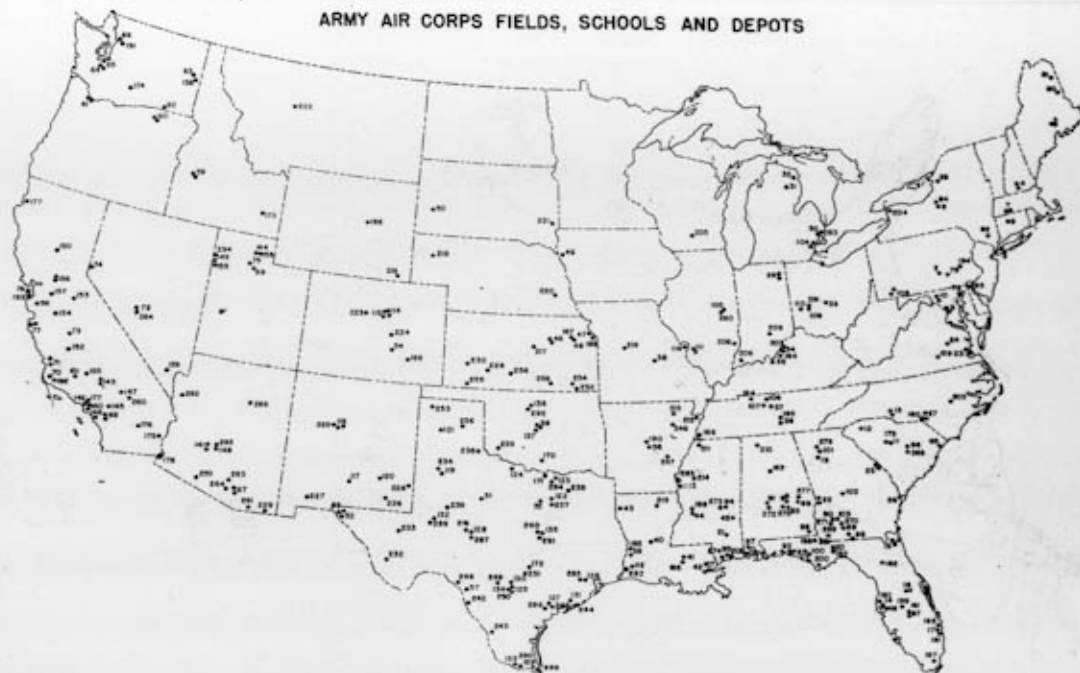

NAVAL AIR STATIONS AND BASES (INCLUDING MARINE CORPS)

