ARMY ORDNANCE AND CHEMICAL WARFARE PLANTS

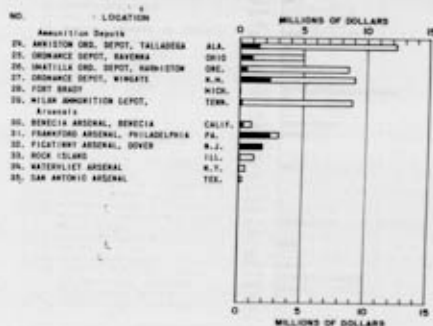
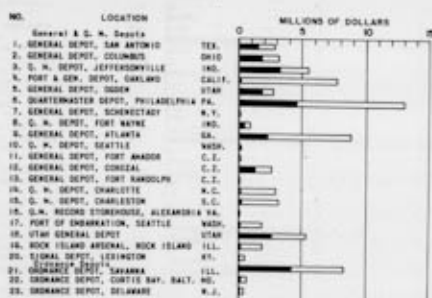
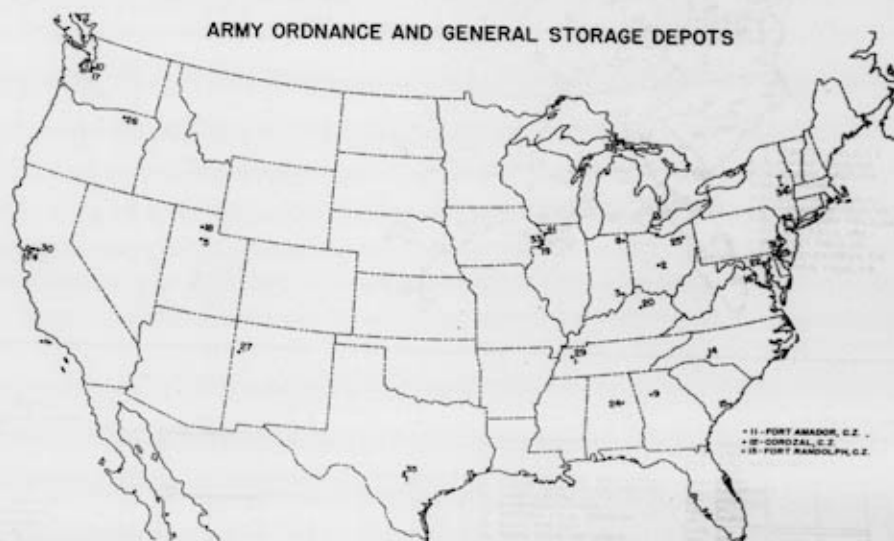

