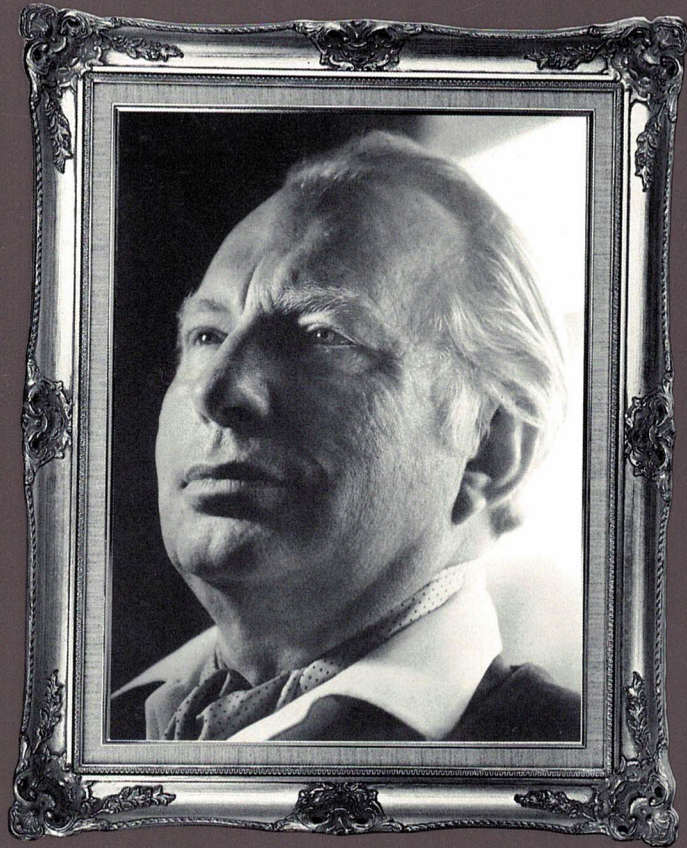

Introduction

Few men alive today have as many brilliant achievements—or as many friends—as L. Ron Hubbard—author, musician, philosopher, research pioneer, educator, photographer, cinematographer, navigator, explorer and humanitarian.

“To really know life, you’ve got to be part of life,” Mr. Hubbard has said. “You must get down and look; you must get into the nooks and crannies of existence; you have to rub elbows with all kinds and types of men before you can finally establish what he is.” More than any other modern philosopher, Mr. Hubbard has befriended and contributed to people of all persuasions and professions, and has himself lived a life of stirring adventure and stellar accomplishment unequaled in the world today.

A recent computer print-out listing some of Mr. Hubbard’s works is more than 1050 pages long, single spaced. His creative works included films, photographs, choreography, slide shows, music, etc., as well as articles and books. For his musical creations alone, he has received more than 75 awards. His weekly fan mail from friends, admirers and people he has helped through his books and philosophy averages 2400 letters—much more than that of the Queen of England and Pope John Paul combined. Mr. Hubbard’s technologies are used by more than 3200 educational, business, social reform, drug abuse and other organizations, from Alaska to Zaire.

Some of the subjects covered by L. Ron Hubbard’s technical, philosophical, instructional and self-help works are: human behavior, morality, education, drug abuse, health, musicology, photography, cinematography, art, design, aesthetics, horticulture, management, labor, marketing, public relations, metaphysics, logic, communication, leadership, interpersonal relations, counseling, navigation, exploration, aviation, engineering, writing, economics, history, data analysis, electronics and computers. In each of these areas, Mr. Hubbard has made outstanding technical breakthroughs and pioneering discoveries acclaimed by civic leaders, professionals and citizens the world over.

L. Ron Hubbard was born in Tilden, Nebraska on March 13, 1911. In 1984, acknowledging him for his 73rd birthday and his more than 50 years as a writer, Governor George Ariyoshi of Hawaii wrote, “You have lived a rich life in many fields, and in turn have enriched the lives of many thousands of others through these efforts and by the personal examples you have offered.

“At one time, in reflecting on your philosophies, you said that ‘wisdom is meant for anyone who wishes to reach for it. It is the servant of the commoner and king alike and should never be regarded with awe.’

