Good evening. It is always a pleasure to welcome Prime Minister Blair to the United States. Earlier today, I had the special pleasure of signing legislation directing the U.S. Mint to strike a Congressional Gold Medal in honor of Anthony Charles Lynton Blair. Congratulations, my friend.

In his address to Congress this afternoon, Prime Minister Blair showed once again the qualities that have marked his entire career. Tony Blair is a leader of conviction, passion, moral clarity, and eloquence. He is also a true friend of the American people. The United Kingdom has produced some of the world's most distinguished statesmen, and I am proud to be with one of them today.

The close partnership between the United States and Great Britain has been, and remains, essential to the peace and security of all nations. For more than 40 years of the Cold War, we stood together to ensure that the conflicts of Europe did not once again destroy the peace of the world. The duties we accepted were demanding, as we found during the Berlin blockade and other crises. Yet British and American leaders held firm – and our cause prevailed.

Now we are joined in another great and difficult mission. On September 11, 2001, America, Britain, and all free nations saw how the ideologies of hatred and terror in a distant part of the world could bring violence and grief to our own citizens. We resolved to fight these threats actively, wherever they gather, before they reach our shores. And we resolved to oppose these threats, by promoting freedom and democracy in the Middle East – a region that has known so much bitterness and resentment. From the outset, the Prime Minister and I have understood that we are allies in a war – a war requiring great effort, and patience, and fortitude. The British and American peoples will hold firm once again, and we will prevail.

The United States and Great Britain have conducted a steady offensive against terrorist networks and terror regimes. We are dismantling the al-Qaida network, leader by leader, and we are hunting

down terrorist killers one by one. In Afghanistan, we removed the cruel and oppressive regime that had turned that country into a training camp for al-Qaida. And now we are helping the Afghan people to restore their country, and regain self government.

In Iraq, the United States, Britain, and other nations confronted a violent regime that armed to threaten the peace, cultivated ties to terror, and defied the clear demands of the UN Security Council. Saddam Hussein produced and possessed chemical and biological weapons, and was trying to reconstitute his nuclear weapons program. He used chemical weapons in acts of murder against his own people. The UN Security Council passed more than a dozen resolutions demanding that he reveal and destroy all of his prohibited weapons. And a final resolution promised serious consequences if he continued his defiance. The former dictator of Iraq chose his course of action, and, for the sake of peace and security, we chose ours.

The Prime Minister and I have no greater responsibility than to protect the lives and security of the people we serve. Saddam Hussein was a grave and growing threat. Removing that threat was a major advance in the war on terror. Given Saddam's history of violence and aggression, it would have been reckless to place our trust in his sanity or restraint. As long as I hold this office, I will never risk the lives of Americans by assuming the good will of dangerous enemies.

Acting together, the United States, Great Britain, and our coalition partners enforced the demands of the world ... ended the threat from Saddam Hussein's weapons of mass destruction ... rid the Middle East of an aggressive, destabilizing regime ... and liberated nearly 25 million people from decades of oppression. We are now helping the Iraqi people to build a free nation.

In Iraq, as elsewhere, freedom and self-government are hated and opposed by a radical and ruthless few. American, British, and other forces are facing remnants of the fallen regime, foreign terrorists, and other extremists. Their attacks follow a pattern. They target progress and success. They strike at Iraqi police officers who have been trained to enforce order. They sabotage Iraqi power grids that we are rebuilding. They are enemies of the Iraqi people. They seek the return of tyranny – and they will fail.

Our forces in Iraq are going after these killers, and finding them, and destroying them. We are being tested in Iraq. Our enemies are looking for signs of hesitation or weakness. They will find none. We will keep our word. We will finish the task of helping Iraqis make the challenging transition to democracy. Iraq's Governing Council is now meeting regularly. Soon the council will nominate ministers and propose a budget. After decades of tyranny, the institutions of democracy will take time to create. America and Britain will help the Iraqi people as long as necessary. Prime Minister Blair and I have the same goal: The government and the future of Iraq will be in the hands of the people of Iraq.

The creation of a strong and stable Iraqi democracy is not easy, but it is essential. A free Iraq will be an example to the entire Middle East. And the advance of liberty in the Middle East will undermine the ideologies of terror and hatred, and strengthen the security of America, and Britain, and many other nations. This is the work our men and women in uniform are accomplishing every day in Afghanistan and Iraq, accepting risk and sacrifice. This is the work history has given us, and we will complete it.