ARMY ORDNANCE AND GENERAL STORAGE DEPOTS

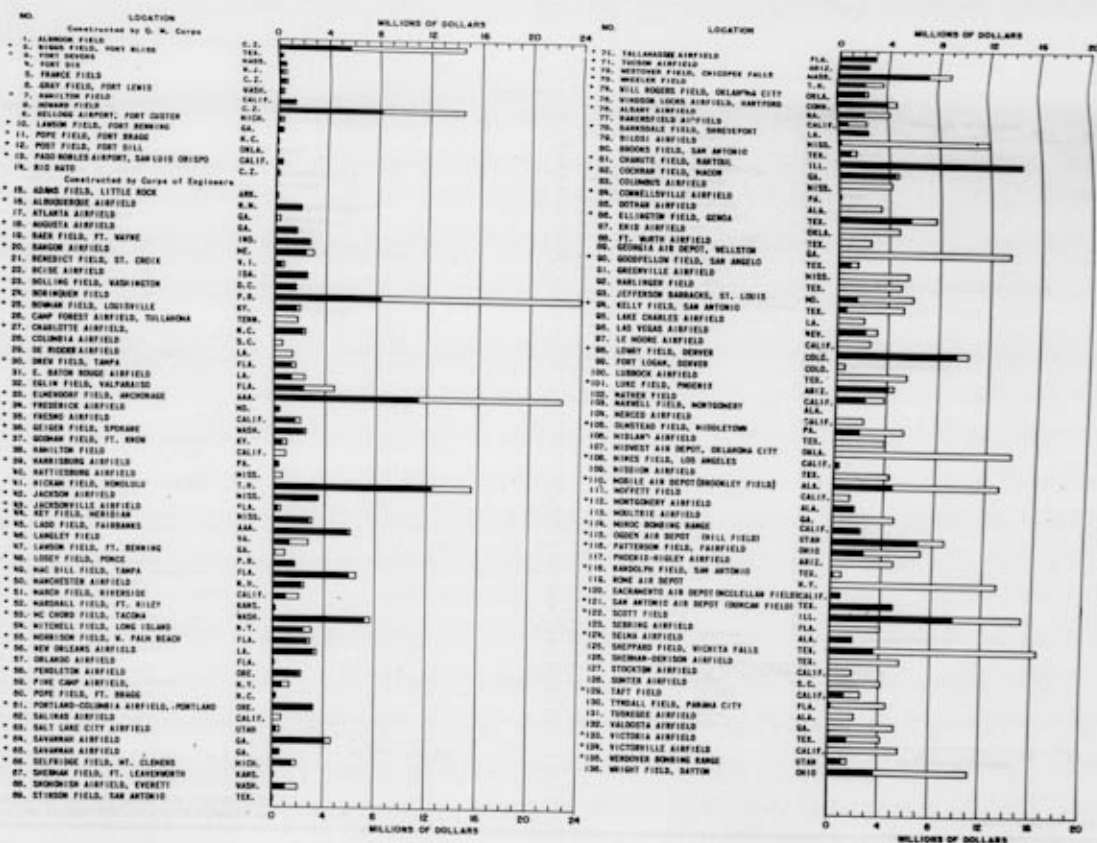

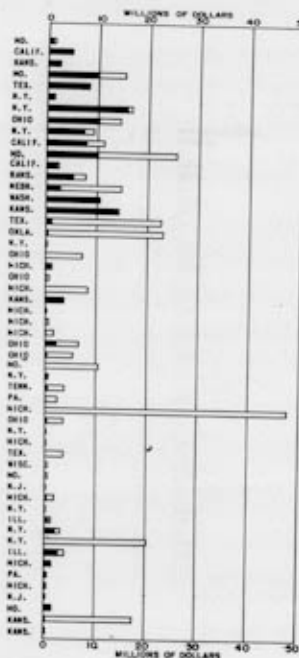

ARMY AIRPLANE MANUFACTURING FACILITIES



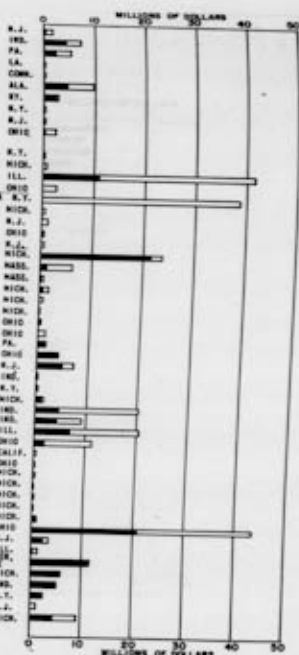

