^Security Council calls on neighbors to help end conflicts in Congo and Burundi

DAR ES SALAAM, Tanzania (AP) The head of a U.N. Security Council mission to central Africa on Sunday urged the neighbors of Congo and Burundi to cooperate with the United Nations to end the violence and civil conflict that has destabilized much of the region.

"It is for the countries of the sub-region to find a way of building confidence among themselves," Jean-Marc de la Sabliere, France's U.N. ambassador, said at the end of the week-long mission. "The Security Council can help, but it cannot do the job."

On May 30, the Security Council authorized the deployment of a French-led emergency force of 1,400 with a mandate to shoot to kill to Bunia in northeastern Congo where fighting among tribal militia had killed more than 400 civilians. A contingent of U.N. troops already in the town has no mandate to protect civilians or intervene to stop fighting.

De la Sabliere said the Security Council mission would stress that no impunity should be given to those responsible for human rights violations and related crimes in eastern Congo.

"What we have seen on the ground shocked us," de la Sabliere said about the stop in Bunia. "The mission is going back to New York with the feeling that there should be no impunity for crimes and human rights violations which are taking place in the region."

During a brief stop Saturday in Rwanda, which backs a rebel faction in Congo's 5-year civil war and also supports tribal militia in Bunia, council members told President Paul Kagame the world was watching its actions in neighboring Congo.

According to a statement from his office, Kagame replied that he would welcome a stronger U.N. presence in Congo and said the U.N. should ensure that the Congolese government fulfils its commitments under cease-fire and power-sharing agreements meant to bring peace to Congo.

Uganda is reported to be supporting another tribal militia in Bunia. But in an interview Friday in Washington, Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni described as "rumor-mongering" reports that his country was using

the tribal fighters as a proxy force in the struggle to control northeastern Congo's natural resources.

The mission also stopped in Luanda, Angola; the Congolese capital, Kinshasa and Bujumbura, Burundi where de la Sabliere said he would lobby for funding for an African Union force to monitor the implementation of a cease-fire between the transitional government and three of four rebel factions in a nearly decade-long civil war.

If sufficient funds can be raised, troops from South Africa, Ethiopia and Gabon are expected to make up the force to bolster the three-year transitional government that entered its second and final phase on May 1.

There are more than half a million Burundian refugees in camps just inside Tanzania's border with Burundi; some Burundian government and military officials claim the camps have become staging areas for rebels.

De la Sabliere met with Tanzanian President Benjamin Mkapa Sunday and was also expected to meet with Peter Nkurunziza, head of a faction of the rebel Forces for the Defense of Democracy that has signed a cease-fire but is not respecting it.

The war in Congo erupted in August 1998 when neighboring Rwanda and Uganda sent troops into Congo to support rebels seeking to oust then-Congolese President Laurent Kabila. They accused him of supporting insurgents from their countries whom they said were threatening regional security. Zimbabwe, Namibia and Angola backed Kabila. The foreign troops have since withdrawn, but fighting among government forces, rebels and tribal militia continues.

The conflict in Burundi broke out in October 1993 after paratroopers from the Tutsi minority that has effectively controlled the country since independence in 1962 assassinated the country's first democratically elected president from the Hutu majority.