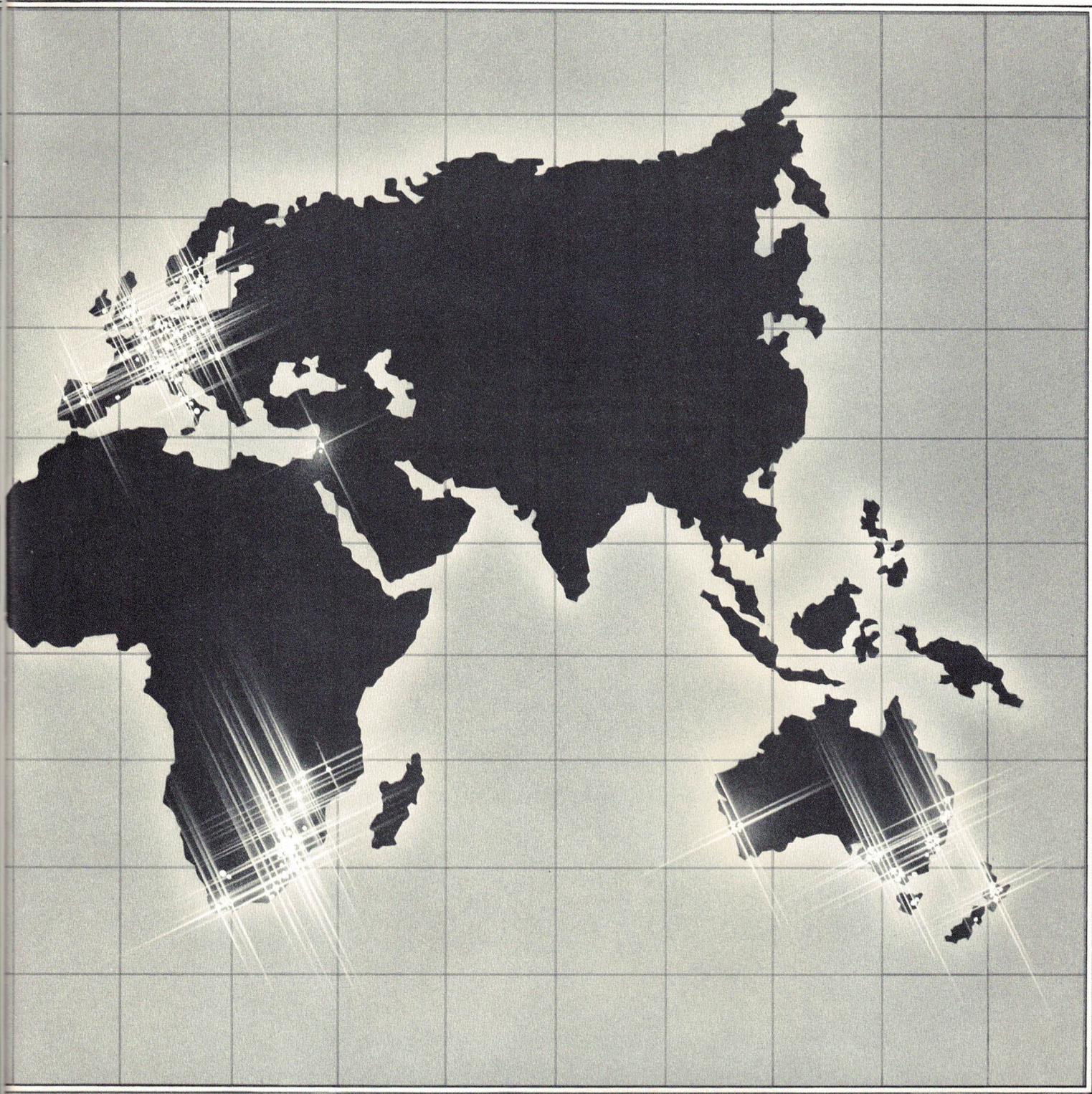

AND ANOTHER POINT OF VIEW

My son John asked me to write about our family's experience with drug-related problems, and with Narconon, from "another point of view." How do you condense ten years of fear, pain, anger, humiliation, humor and love into a few succinct words that will enable people who didn't share those emotions to even begin to understand the dynamics of a family whose guts are twisted by the effects of drug abuse by its children. Children are the "hope of the future" for parents. How trite that statement is; but no matter how hard parents try not to invest their own unfulfilled hopes and aspirations in their children, most of us fail to do so miserably. We want to bask in our children's successes. Even if we have our own successes, we want more for our children; we also want them to have less pain in achieving those successes.

Drug use of a new kind magnified the divergence of our philosophies. We parents who for years had smoked, who had done business and socialized over martini lunches and on cocktail-party weekends, who had controlled their weight with diet pills (speed), had soothed their tensions with tranquilizers, had sweetened their coffee and tea with saccharin, and had spent millions of dollars on over-the-counter medications for everything from hemorrhoids to the common cold, now panicked at the discovery of a baggie of "Maryjane" discovered in their teenager's bedroom. Paranoia led otherwise intelligent, generally reasonable, adults to over-react to such an extent that the "normal" schism between parents and children became a "Grand Canyon."