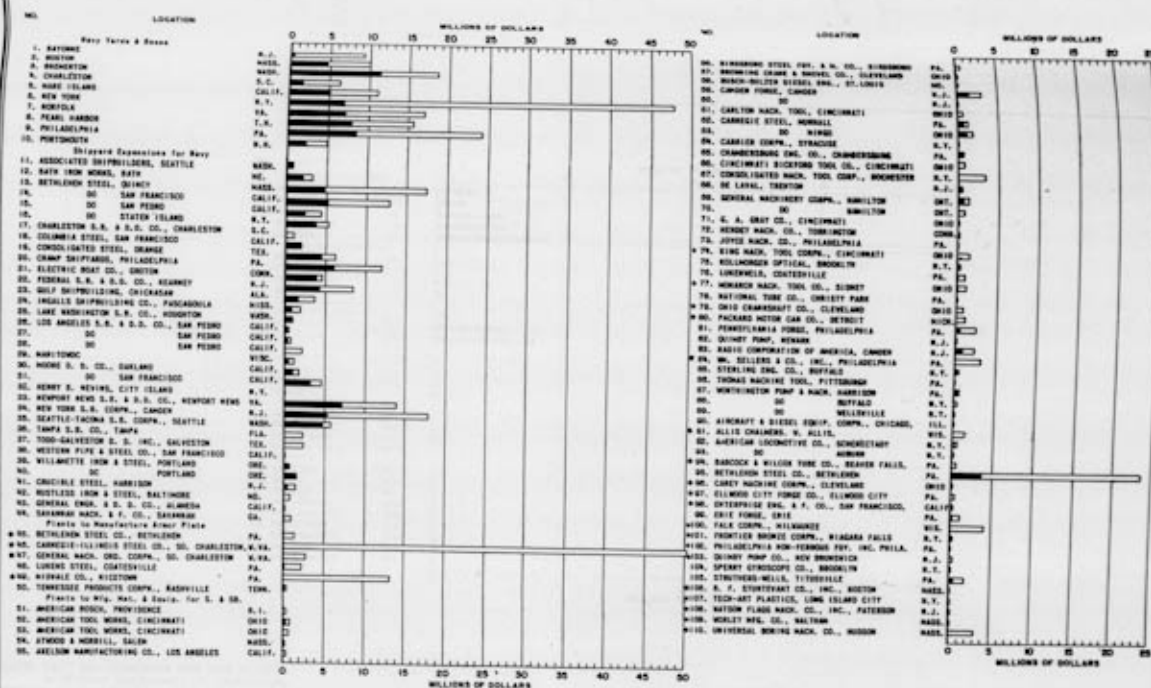

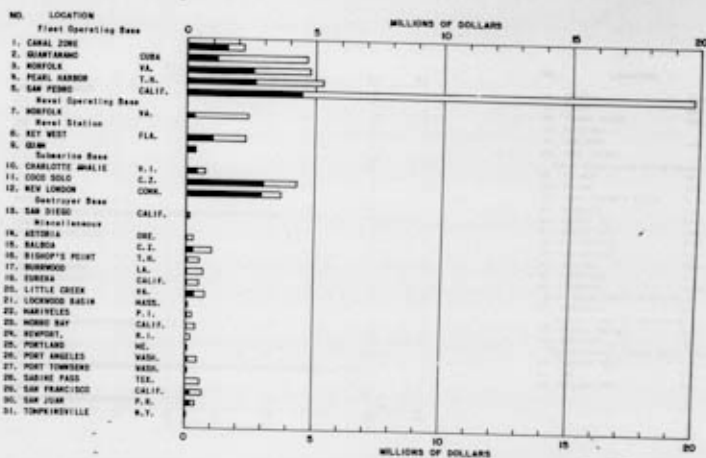

NAVAL AIR STATIONS AND BASES (INCLUDING MARINE CORPS)



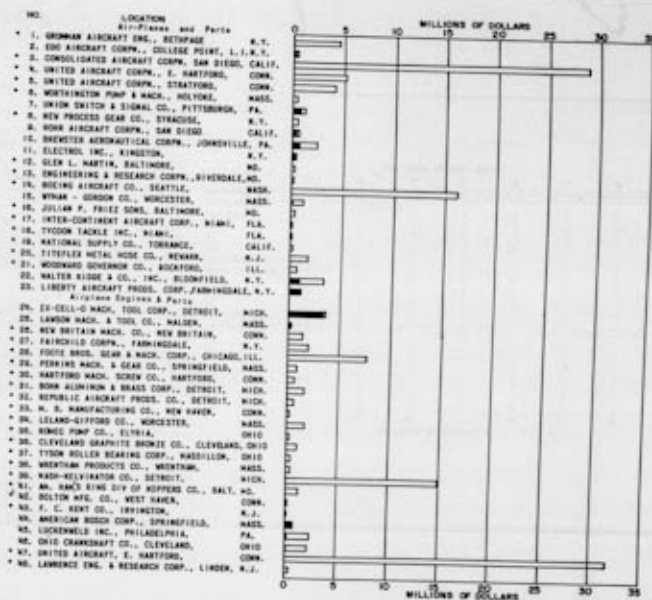
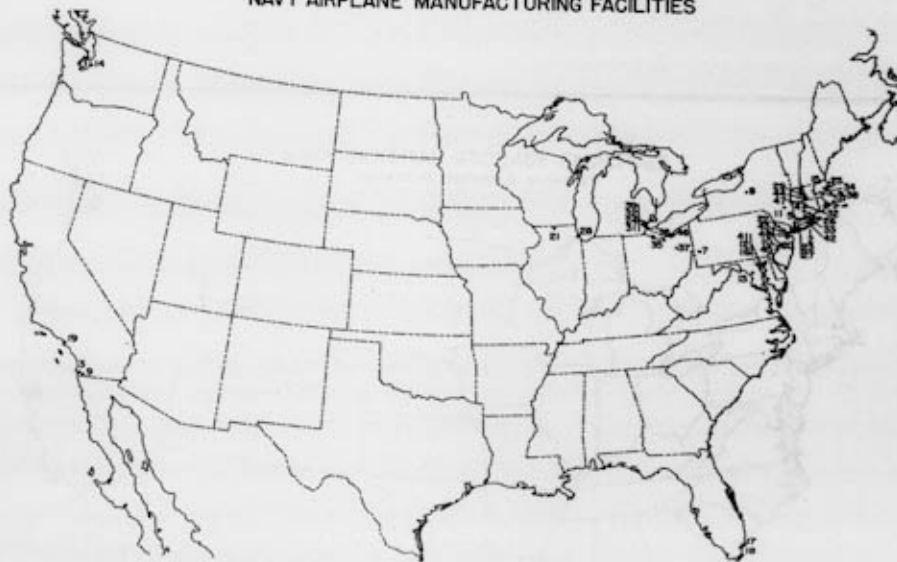

