Item Converter M-134 has been adjusted to reflect actual status of contracts for this item. No deliveries have been made, no stocks are on hand.

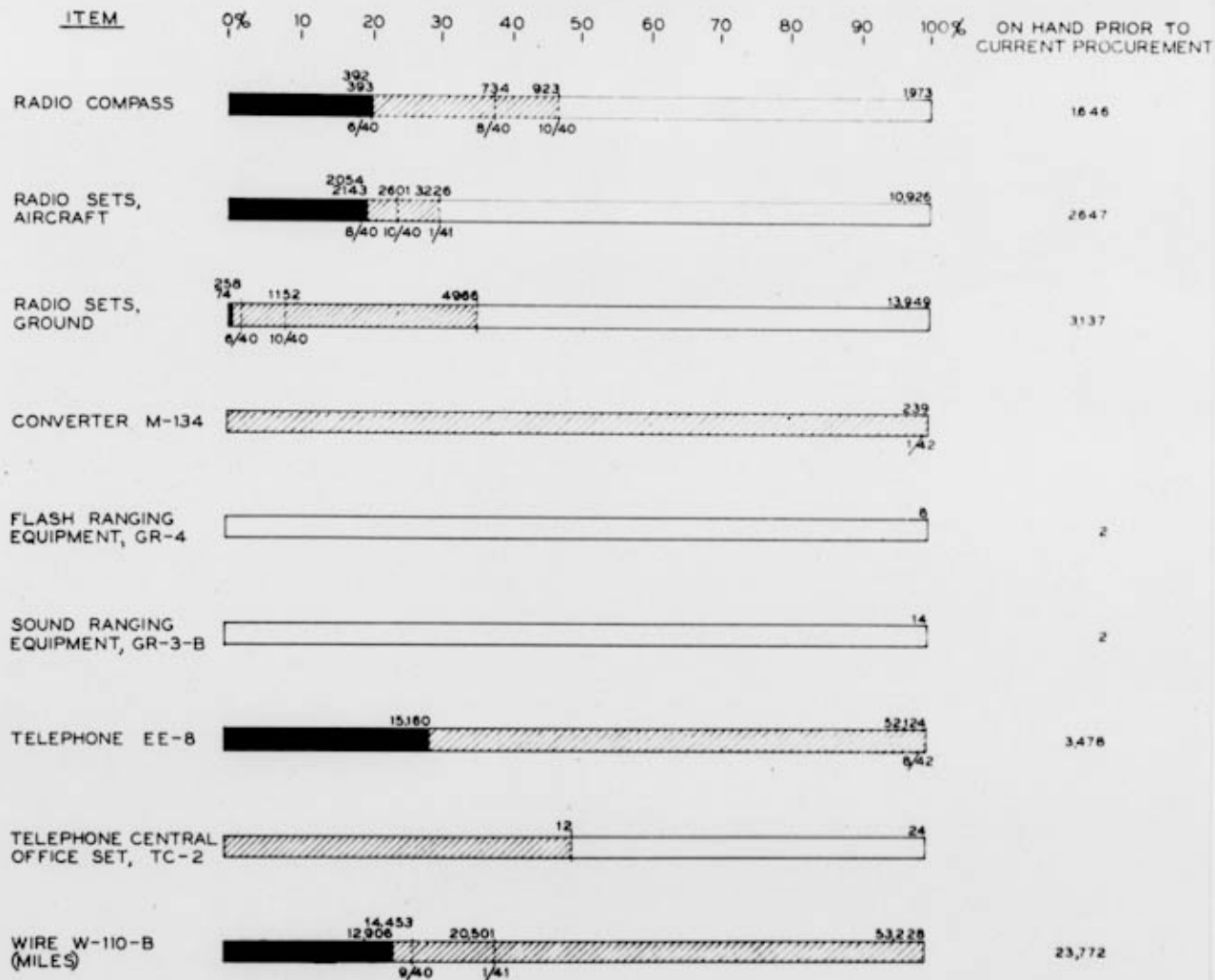

Binaural Trainers, M2

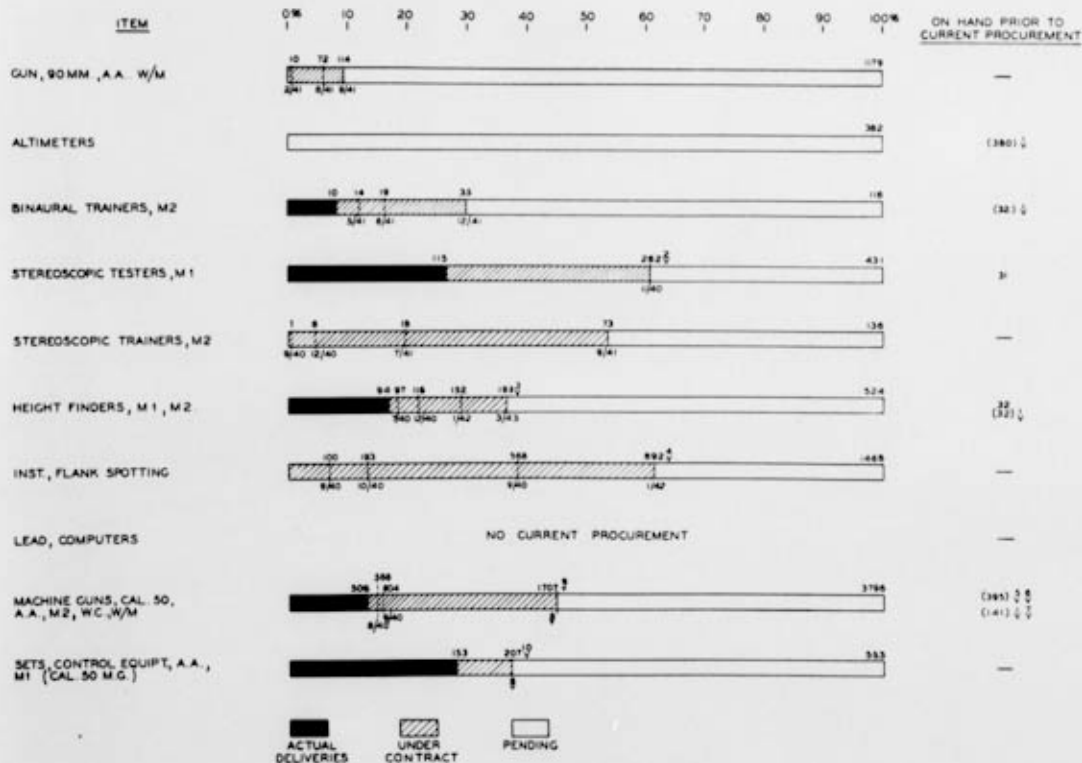

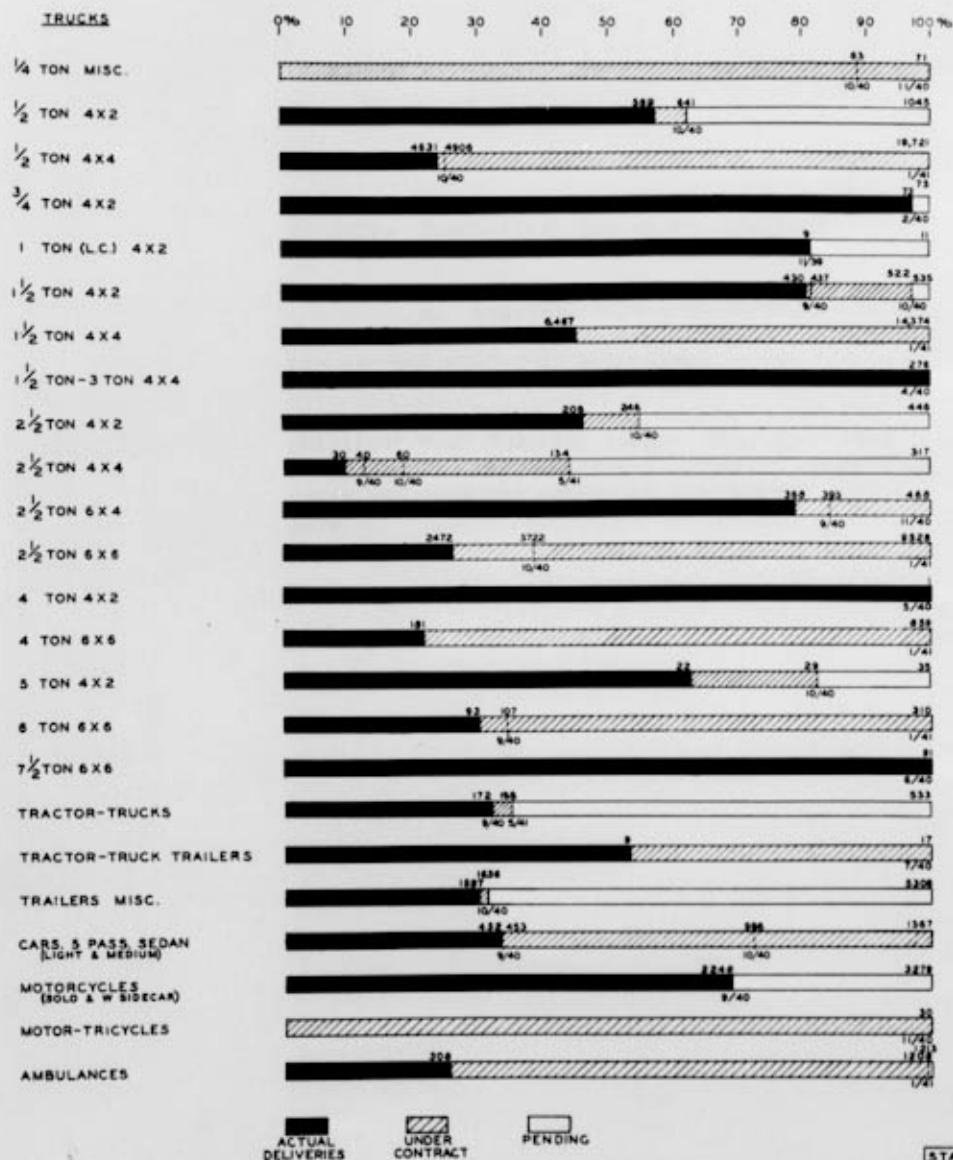