We are seeing movement toward reform and freedom in other parts of the Middle East. The leadership and courage of Prime Minister Abbas and Prime Minister Sharon are giving their peoples new hope for progress. Other nations can add to the momentum of peace by fighting terror in all its forms. A Palestinian state will not be built upon violence, and terrorists are the chief enemies of Palestinian hopes. The sooner terrorism is prevented and punished by all governments in the region, the sooner the Palestinian flag will rise over a peaceful Palestinian state.

The spread of liberty in Afghanistan, in Iraq, and across the Middle East, would mark a hopeful turn in the history of our time. Great Britain and America will achieve this goal together. And one of the reasons I am confident in our success is the character and leadership of Prime Minister Tony Blair. Mr. Prime Minister, thank you for coming.

THE WHITE HOUSE
JULY 17, 2003**

KEY THEMES

- No closer Ally than U.K.; no better friend and colleague than Tony Blair.
- World is safer and better with Saddam Hussein gone.
- Making progress in Iraq, Middle East.
- Syria and Iran remain impediments to regional stability and Middle East Peace Process.
- Working together to face challenges of 21st Century.

**So far, no weapons of mass destruction have been found.
Was the war based on false intelligence?**

- Had sound reasons to believe that Iraq's WMD programs posed serious threat.
 - Saddam used chemical weapons, and after years of lies admitted to producing biological weapons.
 - According to the U.N., Iraq never accounted for thousands of gallons of biological agents and tons of nerve gas.
 - For twelve years and at the cost of severe economic sanctions, Iraq resisted U.N. inspectors.
 - The U.N. afforded Saddam a final opportunity to cooperate with inspections, but instead he filed a false declaration, blocked private interviews, threatened witnesses, and spied on inspectors.
- Iraq had twelve years to hide its programs, four without Security Council-mandated inspectors. It took inspectors four years from 1991-1995 to uncover Iraq's massive biological weapons program, and even then, the inspectors never discovered any of the weapons themselves.
- It will take time to uncover the full extent of Iraq's WMD programs, but the Iraq Survey Group is interviewing many of the thousands of people involved in Iraq's programs and reviewing hundreds of thousands of documents. Eventually, the truth will be known.

Do you regret citing British intelligence on uranium sales to Iraq from Africa in your State of the Union Address?

- We work closely with the British and value their contribution on a whole range of security issues.
- The authoritative judgment of the U.S. intelligence community at the time, the National Intelligence Estimate, was that Iraq also began vigorously trying to procure uranium ore and yellowcake.
- Intelligence analysis requires making judgments based on sometimes incomplete or contradictory evidence, but in the case of a nation which has attacked its neighbors, used WMD, and supported terrorists, we cannot shrink from tough calls and hard realities.

Tony Blair provided critical support to America in Iraq. What are you doing to help Tony Blair?

- U.S. and U.K. joined forces in Iraq because it was right. Rid the world of a dangerous dictator. Not some kind of quid pro quo.
- As a close Ally, working together with U.K. on a wide range of important issues.
- Won't move forward against any U.K. detainees in military commissions pending further consultations between our governments
- Also exchanged letters so we can share classified defense information more routinely. Makes our close defense relationship even closer.

Will the U.S. receive Lord Goldsmith's delegation next week to talk about the treatment and disposition of U.K. citizens detained at Guantanamo.

- Will of course receive delegation and discuss issues completely and transparently. That is the nature of being close allies.
- Understand British concerns and prepared to work with U.K. to address them.
- Bear in mind that the individuals we are talking about were deeply involved in planning attacks against Americans, through the terrorist network in Afghanistan.
- America and the world are safer with these people under arrest.

Are you laying the groundwork for military action against Syria or Iran?

- Deeply disappointed with Syria's role. Continues to harbor terrorists and is not playing a constructive role for peace in the Middle East.
- Supporting those who reject peace and seek to undermine Prime Minister Abbas's efforts to work with Israel to implement the roadmap.
- Iran also supporting Hamas and Hezbollah. Interfering in Iraq and Afghanistan. Seeking to acquire nuclear weapons.
- These are serious issues and have discussed them fully with PM Blair. Important that the U.S., U.K., and the rest of Europe take a strong common position on these efforts to undermine peace in the region.
- We share a common vision of peace in the Middle East, starting with two states, Israel and Palestine, living side-by-side in peace and security.

Are you asking NATO to take over peacekeeping in Iraq?

- NATO has agreed and is already taking steps to support the Polish-led division for the stabilization force in Iraq. Pleased with level of NATO support we have received.
- Have not sought a wider NATO role at this stage. Something to keep under review.
- Focus first on the needs of the Iraqi people, strengthening security, and the Governing Council.