Ours was an ordinary middle-class family. We never expected to deal with problems of the magnitude of heroin, and were totally unprepared to do so; so was the community in which we lived. It seems in retrospect that one day we were involved in Little League, 4-H, Swim Teams, serving on the school board, belonging to community improvement organizations, taking summer vacations at the beach and worrying about dental bills. The next day we were on a crazy merry-go-round

of juvenile halls, California Youth Authority, psychiatrists, school counselors, court appearances and runaways.

... before Narconon we were involved, as individuals and as a family, in numerous "programs," both public and private. We spent a lot of money on psychiatrists, psychologists, private schools, and eventually attorneys and bailbondsmen.

When John and Tory first became involved in Narconon, we had hoped and lost hope so many times that we were more than a little "gun-shy" of any "program." As time passed however, we gradually became aware that this was not just another program; something was really happening. Although only three members of the family were actually participants in Narconon, all of the family has had some involvement.

Narconon is not an overnight, born-again, magic formula kind of program; it only works for those who have made a conscious decision that drugs are not buying them the things in their life that they want. It teaches techniques for dealing with life, for changing goals. People can't be *sent* to Narconon; they have to *go*, and stay, and work.

I hated drugs, I hated the pain, I hated the way people looked at my children, I hated the thought that my children might be hurting other people. They are warm, loving people who care for the world they live in, for their own families, and for each other. They are aware of the satisfaction of financial security, because we lost ours and all had to rebuild it, but they are not obsessed by it. They have an appreciation for education. They have an appreciation for Life.

Narconon was not the only contributing factor in the survival of us all; it required a supportive environment as do most programs; however, with that environment I think it's the only game in town.

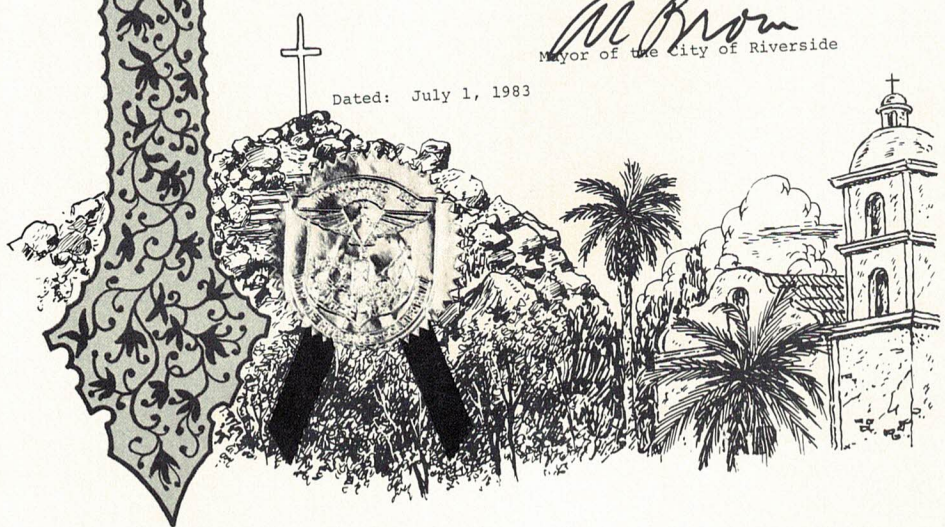
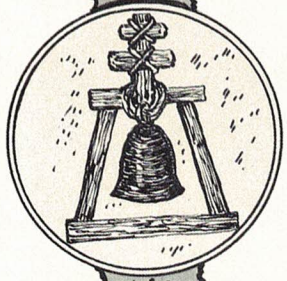

Elks team-up to fight drug abuse

The Westchester Elks, in cooperation with the Narconon Drug Rehabilitation Program, presented a drug education and prevention conference Wednesday night at 7:30 p.m. at the Westchester Elks Lodge located at 8025 West Manchester Avenue in Playa Del Rey.

PCP Nightmare Over for Narcotics Officers

It was to have been a routine marijuana bust. Previous reconnaissance had already located the thriving plants in the back yard of a small Selma, California house in the San Joaquine Valley. On May 29th, 1980 Michael Del Puppo arrived with several other officers to serve a search warrant. The suspect, who was outside at the time, immediately bolted for the front door, closely pursued by the now shouting Del Puppo and his partner who were commanding him to halt. The suspect entered the house, slamming and locking the door behind him. Del Puppo and his partner put their shoulders to the door and tore it off the frame. Michael Del Puppo's three-year ordeal with PCP contamination was about to begin.

him over to an outside faucet and rinsed off his head as best as possible (an act which may have saved his life), it occurred to no one to take his shirt off. Del Puppo states that after his wife washed the shirt he continued wearing it for almost a year before he finally burned it. For Leonard Villahermosa, PCP represented a far less dramatic, but far more insidious turn of events.