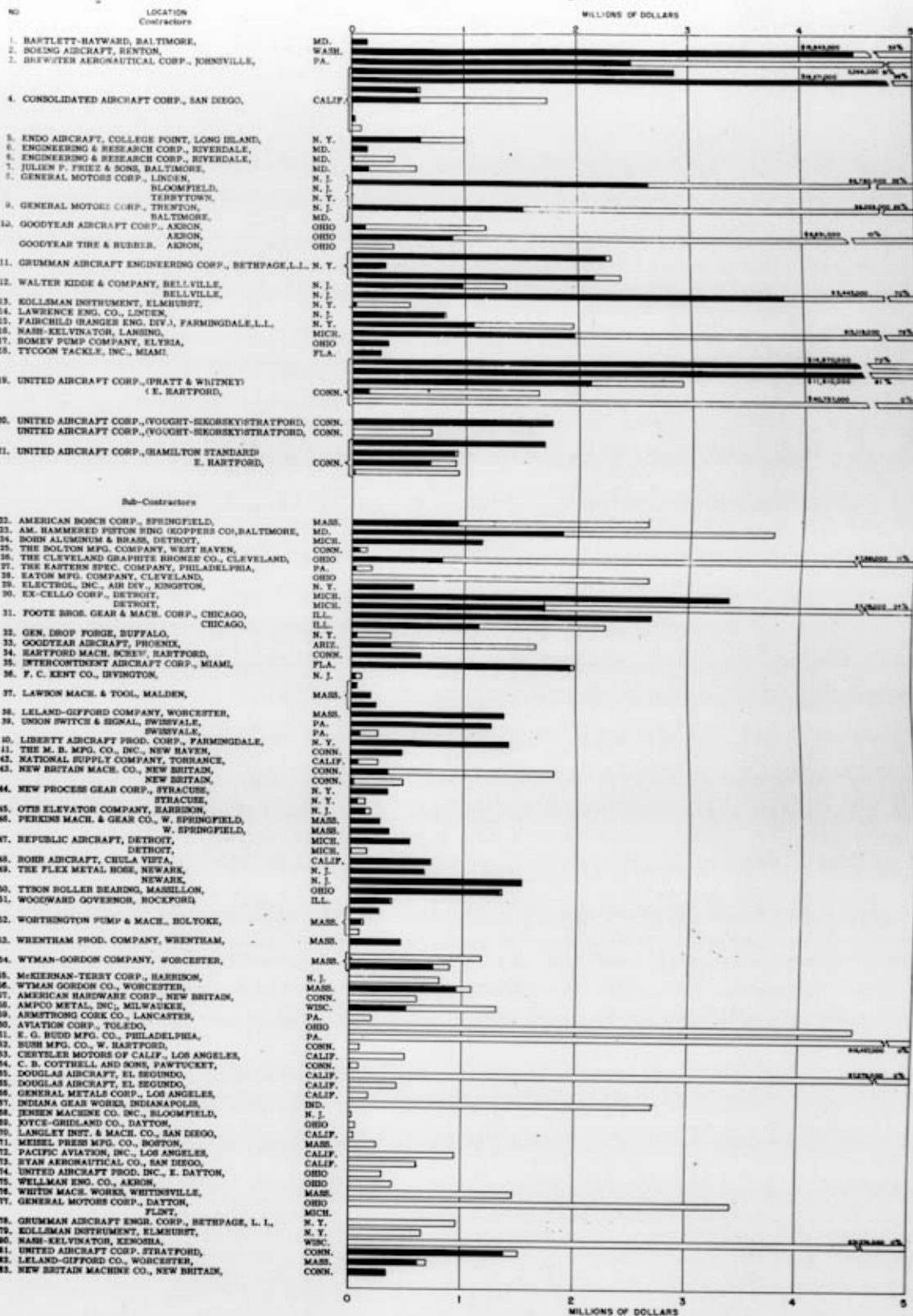

NAVY AIRPLANE MANUFACTURING FACILITIES





