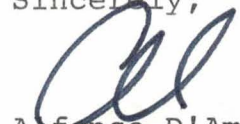
Dear Mike:

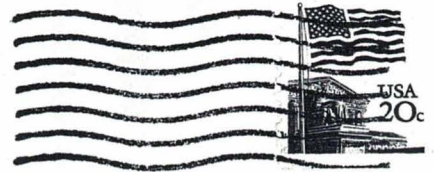