Between 1977 and late 1980 he was involved in the dismantling of nearly a dozen PCP labs. By the end of 1980 his physical and mental health had deteriorated significantly. He began to have daily headaches. In some instances they were so bad that "just the vibration of a person's voice would make me very upset." He became a fight with somebody over absolutely nothing. He felt "sick and worn out" all the time and stated that his mental functioning was very poor. "Sometimes I could get the idea of what I wanted to say to someone, but I just couldn't seem to get it out," he explains. Del Puppo's symptoms were almost identical to those of Villahermosa. After obtaining an attorney he began three years of disappointment as hospital treatments failed and psychiatric and psychological evaluations seemed to ignore the PCP element entirely, asserting that his difficulties

stemmed from the incident itself and not from the chemical contamination. Villahermosa also saw a number of psychiatrists and psychologists and his experiences were remarkably similar to those of Del Puppo.

Del Puppo received a call concerning a detoxification program which had been developed and tested in the 1970's by American writer and researcher, L. Ron Hubbard. His writings on the adverse effects of drugs and how to deal with them have been used for years by various drug abuse programs. His particular detoxification technique has grown in popularity as public concern over the effects of environmental chemicals and hazardous wastes had increased. After learning of the technique, Dr. Analine recommended that Del Puppo undergo the program which was being offered at the Beverly Detox Center, a medical clinic in Los Angeles specializing in human detoxification.

This improvement continued on up until the 19th day of the program when a new realization indicated to Del Puppo that he had completed the program. "The old Michael Del Puppo seemed to be back and I felt sure that I had completed the program."

The doctors readily agreed and Del Puppo was sent for follow-up testing. A physical examination revealed that his eyesight had improved and his blood pressure had dropped significantly. His memory seemed to be improved and his mental functioning seemed greatly enhanced. His IQ and reaction time scores confirmed the improvement.

Both Del Puppo and Villahermosa say they believe there are a number of other officers who probably have had similar problems but are attributing their headaches or fatigue or irritability to other factors, work stress, family upsets and so forth. "The police officers and firemen who have to deal with PC lab explosions and fires are doing their communities a tremendous service," says Del Puppo. "The reward shouldn't be chiding health problems. Toxic contamination problems can be addressed effectively and hopefully, who have similar problems will seek out the help that is now available."

