- (a) Informant saw Pvt. Bennett struck in the breast by fragment of a high explosive shell on the morning of October 3, 1918. Informant and Pvt. Bennett were sleeping in the same hole when soldier was struck by shell and was killed instantaneously. Informant does not know where the body was buried.

- (c) Informant knew the Christian name but not the number of the man inquired about.
