for action cite SPLLA and NAJRC NAF 535 signed Eisenhower.

Since French cruisers Suffren, Duquesne, Tourville, Duguey Trouin, Jeanne Darc are not to go to the United States for major overhaul, please advise whether local routine overhauls to extent necessary to keep them in service for limited operations in accordance with CCS 358 paragraph 5 is primarily British or US responsibility assuming in either case dockyard labour at port selected would be primarily French. For reasons of operational congestion with higher priority ships, CINC MED does not wish refits to be carried out inside Mediterranean and would prefer work done at Casablanca as opportunity offers. Decision requested whether demands for repair material should be made by Port Commandant concerned in accordance with CCS 358 paragraph 18 or whether ship repair materials for such refits will be furnished to French as part of their monthly rearmament tonnage allocation, details being arranged by Fenard Mission with appropriate agencies. Latter procedure since it gives flexibility for transfer of material as between British or US port according to circumstances at time of overhaul. Items required will include boiler and condenser tubes and electric cable, in all of which French are deficient. First case occurring for decision under paragraph 2 is

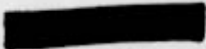

To Eisenhower, Freedom Algiers, from the Combined Chiefs of Staff, (FAN 272)

CCS 358 (revised), which consolidates all papers regarding policy and rearmament of French Naval Vessels has been forwarded to CG NATO, CINCMED, and Commander 8th Fleet.

Your paragraph 3 French should conform to policy laid down in CCS 207/10 and reaffirmed in CCS 358 (revised) of dealing through its own agencies in Washington to represent matters to Combined Chiefs of Staff and other Allied agencies. More details in referenced papers. There is no objection to CG NATO and CINCMED as theater representative of own Chiefs of Staff having officers at French Admiralty at Algiers to keep in touch with French and handle matters affecting their own interests.

Your paragraph 4 there is no objection to CINCMED representing you in matters of employment of forces and policy in your theater. However all matters of policy maintenance and supply must be in agreement with CCS directives.

Your paragraph 5 covered in referenced papers. In general terms policy proposals from French Admiralty should be made via Chief of French Naval Mission in Washington to Commander in Chief US fleet as Executive Agent of CCS information to British Admiralty Delegation.

Your paragraph 6 procedure for rearmament and supply fully covered in CCS 358 (revised). Your attention especially invited to paragraph 23 which provides for sources of supply based upon immediate naval control by US or British Naval Command. Further employment of Richelieu will be in accordance with COMINCH message 26215 October 7. Referenced papers cover cruisers and Jean Bart.

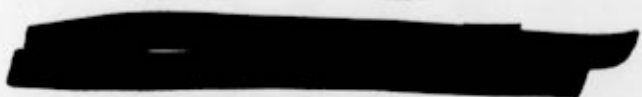

IF DE GAULLE AND GIRAUD DO NOT AGREE IN NEAR FUTURE FOREIGN OFFICE MIGHT PROPOSE REVISION OF EXISTING CHURCHILL- DE GAULLE AGREEMENTS. IF THEY DO AGREE AN ANGLO AMERICAN ARRANGEMENT WITH THE NEW UNIFIED FRENCH ORGANIZATION WOULD BE NECESSARY.

MY FEELING IS THAT THE FRENCH NATIONAL COMMITTEE IS DELIBERATELY BRINGING ABOUT THESE INCIDENTS IN THE HOPE OF FORCING US TO ADOPT THE PRESENT BRITISH POLICY AND TO RECOGNIZE DE GAULLE IN HIS STAND THAT ANY ARRANGEMENTS WE MAKE WITH THE FRENCH IN NORTH AFRICA
