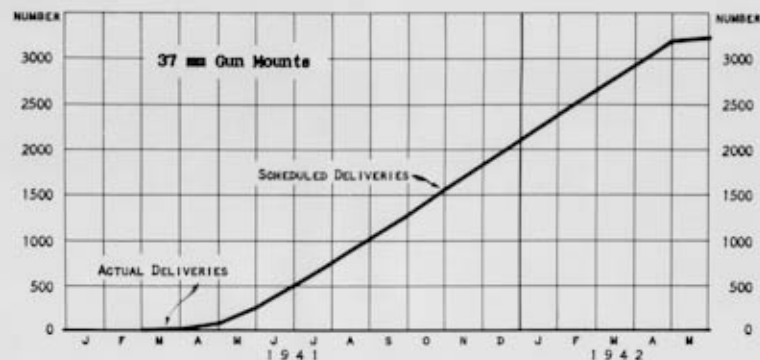
The attached is a chart on light tank production status prepared by Secretary Morgenthau's statistical people from data obtained yesterday from the War Department. Secretary Morgenthau thinks this chart presents the picture which the President would want to see in a simple complete way, and I am inclined to agree with him. I believe it is a better arrangement than the series of corresponding charts delivered to you this morning.

If the President prefers this manner of presentation, the War Department Statistical Section can conform and follow through with similar charts on all important munition items, particularly planes, et cetera.

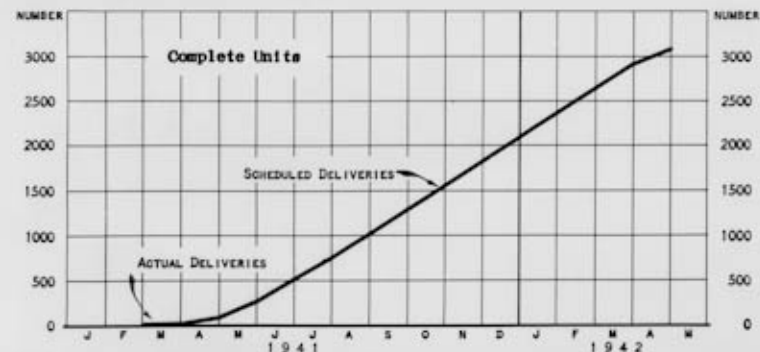
