This soldier received his fatal wound in the night of Aug. 28, 1918 and was brought to Field Hospital 127 at 7:30 A.M. Aug. 30, 1918. All was done that could be done to his wound in the left leg. (gunshot) but he died in the early morning of the same day.

The body was buried in the afternoon in the American cemetery near the old chateau at Montois, Aisne, France; in grave number 17, The grave was marked with a cross containing his name, rank, number, organization and date of death and a wreath of flowers was placed at the head of the grave.



