Dear Sir:

The Quartermaster General desires that receipt be acknowledged of your letter of July 3rd, 1924.

It is regretted to have to inform you that there is no appropriation by the Government to defray the expenses of relatives who desire to visit the graves of their soldier dead in Europe. However, there are bills now pending in Congress containing different provisions regarding this matter, but none have become a law.

The records show that the body of your son, the late Sergeant Abraham Beck, Company B, 4th Machine Gun Battalion, has been permanently buried in Grave 26, Row 17, Block C, St. Mihiel American Cemetery, Thiaucourt, Meurthe-et-Moselle, France.

This American military cemetery is one of those to be maintained by the United States for all time in Europe. The grave will be appropriately marked and maintained by the Government in a manner befitting the supreme sacrifice made by this hero.

Please accept the inclosed card, giving the burial location, in slight token of the soldier's service to his country.

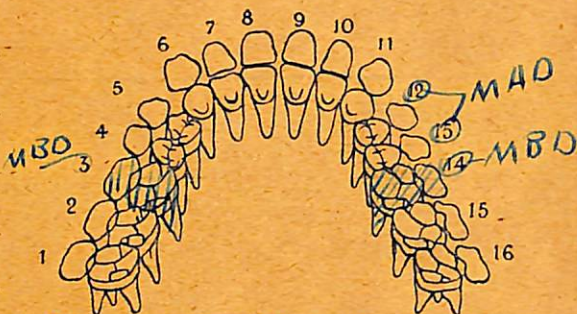
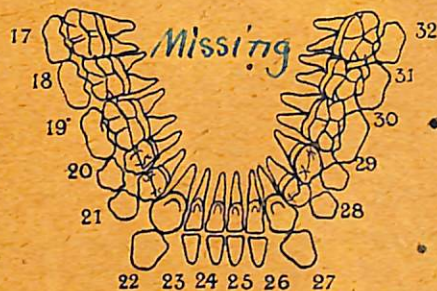


Diagram represents the mouth wide open