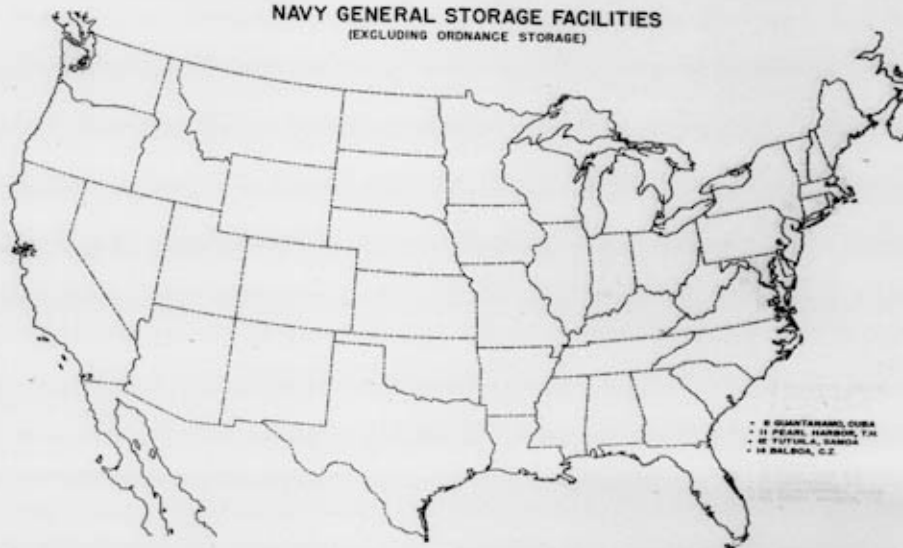

NAVY ORDNANCE FACILITIES

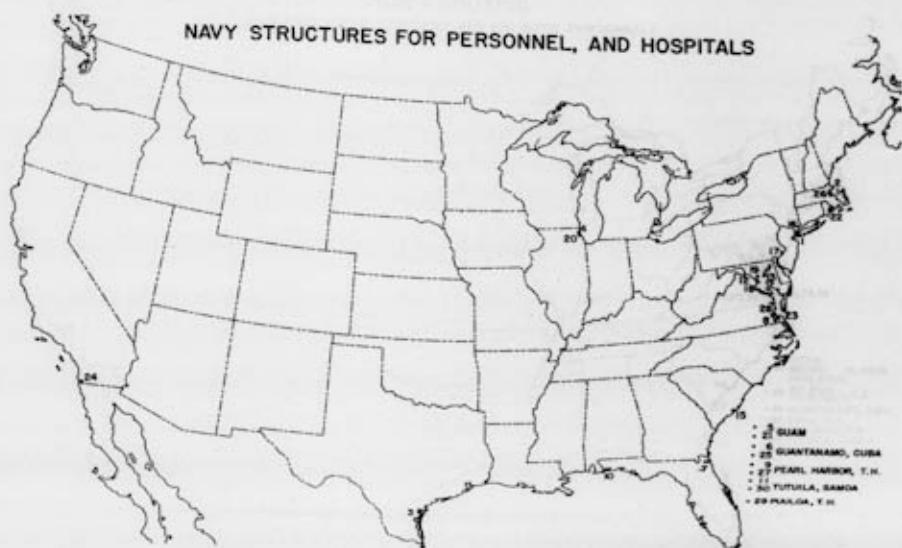
