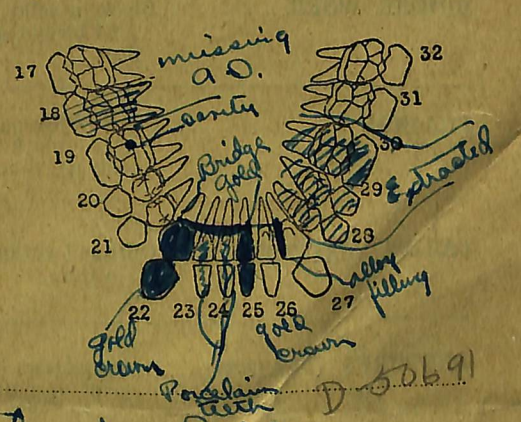
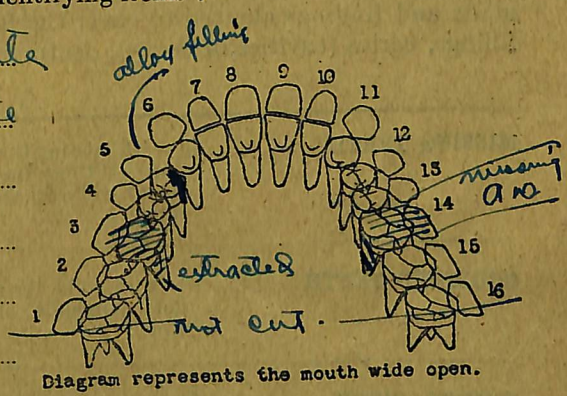

In the event your son was survived by a widow who has since remarried it is requested that a statement to that effect be made.


