

The records of this office show that you are the brother of the late Joseph Bernardo, Private, Company D, 307th Infantry, whose remains are now interred in the Suresnes American Cemetery, Suresnes, Seine, France.

If he was survived by a widow who has since remarried it is also requested that a statement to that effect be made.





Diagram represents the mouth wide open.
