SUBJECT: Presidential Message to Dr. Ernst Cramer of
Germany

Attached at Tab A is a proposed Presidential message on the occasion of Dr. Cramer's 90th birthday. American Ambassador Dan Coats strongly recommends this congratulatory message.

Born in Germany, Cramer had been imprisoned by the Nazis in the thirties because of his Jewish faith. He was allowed to leave the Buchenwald concentration camp just before war broke out in 1939 and left for America. Ending up at a dairy farm in Mississippi, he decided to join the U.S. Army after Pearl Harbor.

He lost his parents and brother in the Holocaust. In 1945, he decided to stay in his native Germany and worked for more than four decades with the Springer Publishing Group, a conservative media giant in Germany.

We ask that you complete this message by January 24.

I send warm greetings and congratulations on the occasion of your ninetieth birthday. I would like to convey my appreciation for your long and dedicated service to German-American friendship, and to international understanding.

Despite the great personal hardships you endured, and the tragedies visited upon your family under the Nazi dictatorship, your life has been a testament to compassion and reconciliation. You have defended freedom and made a lifelong commitment to democratic values.

As an American citizen by choice, and an American military veteran, you make all Americans proud. As a German citizen who returned to a devastated land to help your native country rejoin the community of nations, you have demonstrated over the past five decades an uncommon selflessness and integrity.

Laura and I extend our best wishes on your birthday.

Vike-Freiberga

John Bridgeland is organizing a major conference on February 17 to enhance civics/American history education in the United States as well as to reinforce the message that America represents a successful model of freedom throughout the world. He wants to invite one prominent foreign leader to address the audience on the "meaning of America" to freedom-loving countries abroad. He reportedly floated the idea with you of inviting Latvian President Vike-Freiberga, and you agreed. We concur that she is a good choice. As a former Canadian, she commands perfect English, but as we have seen at the Prague Summit and elsewhere she is a profoundly good speaker on values and the importance of the struggle for freedom in the transitioning democracies of Europe.

Vike-Freiberga has indicated that she would accept the invitation. She is scheduled to share the stage with you and American historian David McCullough the morning of February 17. It is not yet clear when, in the course of the day, the President would address the audience.

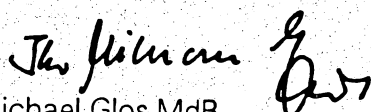

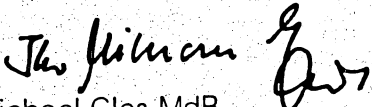