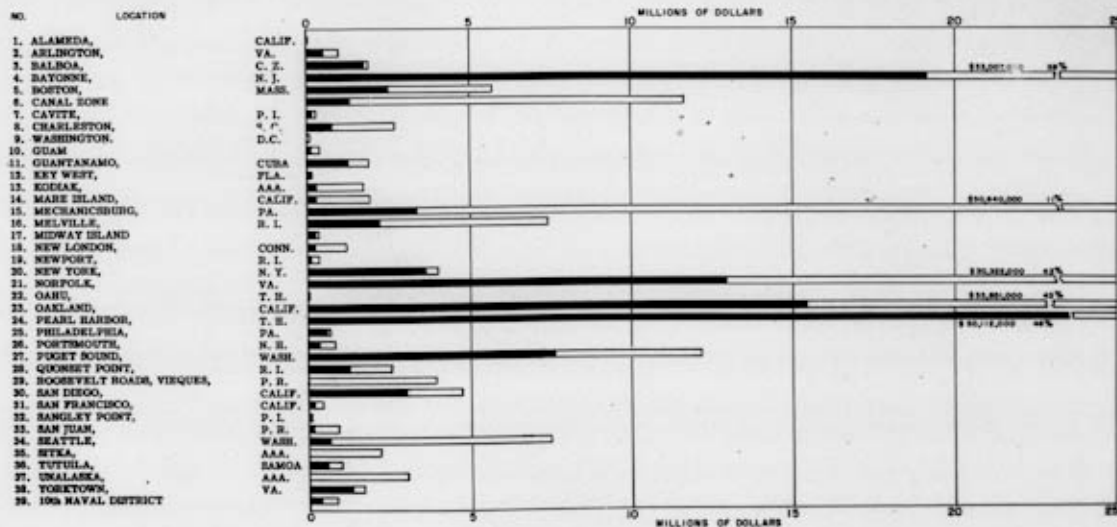

NAVY GENERAL STORAGE FACILITIES (EXCLUDING ORDNANCE STORAGE)