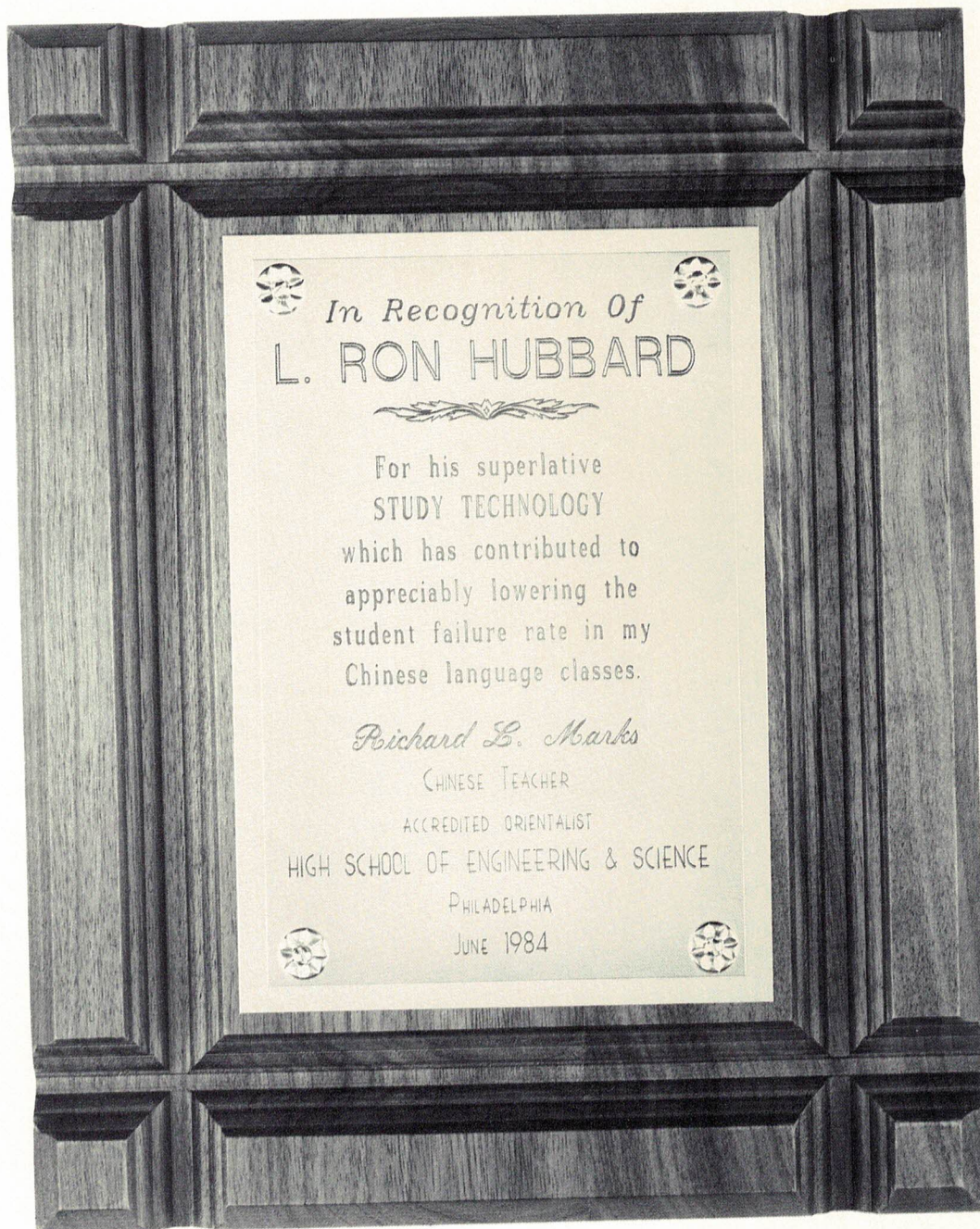

If one wishes a subject to be taught with maximal effectiveness, he should

1. Present it in its most interesting form.
 - (a) Demonstrate its general use in life.
 - (b) Demonstrate its specific use to the student in life.
2. Present it in its simplest form (but not necessarily its most elementary).
 - (a) Gauge its terms to the understanding of the student.
 - (b) Use terms of greater complexity only as understanding progresses.
3. Teach it with minimal altitude (prestige).
 - (a) Do not assume importance merely because of a knowledge of the subject.
 - (b) Do not diminish the stature of the student or his own prestige because he does not know the subject.
 - (c) Stress that importance resides only in individual skill in using the subject and, as to the instructor, assume prestige only by the ability to use it and by no artificial caste system.
4. Present each step of the subject in its fundamental form with minimal material therefrom by the instructor.
 - (a) Insist only upon definite knowledge, axioms and theories.
 - (b) Coax into action the student's mind and establish all data which can be established from the axioms or theories.
5. Form patterns of computation in the individual with regard only to their usefulness.
6. Teach where data can be found or how it can be derived, not the recording of data.
7. Be prepared, as an instructor, to learn from the students.
8. Treat subjects as variables of expanding use which may be altered at individual stability of knowledge as the student's ability to apply knowledge he knows for new application.
9. Stress the right of select only what he desires to know as he wishes, that he he has learned.

Believing that it IS possible for an individual to influence others by setting a good example to those around him who affect his own survival, L. Ron Hubbard wrote a common sense guide to better living, a slender but immensely powerful booklet called *The Way to Happiness*.

Many of the residents, as well as the head of the Parents of Watts, have directly attributed this to the introduction and use of *The Way to Happiness* in the community.

- Over 50 U.S. corporations and companies have contributed to the distribution of *The Way to Happiness*, including Atlantic Richfield, Sinclair Paint, Rockwell, Security Pacific Bank, Chevron, National Paint, IBM and Ashton-Tate.
- A 30 foot tall "Statue of Happiness" was built in Teignmouth, England, to honor *The Way to Happiness*.
- 1000 Mexican prison inmates received *The Way to Happiness* and a lecture on the precepts.
- One of the most senior education officials in the country of Zaire gave a lecture on ethics, morals and *The Way to Happiness* to 500 political trainees and members of the press. This was very well received and many of these people are now using this book in their daily life.
- A Roman Catholic priest in Rome organized a project to have children pass out the booklet.
- A community service group in San Quirico Italy, raised enough money to get the booklet into the hands of every citizen in the city.

In 1984, hardcore gang members, from one of Los Angeles's most notorious gangs, were introduced to *The Way to Happiness*. Once acquainted with the concepts of the booklet, they stopped taking drugs, held a three-day vigil against gang violence, painted a mural with a quote from the booklet, and organized two projects that removed graffiti from more than 110 business establishments.

