We were on a patrol which started out towards Landres-St Geogges at 11 o'clock 17th October 1918 with order to secure a ~~prison~~ prisoner. The Patrol consisted of 1 officer and 16 men four of us went ahead and 12 remained in support we were walking along with 5 paces interval when suddenly a german called " Halt" and we were immediatly fired upon by rifles, we dropped immediatly, the second shot fired, hit Ames in the stomach, he called that he was hit and begged to be placed on his left side, and that he was dying, shortly after he became unconscious, we carried him back until we were able to secure a stretcher and then placed him on it and started towards the first aid station, he died before reaching it.

He was buried on Hill 247 (Cote de Maldah) 500 yards south of road from Sommerance, take line from 3 lone popular trees on the road Map Buzancy I/50.000. Co-ordinates OI.6-84.5

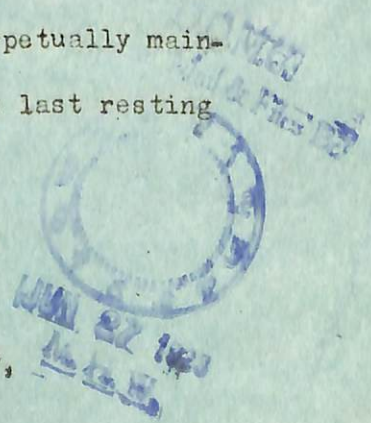
The Quartermaster General desires that you be informed that the permanent grave of Corporal Patrick Ames, Company M, 165th Infantry, is Grave 30, Row 16, Block C, Meuse-Argonne American Cemetery, Romagne-sous-Montfaucon (Meuse), France.

This is one of the permanent American military cemeteries to be maintained by this Government in Europe. Each grave will be marked by a headstone of white marble, of suitable design, with name, rank, division, organization, date of soldier's death and State from which he came. The headstones will be placed at all graves in connection with the improvement work now in progress, as soon as possible and without waiting for special action or request on the part of relatives.

In effecting removal, the utmost care and reverence were exacted and more than willingly accorded by those performing this sacred duty. The grave of the deceased will be perpetually maintained by this Government in a manner befitting the last resting place of our heroes.

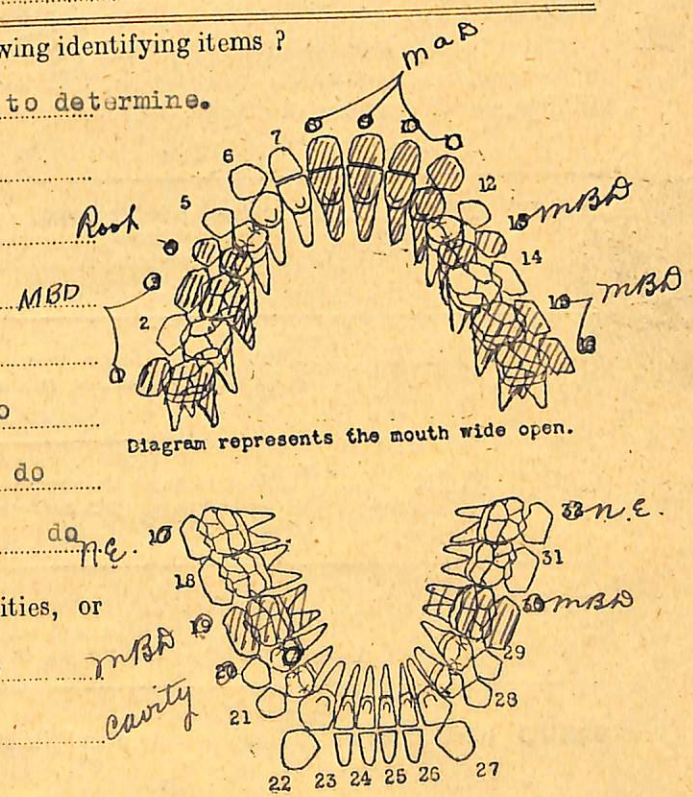

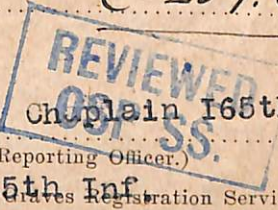
