rank, organization and date of soldier's death. The headstones will
be placed at all graves in connection with the improvement work now in
progress, as soon as possible and without waiting for special action
or request on the part of relatives.

3. In effecting removal, the utmost care and reverence were
exactd and more than willingly accorded by those performing this
sacred duty. The grave of the deceased will be perpetually main-
tained by this Government in a manner befitting the last resting
place of our heroes.



Dear Sir:

The remains of your son, the late Private Antonio Bagelio, are interred in Grave #135, American Cemetery #26, Carbon Blanc, Gironde, France.

It is requested that this office be furnished a statement signed by the first surviving relative of the deceased, according to the following order:- widow (if not remarried), children, or father, expressing his desire whether the remains be left in France, or sent to the United States and interred in a National Cemetery, or shipped, at the expense of the United States Government, to Italy.

Should it be desired that the remains be shipped to Italy, compliance will be influenced by the agreements and understandings between European Nations regarding burials of military dead; or by the provisions of local sanitation laws and health regulations. Should it be impossible to comply with such request, through the operation of such forces, the body will be retained in the care and custody of the American Graves Registration Service, in Europe.

A prompt reply will be appreciated.