Secretary Morgenthau asked me to deliver this to you as soon as possible.

DELIVERIES OF ENGINES OVER 1000 HORSE POWER By Company, Two Week Periods June 9, 1940 to Date

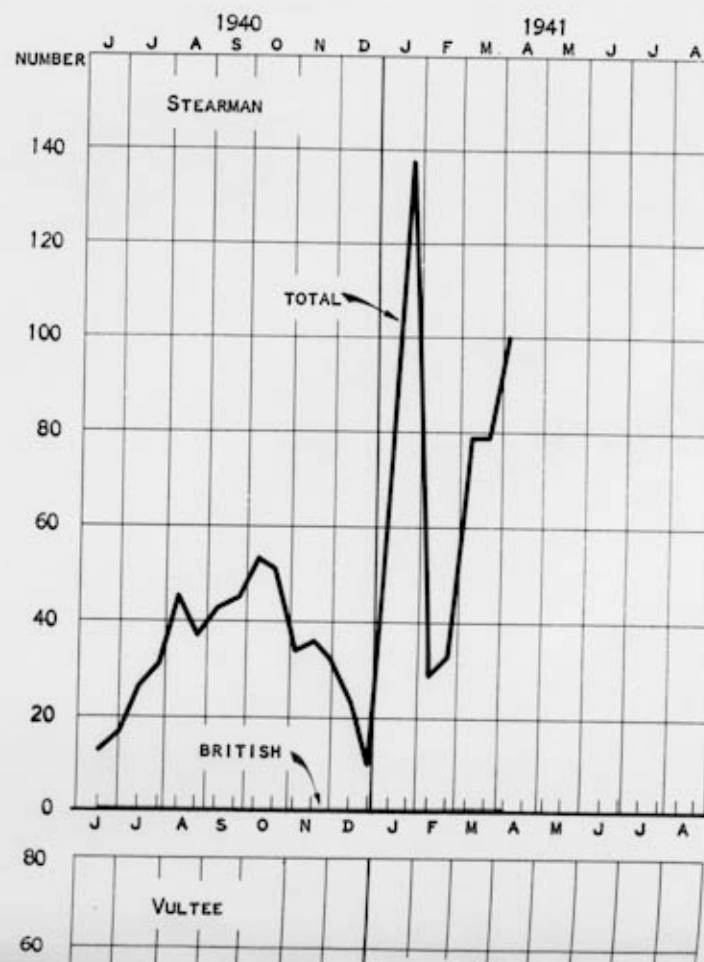
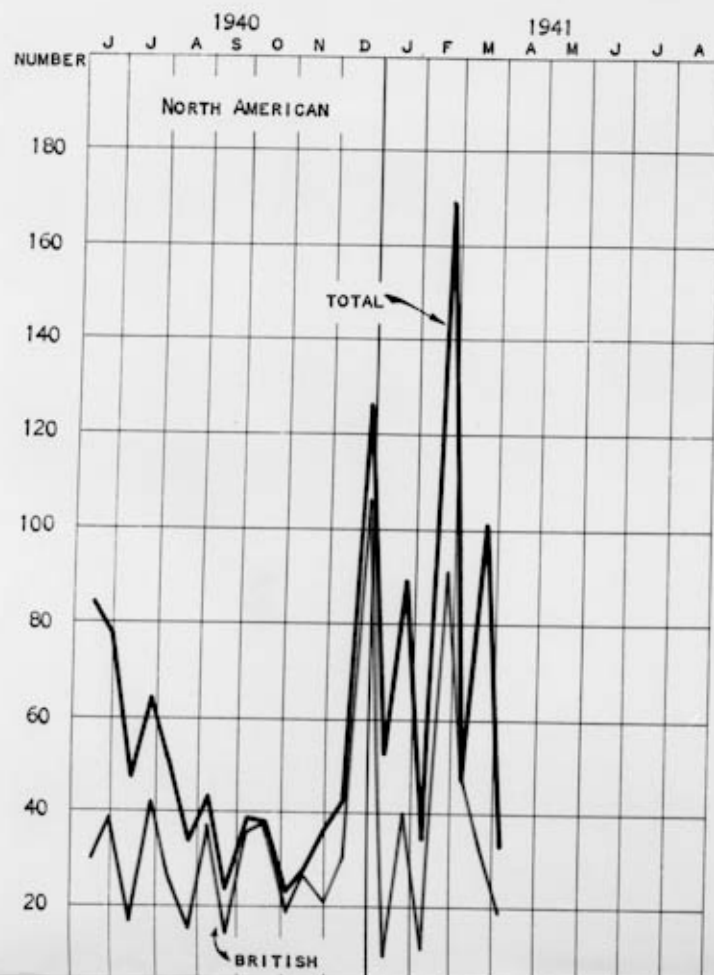