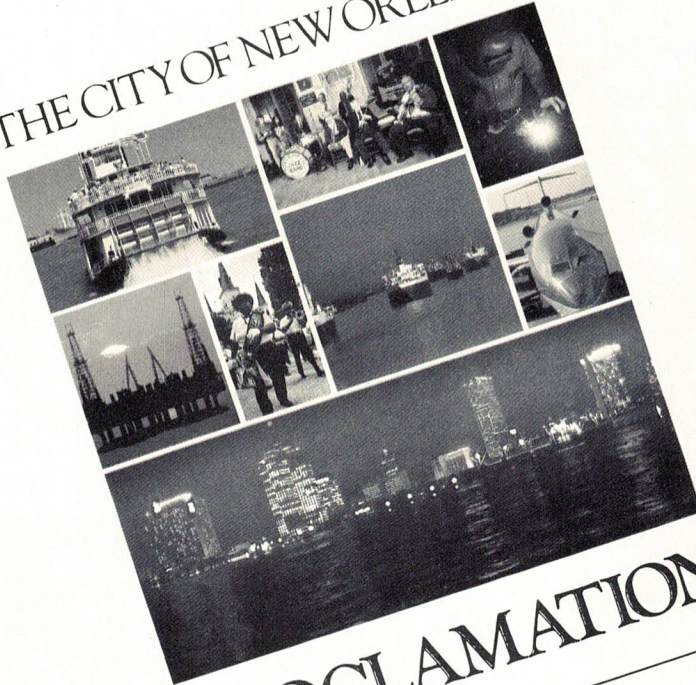

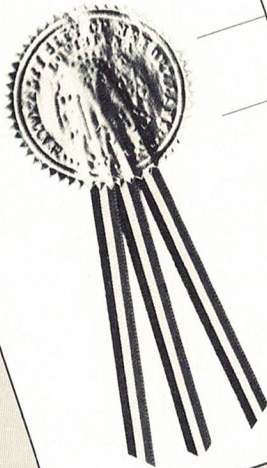
Los Angeles is bracing itself for a vast, global pilgrimage to the Olympic Games—a pilgrimage already under way. Will the visitors be friendly? In 1972, bloody violence marred the Olympics when Palestinian guerillas kidnapped nine Israel athletes at the Munich Games and demanded as ransom that Israel free all Arab prisoners from its jails. In the ensuing shoot-out five of the eight terrorists and all nine athletes were killed. Tragically, the Soviet Bloc nations are boycotting the 1984 Games politicalizing this historic celebration of health, strength and beauty. Can someone strike a spark to help promote new harmony among these desperate nations and national attitudes—to foster a return to the traditional values and goals embodied in the games? "The Way to Happiness" is also being translated into two Chinese languages and Korean. In East Los Angeles "The Way to Happiness" has affected a transformation of the once notorious 18th Street gang when 16 members began to comprehend the idea in the moral code they started rejecting drugs, held a three day vigil to protest gang violence, painted a mural featuring a quote from the book and cleaned unsightly graffiti from the exterior of over 110 business establishments. A year later, most of the buildings were still free of graffiti. The second graffiti clean-up developed as a pre-olympic project when youth in the Boyle Heights District repainted 17 businesses and distributed more than 25,000 copies of "The Way to Happiness" for businessmen to share with their customers. This is just the start. "The Way to Happiness" campaign proposes ultimately to reduce crime, drug abuse, inflation, unemployment and faulty education in the world. It's a star high dream, but if we can consciously embrace the values enunciated in this guide, we may at least, succeed this summer in preserving untarnished the integrity and meaning of Sam, our symbolic Olympic Eagle. 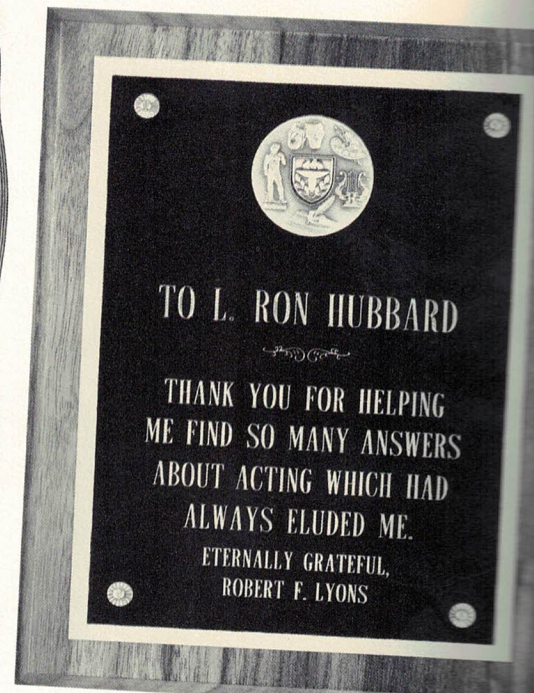
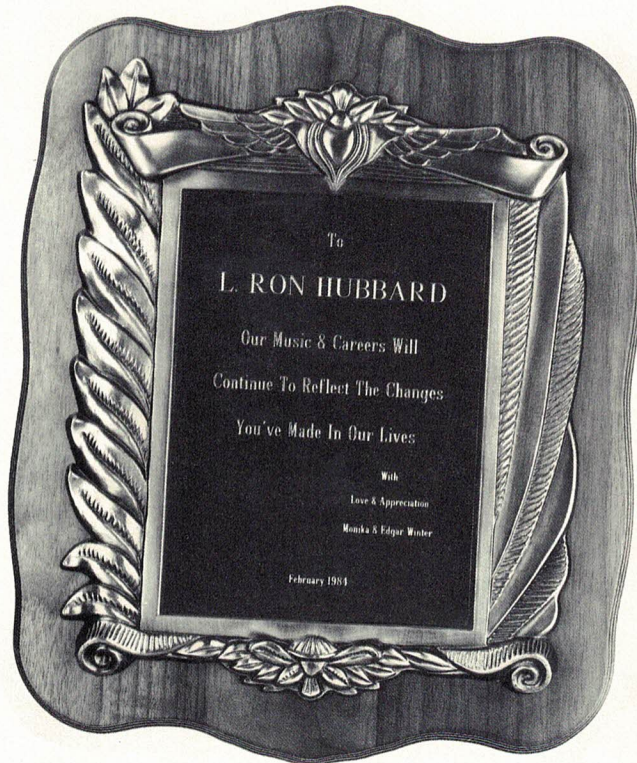

