DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO: KILLING OF UN
OBSERVERS; STATUS OF MULTINATIONAL FORCE FOR ITURI

May 20, 2003

Key Points

- The United Nations Observer Mission for the Congo (MONUC) has reported that two of its military observers were killed in the northeastern Congolese province of Ituri. The bodies of the two observers, of Jordanian and Malawian nationalities, were found several kilometers north of Bunia, the capital city of Ituri. We understand that MONUC is sending investigators to the area to obtain further information on the circumstances of their deaths.
- The United States deplores these murders in no uncertain terms and reminds all parties to the conflict in the Congo of their responsibilities to ensure the safety of UN observers. We support MONUC efforts to bring the perpetrators of this crime to justice.
- The situation in the Ituri region remains extremely volatile. On May 16, the belligerents to the conflict in Ituri signed an agreement to end the fighting, but we have continued reports of violence in the region.

- We understand that the Governments of France and South Africa are seriously considering UN Secretary General Kofi Annan's request to send a military intervention force to the Ituri region. The UN has requested this international assistance to ensure that the situation in Ituri does not further imperil the Congolese peace process. We understand that the Government of France and the UN are still discussing the specifics of such an intervention.
- **We deplore** the violence in Ituri and call for an immediate cessation of hostilities there.
- **We stress** the need for regional states, especially Rwanda, Uganda, and the DRC government, to ensure that they support a peaceful resolution to the fighting in Ituri and refrain from involving themselves, either directly or indirectly, in the conflict.
- **We urge** the Congolese armed groups in the Ituri region to immediately cease hostilities, establish relations, and work constructively with the Ituri Pacification Committee (IPC).
- **We strongly support** the role of the Ituri Pacification

Committee (IPC) to develop a mutually acceptable, inclusive governmental authority in the region which can be supported by the soon-to-be formed transition government in Kinshasa. We urge all armed groups to work with the Ituri Pacification Committee, and the UN in ensuring an end to hostilities and ensuring humanitarian access to people throughout Ituri. We have provided \$250,000 to support the work of the Ituri Pacification Committee, with its ultimate objective being the creation of a Congolese political and security mechanism.

- We support the coordination of efforts by the Kinshasa transitional government Follow-Up Committee to develop and support, in conjunction with the Ituri Pacification Committee, an integrated security structure in Ituri.
- The UN Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has a limited authority to protect civilians in imminent danger, when its forces are sufficient. The Uruguayan MONUC detachment deployed in Bunia is a reserve guard force, and patrols within the city are limited.
- **IF ASKED:** Do you support the Government of France as a force provider? We support a multinational force to be deployed to Ituri and believe the French are the most likely country to lead such a force at this time.

BACKGROUND

We have made numerous bilateral and multilateral interventions to regional states regarding the grave humanitarian situation in the Ituri region and have called on all parties to cease exacerbating the tense ethnic climate there. We have also supported the inclusion of strong language condemning the violence in the Ituri region in a number of UN Security Council resolutions and presidential statements.

We have encouraged Uganda, the DRC, and other Congolese parties to move forward with the IPC's plan of action and have provided \$250,000 in funding for the IPC.

The political, military, and humanitarian situation in the Ituri region of northeastern Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) continues to deteriorate. Despite formation of the Ituri Pacification Committee (IPC), charged with creating a political and security framework in the Ituri region, and the deployment of a 700-strong UN Organization Mission in the Congo (MONUC) force reserve detachment to Ituri's capital, Bunia, the situation there has worsened. Ugandan troops completely withdrew from Bunia May 7 and are scheduled to completely withdraw from the DRC within a few days. Although the DRC government deployed 600 Rapid Intervention Police to Bunia earlier this month, this force has failed to play any stabilizing role in the area.

The UN Department of Peacekeeping (DPKO) has held several emergency UN Security Council (UNSC) briefings, during which it highlighted the growing insecurity in Bunia. General lawlessness currently exists in Bunia, and mobs have surrounded MONUC headquarters and the Bunia airport, which MONUC forces are guarding. Congolese Hema militia groups declared themselves in control of Bunia May 10, but fighting, heavy at times, continues throughout the city. The 6,000-10,000 Congolese refugees at the airport in Bunia lack food, water, or sanitation.

Although there is no evidence of widespread ethnic killing between the Hema and Lendu ethnic groups, the UN is profoundly concerned that civilians are at risk and has asked that the UNSC consider the deployment of trained troops capable of acting in a non-permissive environment. The UN SYG has requested international assistance, and the Government of France has agreed, in principle, contingent

upon several condition, to send an intervention force to Ituri. The Government of France and the UN are currently discussing the modalities of such a deployment.

The US Government is currently leading discussions in Kinshasa among donor countries regarding options to defuse the situation in Ituri, including the formation of an integrated Congolese security mechanism under the auspices of the IPC and MONUC.

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
