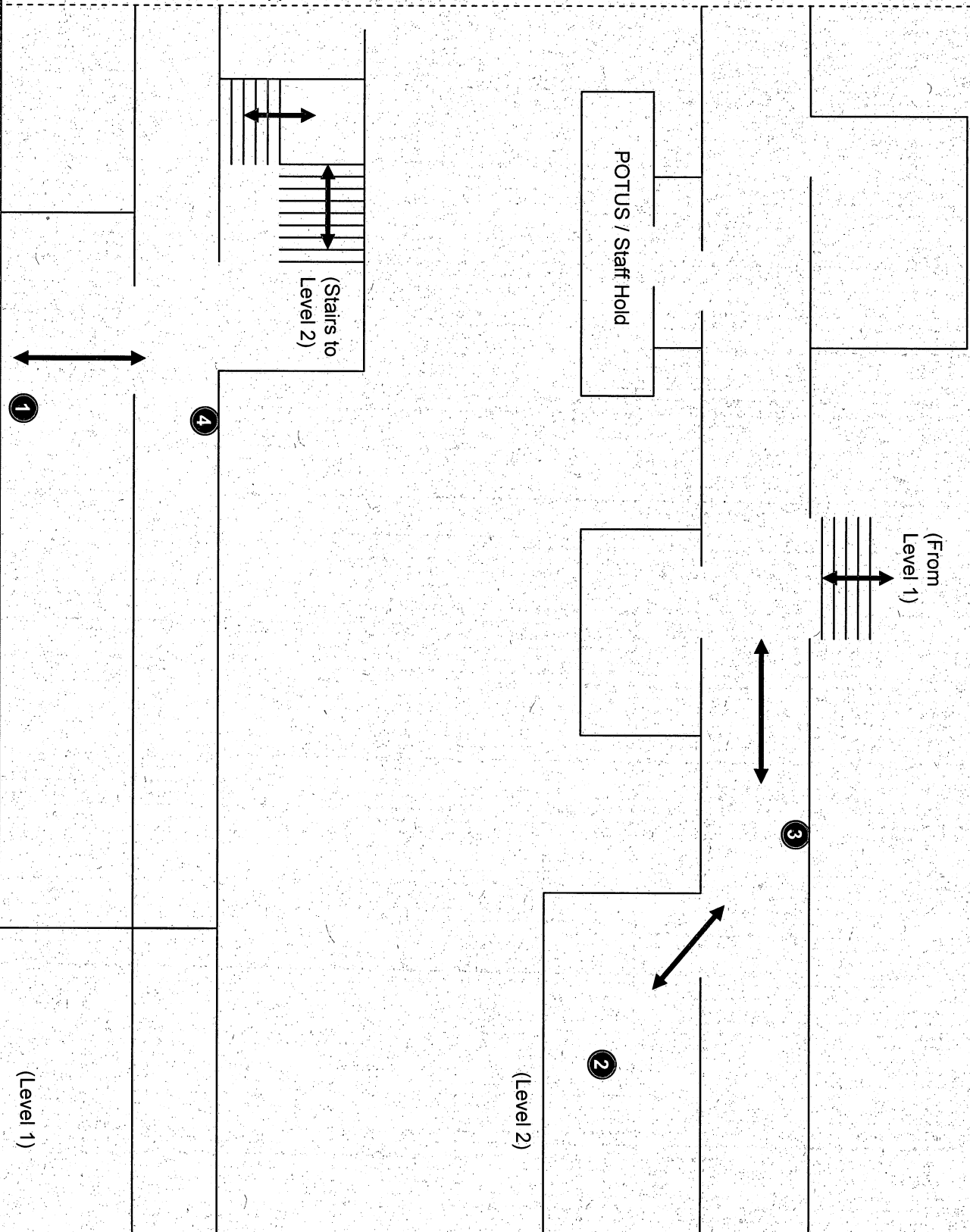

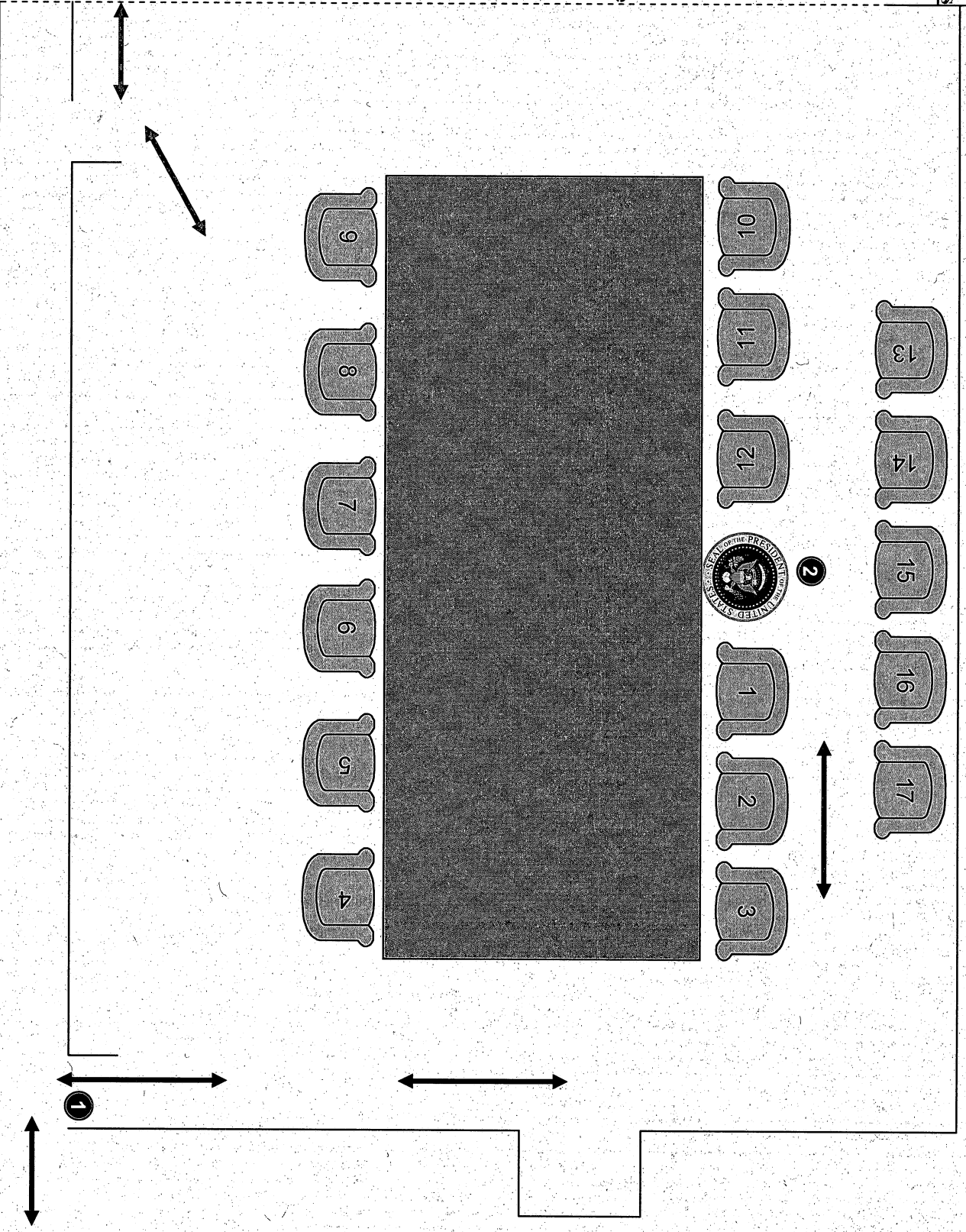

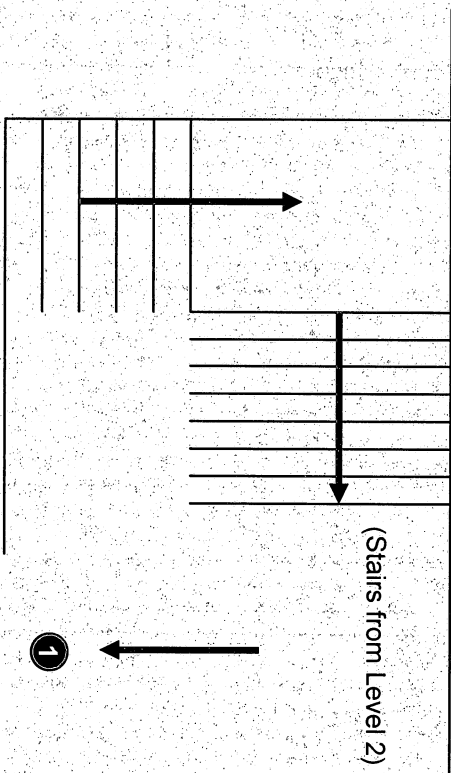
Briefing Diagram