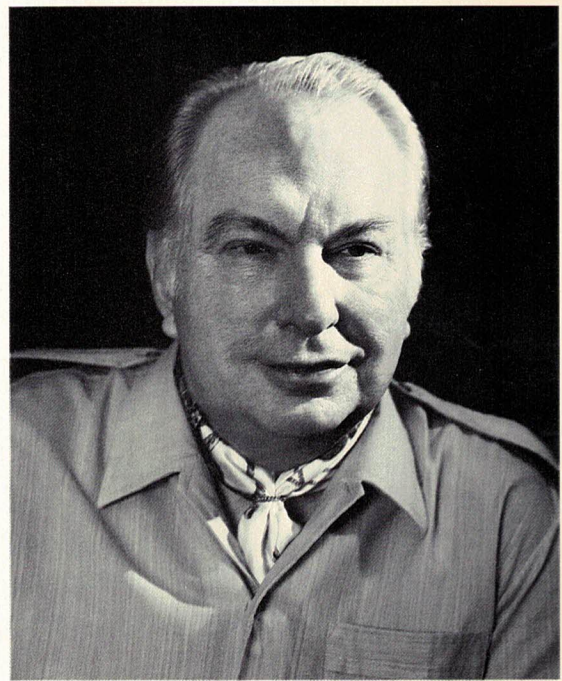

Abe Polonsky, who's spent the last few years in the groves of academe, has been signed by producer Bill Immerman to adapt L. Ron Hubbard's current best-selling "Battlefield Earth," which Ken Annakin will direct.

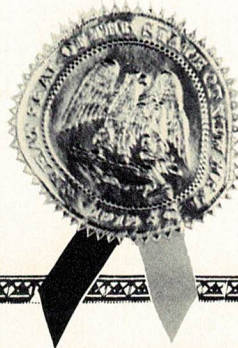

RR and the Media

- o RR has always been comfortable with media. Has a basic respect for their job.
- o He takes the responsibility of the media in democratic society very seriously.

White House Approach to the Media

- o We have never viewed the media as monolithic. The Washington-based press corps can be very different from the out-of-town media.
- o We also understand that the President must communicate to the Nation almost exclusively through the media. Unless it's a Presidential address to Congress or in the Oval Office, must rely on media to transmit what he says.
- o Our approach has been to not rely exclusively on White House press corps. Tend to be subject much more to inside - the - beltway approach to news.
- o Regional media -- such as you represent -- are very important to us. You're closer to what's really on people's minds.
- o The steps we've taken to work with the regional media include:
 - o Office of Media Relations (separate from Press Office) deals exclusively with needs of local media.

 - o We tell our people, throughout the administration, when you travel on business -- do editorial boards, do talk shows, don't be afraid of the media. We see this as a way of getting the administration's story out of Washington directly to the people.
 - o Regional briefings for local editors and broadcasters when we bring them to the White House for a day of briefings and a Q&A session with RR.

- o Commend CBS for public service programming on such issues as teenage alcohol and drug abuse. Is recognition of CBS's broader responsibility to the public.
- o Comments on press relations and what changes, if any, Regan and Buchanan might make.

BACKGROUND

When the two of us met in December we discussed the idea of providing an opportunity for you or another White House official to meet with representatives of television broadcasting. Such a meeting would establish a forum for a direct discussion with broadcasters regarding how the White House perceives the media. We agreed that such a discussion would be most beneficial.

Initially, our discussion focused on the possibility of a presentation or panel discussion at the annual CBS affiliate convention. Then we determined that a good first step might be a smaller group and I suggested the CBS Television Affiliates Government Relations Committee.

