**President's State of the Union Message: Transmittal of
Copies to the Vice President and the Speaker**

As you know, traditionally the President carries official envelopes (provided by the Executive Clerk) containing the written text of addresses to joint sessions and hands them to the Vice President (President of the Senate) and the Speaker of the House. Each envelope normally contains an original message, with signature, and two copies, and are ***not sealed***. The purpose of these originals is to provide the Congress with official copies of the text of the message and from which the official House Document is printed.

Attached is the Message (in duplicate) for signature. If you will give to me following approval, I will copy and return them to you in the official envelopes.

OPTION: 1) The envelopes can be ***personally carried*** by the President as he walks down the center aisle of the House Chamber, and he then would hand them to the President of the Senate (Vice President Cheney) and the Speaker before beginning his Address; **or**, 2) they can be ***placed on the podium by his staff***, in the moments before the President appears, and when the President reaches the podium he can simply then hand them to the President of the Senate and the Speaker before beginning his Address.

While President's have and may use either option, in the February 2001 and September 2001 addresses to Joint Sessions of the Congress, staff placed the envelopes on the Podium just prior to the President's arrival in the House Chamber.

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