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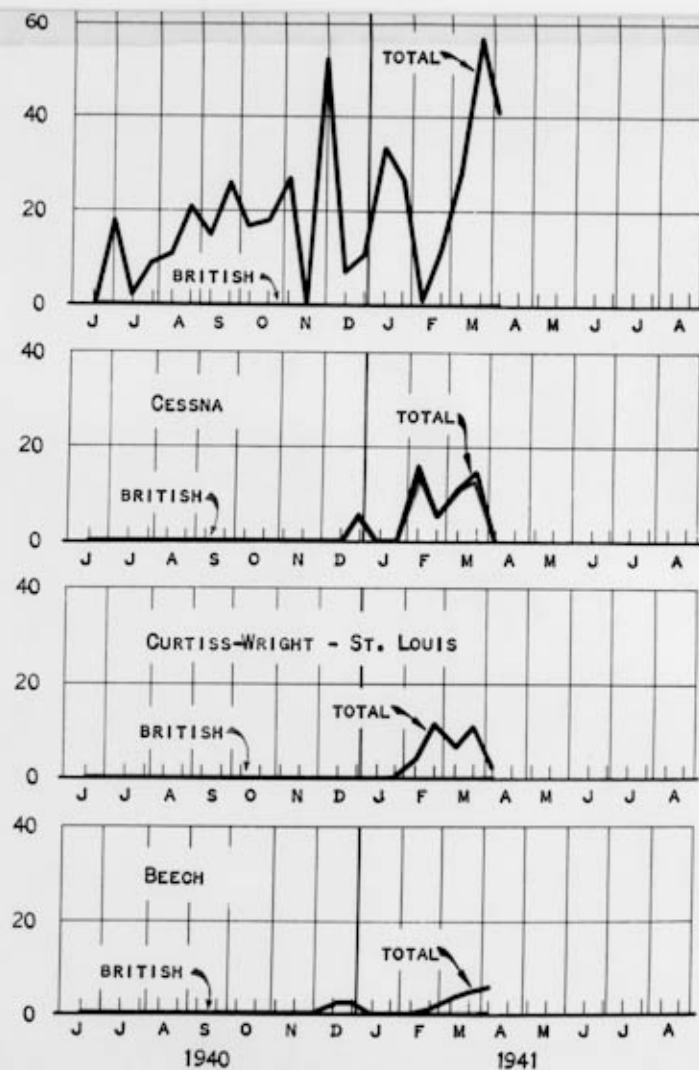
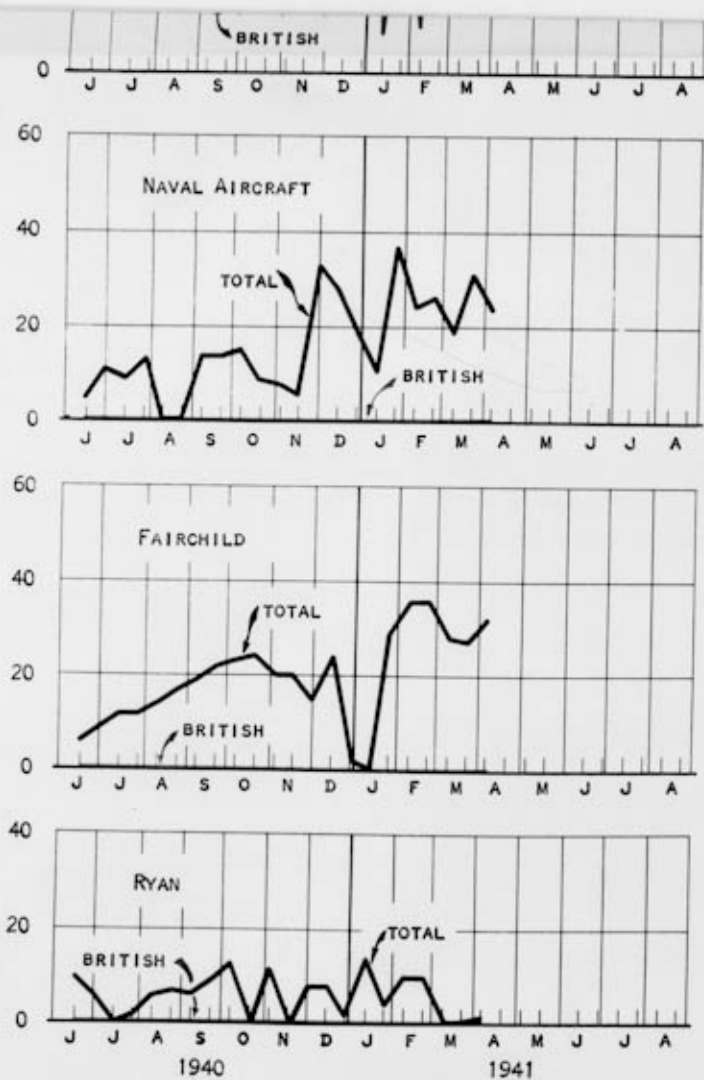




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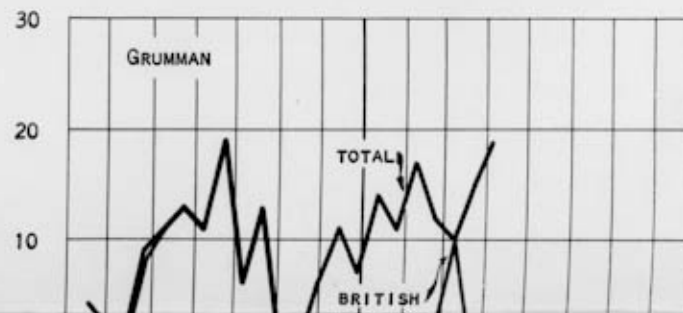
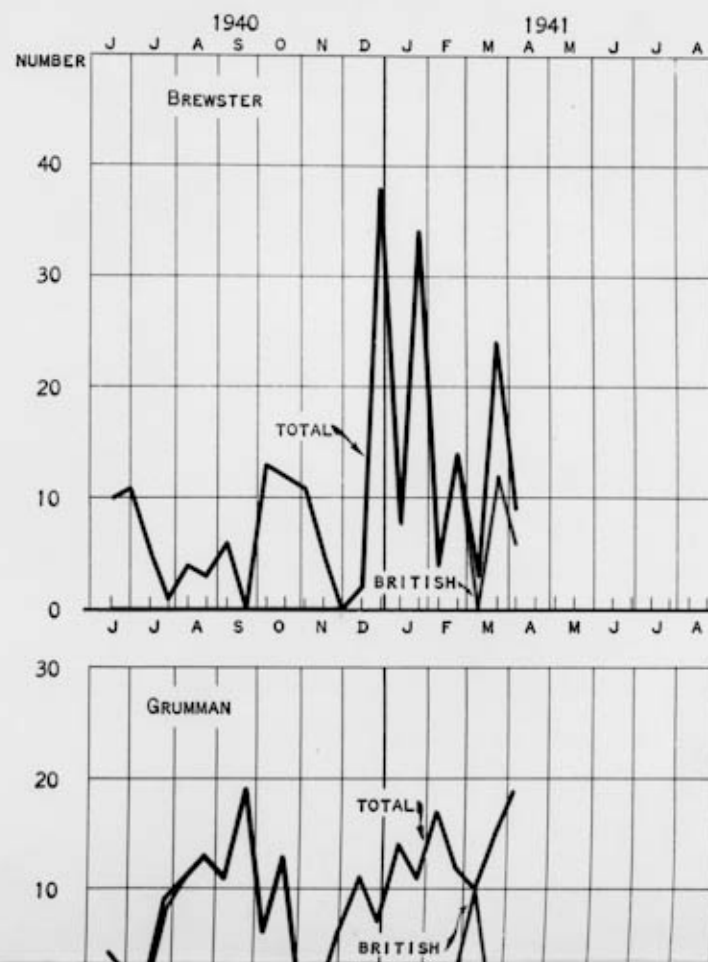
