism in Latin America. We cannot afford to see a repeat of the disaster which has struck the people of Cuba. We can't permit another Cuba, this time in the heart of Central America.
- The democratic resistance in Nicaragua must not be abandoned. We have a moral obligation to do what we can to support their cause. What they fought for is freedom. That is what America is all about.

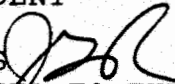
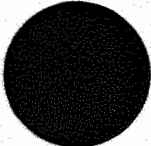
- They don't stand a chance on the battlefield if we don't win our battle in the halls of Congress. That's why your help is crucial.

RECOMMENDED TELEPHONE CALL

TO: Thomas Regulato, President of WQBX Radio, Miami, Mayor Xavier Suarez, and attendees of a Pro-Contra rally.

DATE: Saturday, March 15, 1986, at approximately 2:45 p.m.

RECOMMENDED BY: Pat Buchanan *PJB*

PURPOSE: To promote the President's request for aid to Nicaraguan Contras.

BACKGROUND: On Saturday, March 15, 1986, Thomas Regulato, Director of Miami radio station WQBX, Mayor Xavier Suarez of Miami, and the UNO leadership will lead a march and rally in support of the President's Contra Aid package from Bay Front Park to the Federal Building in downtown Miami, Florida. A crowd of 10,000 is expected.

The featured speaker of the rally at the Federal building will be a 17-year-old Nicaraguan refugee girl, with no Samoza or Sandinista background. She has been selected by organizers of the rally to represent the future of the Nicaraguan people. She speaks fluent English and Spanish.

Arrangements for the President's call to be broadcast to the crowd and on air can be made by the WQBA radio.

DISCUSSION TOPIC: -- The President's earnest desire for the people of Nicaragua to live in peace and in a democracy;

-- No Second Cuba;

-- The U.S. has provided aid, the U.S. has urged negotiations; it is clear that only pressure, and our military assistance to the Contras will bring about a negotiations for peace.

(Speechwriters will provide talking points.)
