SUBJECT: Summer Travel and Events

Although it is quite some time away, because of the major events that will be taking place, we should begin considering Presidential travel plans and activities for the summer.

MAJOR EVENTS

1. Democratic National Convention - July 16-20, 1984 - San Francisco, California.
2. Summer Olympics - July 28 - August 12, 1984 - Los Angeles, California.
3. Republican National Convention - August 20-23, 1984 - Dallas, Texas.

RECOMMENDED PRESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES

1. Democratic National Convention - Although this will certainly dominate the news for the July 16-20 time frame, I recommend that the President be in Washington rather than the Ranch. Since the convention addresses will obviously be very critical of the President, it would be better for him to be seen working at the White House than vacationing on the Ranch.

2. Los Angeles Olympics - The opening ceremony for the Summer Olympics takes place on the afternoon of July 28. I recommend that the President fly in from Washington to attend these ceremonies, then travel to the Ranch until the conclusion of the Olympics on August 12. He could remain on the Ranch until August 20 when the Republican National Convention begins. Congress is scheduled to be in recess from August 11 to August 26 and it should be a slow news period.

To avoid negative news stories about this extensive period on the Ranch, there are several good events that could be used for day trips or brief travel swings. These include the VFW convention in Chicago, August 10-17 and the Knights of Columbus Convention in Denver on August 7-9. There are also some major hispanic forums during that time frame, but the exact dates have not yet been set.

RECOMMENDATION

The President attend the Olympic opening ceremony on July 28, and remain on the Ranch until August 20, with day trips to be determined.

3. Post Convention through Labor Day - There is only a one-week period between the Republican Convention and Labor Day weekend. Since he will have just come from an extended stay at the Ranch, it would probably not be wise to go back. I suggest that he return to Washington for a week of work followed by a major Labor Day event such as a visit to Liberty Park in New Jersey as he did four years ago.