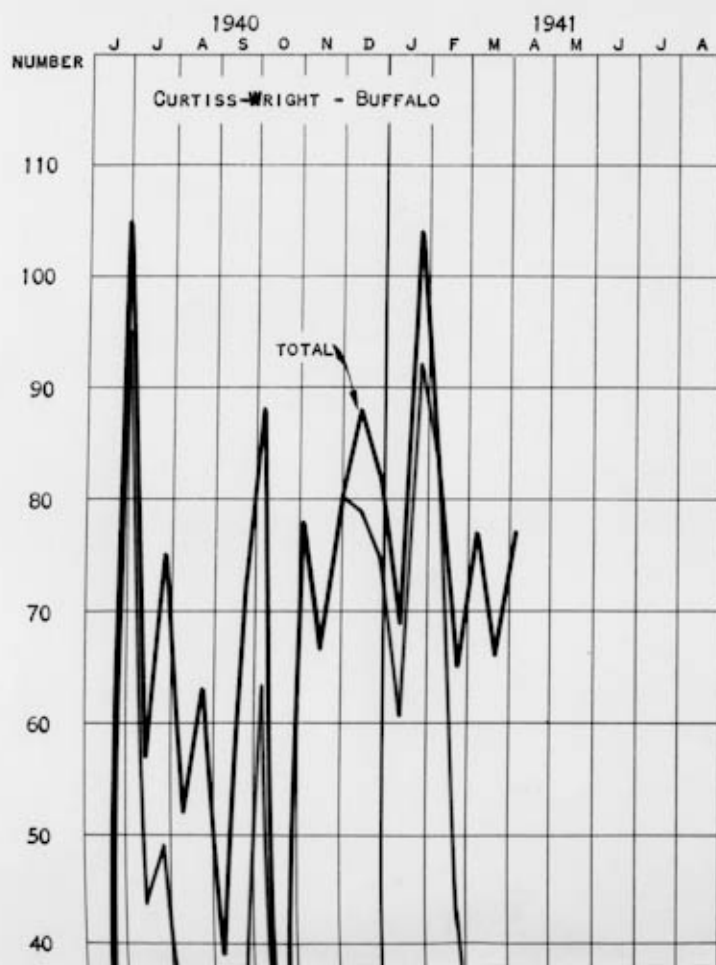

Deliveries of Pursuit Planes, Bi-weekly, June 22, 1940 to April 12, 1941

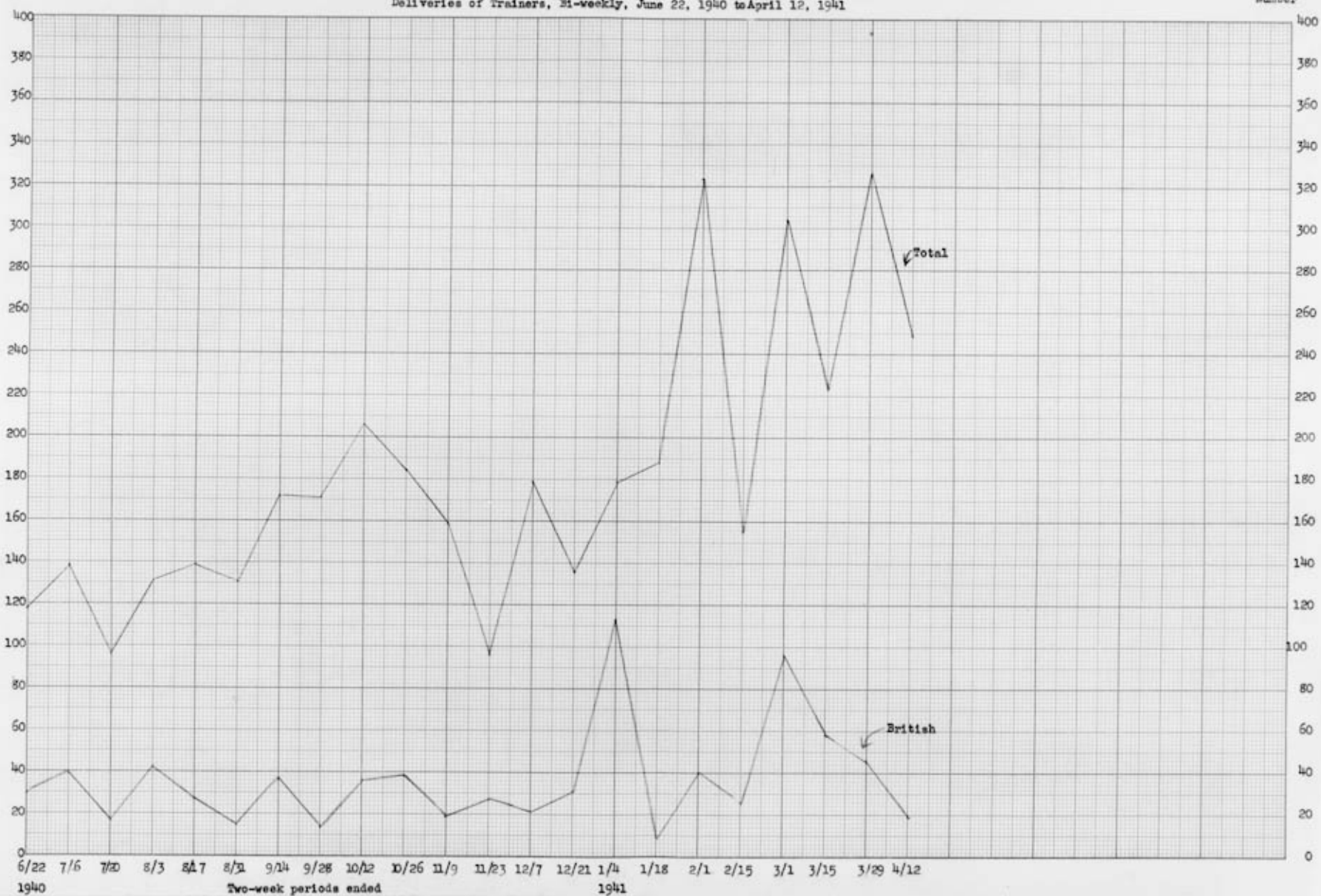

Deliveries of Trainers, Bi-weekly, June 22, 1940 to April 12, 1941

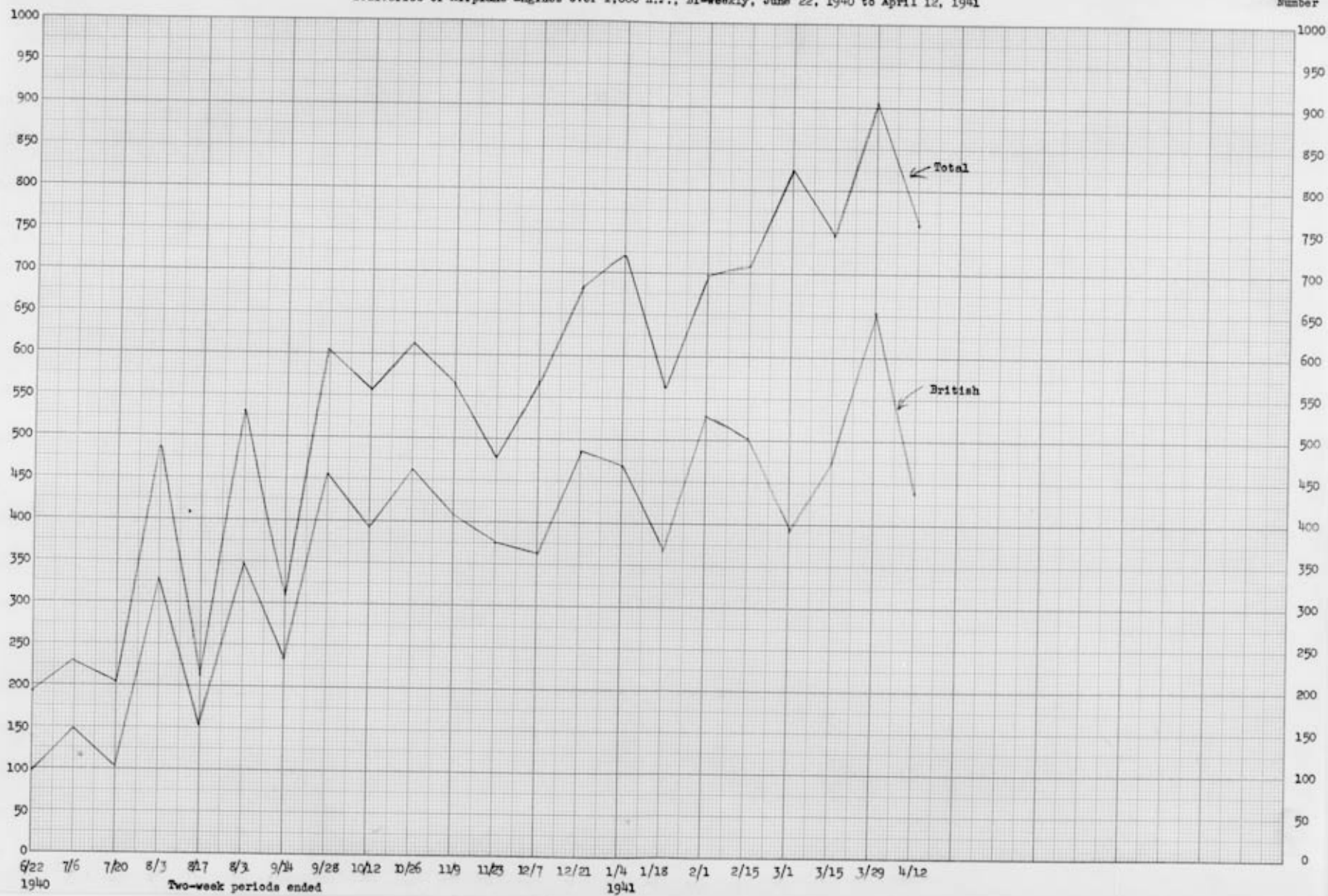
