After discussion with Harriman, have decided that Hill and I will return to Washington to report. Harriman has suggested to the State Department that he be recalled for a brief visit, but so far have not had a reply. He is not in a position to urge State Department approval for his return, but I am convinced, and I know that he agrees, that it is extremely important that he submit a first-hand report on the situation existing here prior to the San Francisco Conference.

Hill and I will wait for a day or two to see what action is taken on Harriman's return and accompany him if it is approved; otherwise, we shall come on by ourselves.
