
Dear Mike,

Dear Mr. President,



RABAT, 10 Nov. (MAP). — SM le Roi Hassan II a adressé un message de félicitations au Président des Etats-Unis d'Amérique, M. Ronald Reagan à l'occasion de sa réélection à la tête de la Maison Blanche pour un nouveau mandat de quatre ans.

Voici la teneur de ce message :

« Monsieur le Président et grand ami,

« Le peuple américain vient de vous renouveler clairement et massivement sa confiance. Votre réélection à la Présidence des Etats-Unis d'Amérique n'est cependant pas seulement l'expression de la volonté des Etats-Unis mais également un message du peuple américain à l'adresse du monde.

« Nous pensons que ce message signifie la justice, la liberté et le courage.

« Si nous avons eu l'honneur et la joie de vous connaître personnellement, nous n'en sommes pas moins convaincus que le choix de votre peuple est un choix judicieux et que le message du six novembre sera accueilli comme il se doit.

« Les Etats-Unis d'Amérique et le Royaume du Maroc ont des liens séculaires fondés sur le respect que nos deux pays vouent à la dignité humaine et à la fierté des peuples.

« Pour Notre part — Nous vous le disons en toute franchise —, Nous avons voté du fond du coeur pour Reagan.

« Nous serons confrontés à de nombreux problèmes dont la solution exigera de vous d'énormes efforts mais Nous demeurons optimistes car Nous avons à la Maison



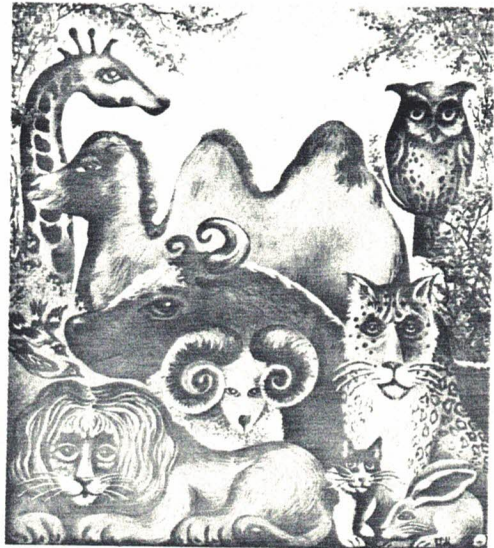
