I have been invited to take part in a panel discussion of the Atlantic Partnership Program, a young leaders forum sponsored by the Council of Foreign Relations, about trans-Atlantic relations. (I have taken part in this forum since 1997.)

The conference dates are January 30 to February 1, 2003 in Washington. I have been asked to speak at the first panel on the morning of January 30. The topic for the panel is "The Trans-Atlantic Project after Prague and Copenhagen."

The Council on Foreign Relations has a strict rule that remarks and discussion at these seminars are strictly off-the-record. My remarks would be informal (no written text) and would address our early thinking about priorities for the May 2004 NATO Summit.

There is no remuneration for participation. Lunches and dinners will be provided to conference participants (although I have no plans to attend them at this time). The ethics regulations provide that when an employee is assigned to participate as a speaker or panel participant or otherwise to present information on behalf of the agency at a conference or other event, his acceptance of an offer of free attendance at the event on the day of his presentation is permissible when provided by the sponsor of the event. Under the regulations, free attendance includes acceptance of food furnished to all attendees as an integral part of the event.

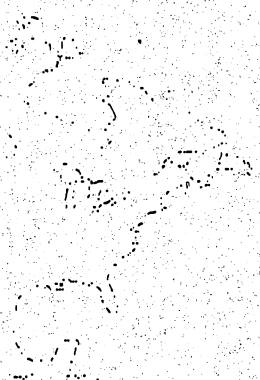

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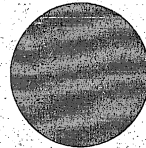

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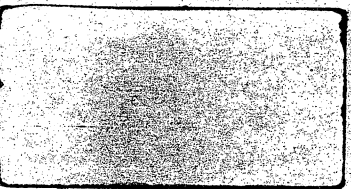