GOVERNMENT RELATIONS COMMITTEE

The Committee is made up of representatives from each of the seven affiliate districts around the country. Its purpose is to follow legislative and regulatory issues in Washington that affect the industry in general and network affiliates specifically. Thus informed, the Committee helps to express the views of CBS affiliate stations on important issues. The CBS Washington office provides a support-staff function for the Committee. A list of the attendees (which includes several CBS Inc. representatives as well) is attached. I have included social security numbers for clearance.

FOCUS OF DISCUSSION

At our meeting you indicated that you felt that it would be beneficial to share with broadcasters how the media is perceived within the White House and how the White House acts based upon that perception.

The subject of White House perception, indeed the Washington perception of the media, is of very great interest to CBS and to CBS affiliates.

I believe it would be valuable for affiliates to hear how the White House reacts to news stories, how you time major White House actions or initiatives and how you believe the President and the Administration is treated by the media, particularly CBS. Certainly you might note the attached clipping from the February 22 Washington Post wherein George Keyworth charges that the press is "trying to tear down America." CBS and our affiliates are very concerned about such beliefs and attitudes toward the broadcast media.

In addition to the obvious "news" based issues, certain other views would also be of interest. CBS expends significant effort to fulfill its role as an information source and as an entertainment source. In entertainment we also seek to inform the public. In specials such as "License to Kill" (drunk driving), "All the Kids Do It" (teenage drinking) and "Not My Kid" (effect of teenage drug use on family relationship), CBS seeks to increase public awareness and concern through entertainment programming. To the extent that there is White House awareness of these efforts I am sure your views on such programs would be most relevant and beneficial.

Finally, any insight regarding the White House personnel and staff structure changes, which may relate to media and press relations, would be most interesting.

ISSUE OF NOTE

While this meeting has been announced as a White House briefing regarding the Administration's perceptions of the broadcast media you should be aware of the issue which is of greatest concern to our affiliates at the moment. While I do not anticipate questions being addressed to you on this subject, I do think it appropriate to provide you some background information on the effort to secure a legislation ban against television advertisements of beer and wine or mandatory counter advertisements.

BACKGROUND

When the two of us met in December we discussed the idea of providing an opportunity for you or another White House official to meet with representatives of television broadcasting. Such a meeting would establish a forum for a direct discussion with broadcasters regarding how the White House perceives the media. We agreed that such a discussion would be most beneficial.

Initially, our discussion focused on the possibility of a presentation or panel discussion at the annual CBS affiliate convention. Then we determined that a good first step might be a smaller group and I suggested the CBS Television Affiliates Government Relations Committee.

GOVERNMENT RELATIONS COMMITTEE

The Committee is made up of representatives from each of the seven affiliate districts around the country. Its purpose is to follow legislative and regulatory issues in Washington that affect the industry in general and network affiliates specifically. Thus informed, the Committee helps to express the views of CBS affiliate stations on important issues. The CBS Washington office provides a support-staff function for the Committee. A list of the attendees (which includes several CBS Inc. representatives as well) is attached. I have included social security numbers for clearance.

FOCUS OF DISCUSSION

At our meeting you indicated that you felt that it would be beneficial to share with broadcasters how the media is perceived within the White House and how the White House acts based upon that perception.

The subject of White House perception, indeed the Washington perception of the media, is of very great interest to CBS and to CBS affiliates.

I believe it would be valuable for affiliates to hear how the White House reacts to news stories, how you time major White House actions or initiatives and how you believe the President and the Administration is treated by the media, particularly CBS. Certainly you might note the attached clipping from the February 22 Washington Post wherein George Keyworth charges that the press is "trying to tear down America." CBS and our affiliates are very concerned about such beliefs and attitudes toward the broadcast media.

In addition to the obvious "news" based issues, certain other views would also be of interest. CBS expends significant effort to fulfill its role as an information source and as an entertainment source. In entertainment we also seek to inform the public. In specials such as "License to Kill" (drunk driving), "All the Kids Do It" (teenage drinking) and "Not My Kid" (effect of teenage drug use on family relationship), CBS seeks to increase public awareness and concern through entertainment programming. To the extent that there is White House awareness of these efforts I am sure your views on such programs would be most relevant and beneficial.

Finally, any insight regarding the White House personnel and staff structure changes, which may relate to media and press relations, would be most interesting.

ISSUE OF NOTE

While this meeting has been announced as a White House briefing regarding the Administration's perceptions of the broadcast media you should be aware of the issue which is of greatest concern to our affiliates at the moment. While I do not anticipate questions being addressed to you on this subject, I do think it appropriate to provide you some background information on the effort to secure a legislation ban against television advertisements of beer and wine or mandatory counter advertisements.


