**JOINT STATEMENT BY PRESIDENT GEORGE W. BUSH
AND PRIME MINISTER TONY BLAIR
ON IRAQ**

The future of Iraq belongs to the Iraqi people. After years of dictatorship, Iraq will soon be liberated. For the first time in decades, Iraqis will soon choose their own representative government.

Coalition military operations are progressing and will succeed. We will eliminate the threat posed by Iraq's weapons of mass destruction, deliver humanitarian aid, and secure the freedom of the Iraqi people. We will create an environment where Iraqis can determine their own fate democratically and peacefully.

We are grateful to our men and women in uniform, as well as to the brave troops of Australia and Poland, and to forces contributed by other members of the coalition. They have demonstrated enormous bravery and professionalism in the face of great danger. We mourn for the members of the Armed Forces who have sacrificed their lives, and extend our deepest sympathies to their families.

We also grieve for the loss of civilian life in Iraq. Coalition forces take great care to avoid civilian casualties. The Iraqi regime has done the opposite. It has deliberately put Iraqi civilians in harm's way, and used women and children as human shields. It has sent execution squads to kill Iraqis who choose freedom over fighting for a brutal regime. We condemn Iraqi regime forces' attacks in civilian clothing, false surrender, and mistreatment of prisoners of war. These acts are an affront to all standards of human decency and international law.

We are taking every step possible to safeguard Muslim holy sites and other protected places in Iraq that are important to

the religious and cultural heritage of Islam and of Iraq. We have no confidence that the Iraqi regime has done the same, and are deeply concerned by reports that it is deliberately endangering such sites and using them for military purposes.

The coalition is delivering food, medicine, and other humanitarian assistance to the Iraqi people. This flow will increase as more of Iraq's territory is liberated. We welcome the adoption by the United Nations Security Council of Resolution 1472, which will allow shipments of humanitarian items to Iraq to resume under the Oil for Food program.

As we said at our March 16 meeting in the Azores, we will uphold our responsibility to help the people of Iraq build a nation that is whole, free and at peace with itself and its neighbors. We support the aspirations of all of Iraq's people for a united, representative government that upholds human rights and the rule of law as cornerstones of democracy. We reaffirm our commitment to protect Iraq's natural resources, as the patrimony of the people of Iraq, which should be used only for their benefit.

The day when Iraqis govern themselves must come quickly. As early as possible, we support the formation of an Iraqi Interim Authority, run by Iraqis, until a permanent government is established by the people of Iraq. The Interim Authority will be broad-based with members from all Iraq's ethnic groups, regions and diaspora. As coalition forces advance, civilian Iraqi leaders will emerge who can be part of such an Interim Authority. The Interim Authority will progressively assume more of the functions of government. It will provide a means for Iraqis to participate in the economic and political reconstruction of their country from the outset.

As we proceed, we will work in partnership with our coalition allies, other bilateral donors, and with the United Nations and other international institutions. The United Nations has an important role to play in the reconstruction of Iraq. We welcome the efforts of U.N. agencies and non-governmental organizations in providing immediate assistance to the people of Iraq. As we stated in the Azores, we plan to seek the adoption of new United Nations Security Council resolutions that would affirm Iraq's territorial integrity, ensure rapid delivery of humanitarian relief, and endorse an appropriate post-conflict administration for Iraq. We welcome the appointment by the United Nations Secretary General of a

personal representative to work with the people of Iraq and coalition representatives.

Coalition forces will remain in Iraq as long as necessary to help the Iraqi people to build their own political institutions and reconstruct their country, but no longer. We look forward to welcoming a liberated Iraq to the international community of nations. We call upon our partners in the international community to join with us in ensuring a democratic and secure future for the Iraqi people.

- Hope to work with U.N. representative on key immediate tasks such as humanitarian relief and human rights

Are you concerned with pace of war, number of casualties?

- Very pleased with performance of troops
- Always knew the risks; knew there would be casualties
- Grieve over casualties; condolences to families. Their sacrifice is a just cause, making our country and the world safer, and bringing freedom to the people of Iraq

How can you call for respect of Geneva conventions in Iraq, when the United States does not recognize them at Guantanamo?

- U.S. fully respects Geneva conventions. Treating Iraqi prisoners of war with dignity. Providing medical treatment where needed and assuring their safety
- Iraq must do the same, and anyone who does not will be tried for war crimes
- Individuals detained at Guantanamo are terrorists and other unlawful combatants, not part of a uniformed military. Being treated well

Are you seeking a new U.N. resolution (sanctions relief, U.N. administration)?

- Discussed this with Tony Blair today
- Coalition providing humanitarian relief urgently. Security Council Resolution 1472 very helpful for relief effort
- We agreed at Azores to seek a Security Council resolution to endorse an appropriate post-conflict administration in Iraq
- UN sanctions on Iraq will also have to be lifted once the current regime is gone

When are you going to release the roadmap? Why haven't you done so yet?

- Have said I am prepared to deliver the Roadmap to the parties, Israeli and Palestinian, for comment once the Palestinians have a Prime Minister with real authority in place
- Palestinian Authority recently designated Mahmud Abbas (Abu Mazen) as Prime Minister
- Abu Mazen has begun to form a new Palestinian cabinet and government. This government could be confirmed as soon as next week when he presents his Cabinet to the Palestinian Legislative Council
- As soon as this occurs, we will present the Roadmap to the parties

What are your views on France and relations with the rest of Europe?

- Have support from majority of European countries. Grateful for their determination and courage
- Many have chosen formally to be part of our coalition
- Recognize differences within Europe
- Believe it is important that democracies of the world work together
- Confident that this will be the case as we build the peace in Iraq and the Middle East