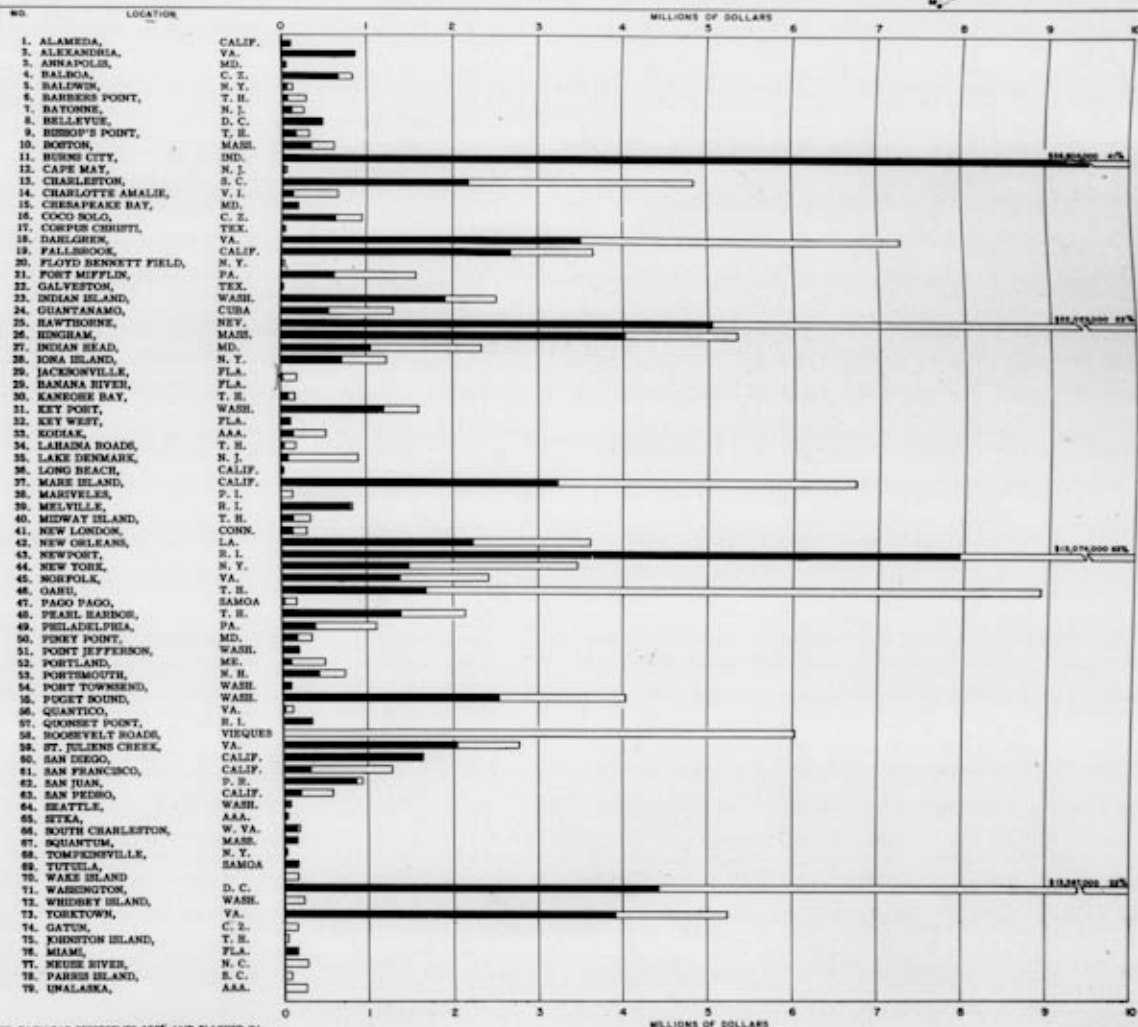

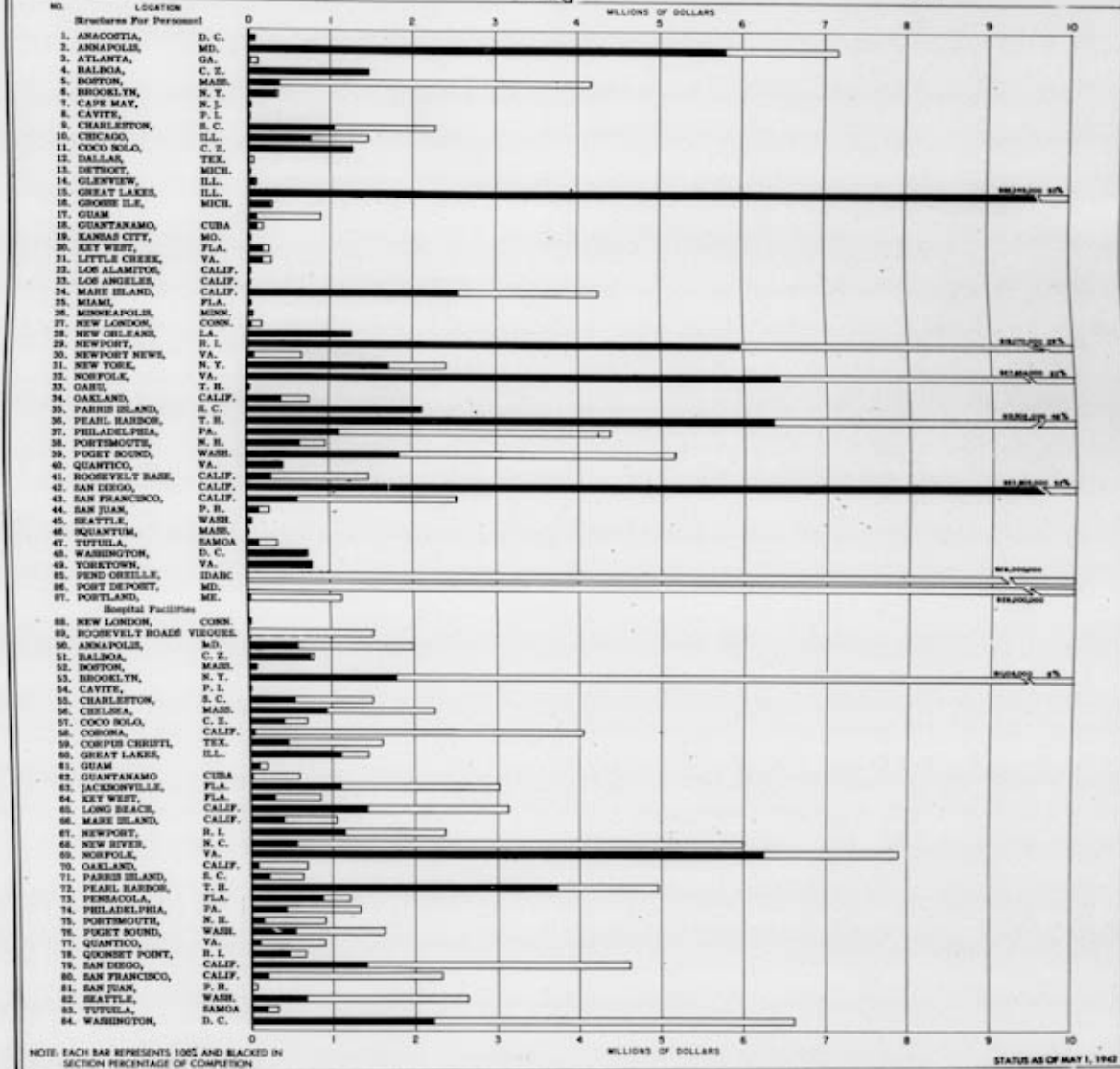
NAVY ORDNANCE FACILITIES

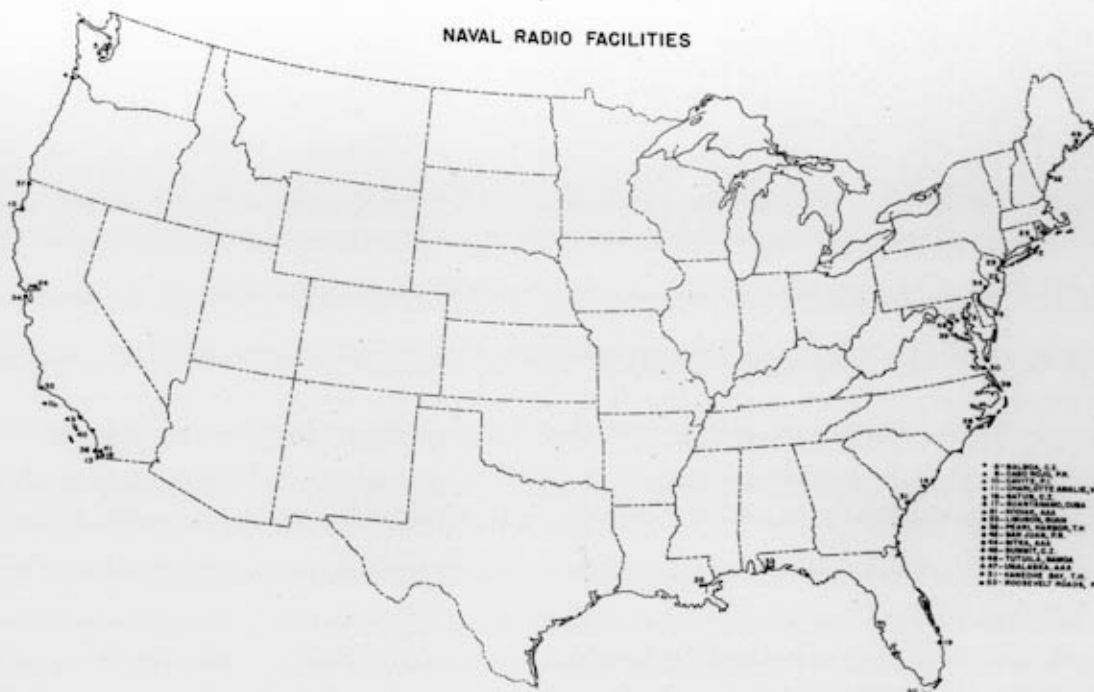
NAVY STRUCTURES FOR PERSONNEL AND HOSPITALS

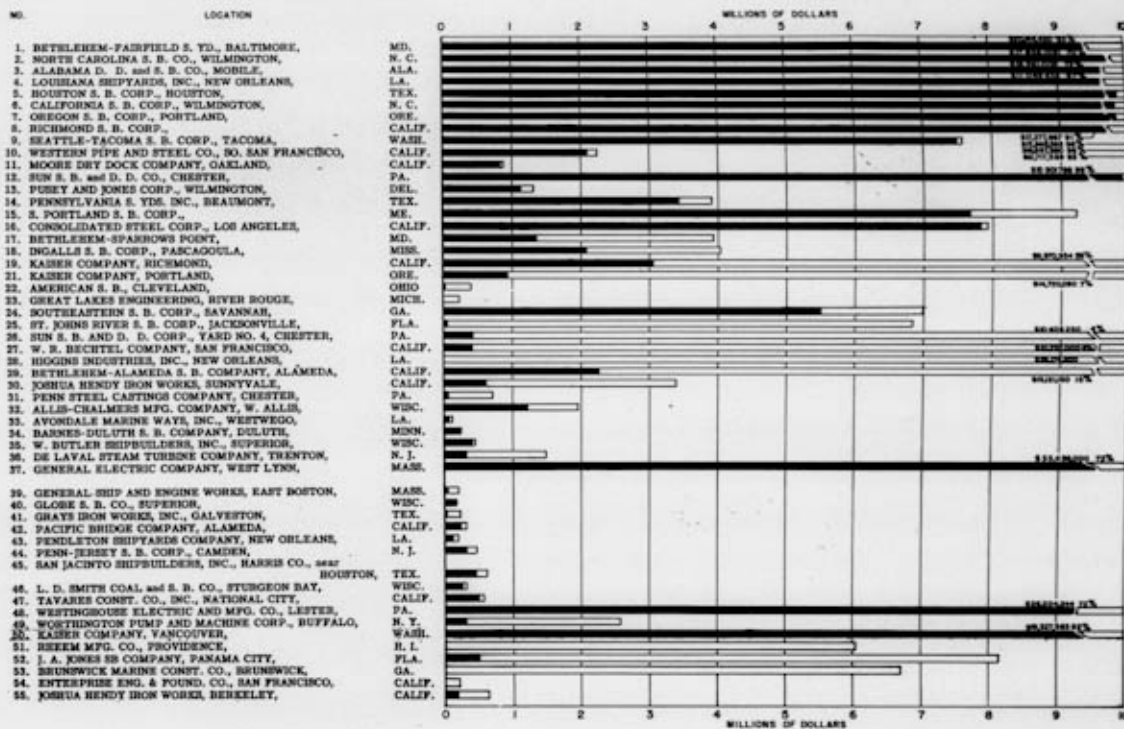
MARINE CORPS FACILITIES (EXCLUDING FLYING FIELDS)

MERCANTILE SHIPBUILDING AND SHIP REPAIR FACILITIES

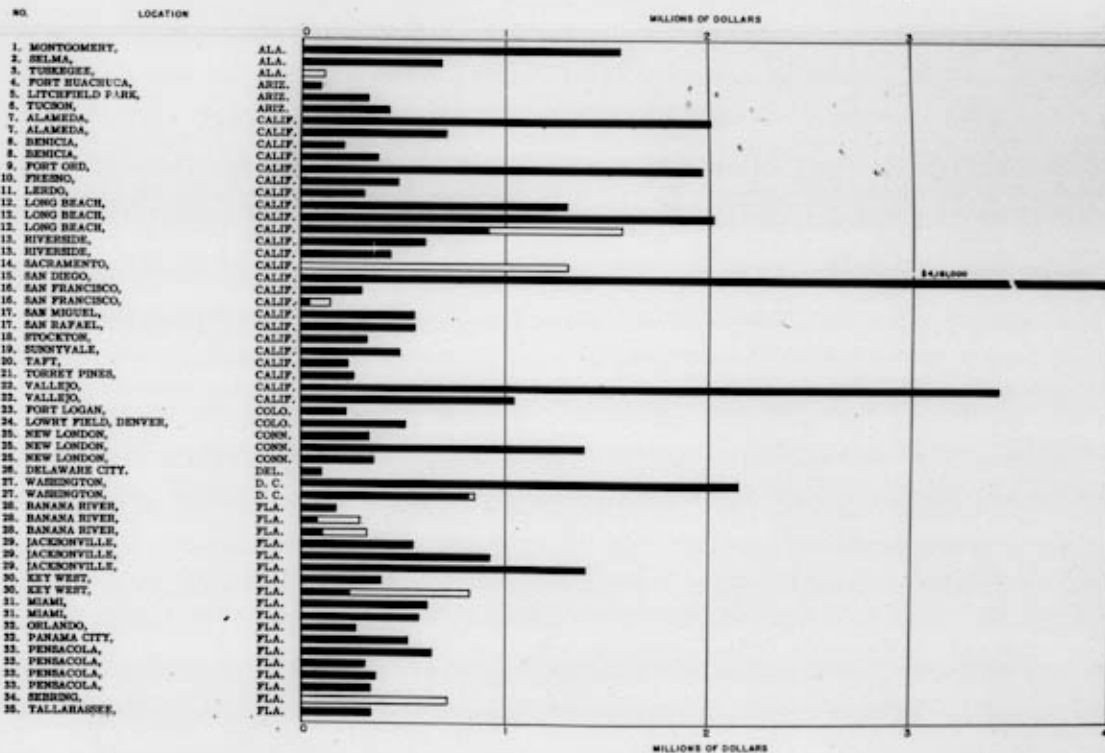
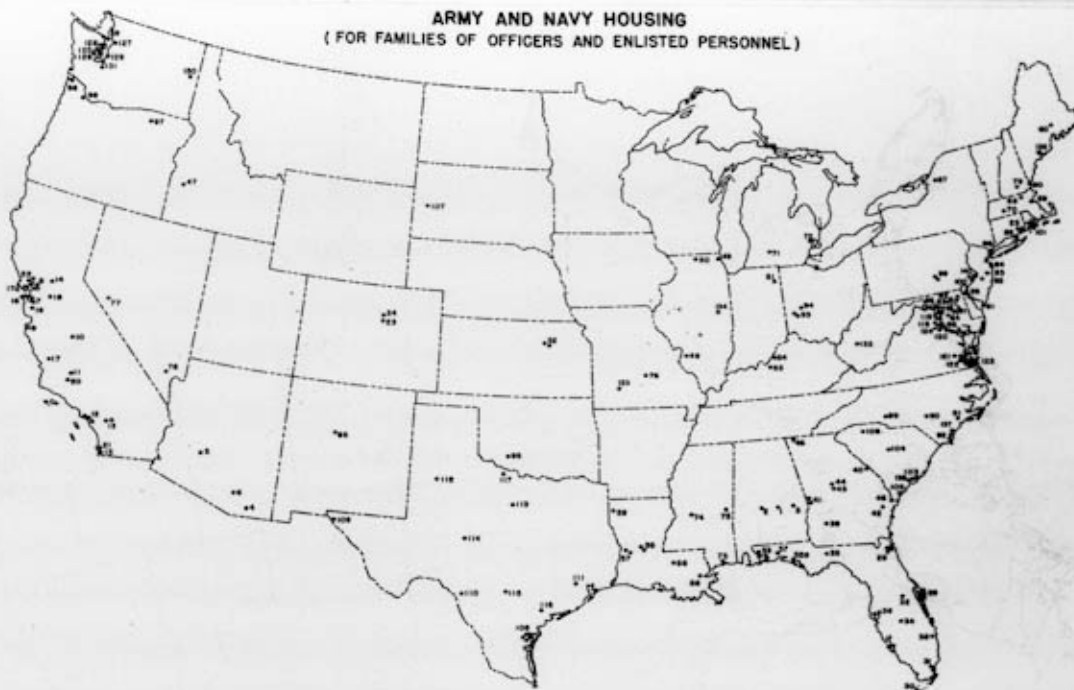
