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Diagrams Show Interest in Nuke Plants

WASHINGTON -- Diagrams of American nuclear power plants found by U.S. forces in Afghanistan show al-Qaida's interest in striking them, but it's unclear how far along those plans were, a defense official says.

In addition, documents recently uncovered in a suspected al-Qaida safe house in Kabul include rudimentary designs for a nuclear weapon, according to an unclassified U.S. intelligence report released on Wednesday.

The discoveries highlight the dangers posed by the terrorist network, officials said.

Military officials are unaware of any finds noting specific times or operatives who would conduct an attack on a nuclear power plant. Instead, the documents seem to be part of al-Qaida's research and planning effort, and they provide insight to the terrorist group's thought process in designing possible attacks, said the official, speaking on the condition of anonymity.

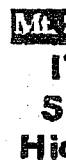
Some of the material recovered appears to be from public sources such as magazines. It is not known how al-Qaida came by the rest.

In his State of the Union address Tuesday night, President Bush said, "The depth of their hatred is equaled by the madness of the destruction they design. We have found diagrams of American nuclear power plants and public water facilities, detailed instructions for making chemical weapons, surveillance maps of American cities, and thorough descriptions of landmarks in America and throughout the world."

The discoveries Bush mentioned prompted an FBI warning to law enforcement agencies earlier this month, telling them to be vigilant around utilities, nuclear plants and water facilities, said homeland security spokesman Gordon Johndroe.

Since Sept. 11, the NRC has advised plants to be on alert, and some states have sent National Guard troops to augment the security forces at a handful of plants.

Paul Leventhal, president of the nonproliferation advocacy Nuclear Control Institute, said Bush's statements raise questions about the

US forces unleashed wave after wave of warplanes, "carpet-bombing" Taliban frontlines, while Americans steelled themselves for new terror strikes which authorities warned could be imminent.

In the first all-day bombardment of Taliban frontlines Wednesday, US bombers dropped salvos of bombs on Afghanistan, haven of terror suspect Osama bin Laden, as military planners warned more assaults using Vietnam-War era B-52s were on the way.

But on the home front of President George W. Bush's war on terrorism, officials admitted they were no closer to finding the masterminds behind a bio-terror scare, which Wednesday claimed a fourth life.

And Bush warned: "I put the country on alert for a reason," as security services remained at top alert after government warning that new terror attacks could come within days, seven weeks after strikes on New York and the Pentagon. Opposition troops battling the Taliban in Afghanistan, greeted the new intensity of US airstrikes on Taliban frontline on the Shomali plain, 50 kilometers (30 miles) north of Kabul with delight.

"Today is a better day. If this keeps going the Taliban will be weakened and the frontlines will collapse," said an enthusiastic commander, Alu Zaqi.

At least one B-52 high altitude bomber was seen streaking through the skies over Afghanistan.

Pentagon officials declined to confirm the sighting, but Rear Admiral John Stufflebeem, asked to confirm 'carpet-bombing' raids said: "the B-52s are being utilized in areas all over the country, including on Taliban forces in the north."

"We do use it, we have used it and will use it when we need to."

US Defense Secretary Donald Rumsfeld confirmed late Tuesday that US troops on the ground in Afghanistan were directing air strikes and coordinating supply operations for the opposition.

Intelligence sources in Northern Afghanistan estimated the number of US personnel in the country at around 40, while the Taliban have claimed that 500 US and allied forces are with the regime's enemies.

The strikes have also, however, brought misery to Afghan civilians, undermining support for the US campaign among its allies and triggering a huge exodus of angry, hungry refugees towards neighbouring Pakistan.

Suhail Shaheen, deputy Taliban ambassador to Islamabad, told reporters that "1,500 innocent men,

women and children" had been killed by the US strikes.

But White House spokesman Ari Fleischer hit back : "our nation is going through a massive effort to make certain that everything is done with an eye toward humanitarian needs."

"Our nation can take a lot of pride in the fact that our military planners and the people who carry out their missions try as hard as possible -- more than most -- to avoid civilian casualties."

The US Agency for International Development (USAID) said it was buying 11.2 million dollars in Central Asian wheat and foodstuffs to help feed Afghans during the coming winter amid dire warnings of a catastrophic refugee crisis.

As the United States pounded Taliban positions in Afghanistan, a domestic bio-terror scare claimed another life.

Kathy Nguyen, 61, worked in a supply room at the Manhattan Eye, Ear and Throat Hospital and had no known link to the media and government offices which are known to have received anthrax-laced letters, baffling investigators.

Four people have now died and 11 are known to be sick from anthrax infections.

Officials all but admitted they had hit a brick wall in a huge probe into the scare and are yet to tie it to bin Laden, top suspect in the September 11 assaults.

"I am not in the position to say we are on the brink of making an announcement," Attorney General John Ashcroft said. "We have no progress to report at this time."

Ashcroft put Americans on high alert for more terror attacks on Monday. Precautions included closing airspace around nuclear power stations -- which experts fear could be possible terror targets for members of bin Laden's al-Qaeda network.

Federal agents scrambled to track down six men -- described as Middle Eastern in appearance and carrying Israeli passports who were carrying box cutters and maps showing the locations of US nuclear power plants. The men were stopped at the weekend but released when their passports were found to be in order.

The trauma of attacks on New York and the Pentagon and lingering anxiety of more attacks, has badly tempered the US economic outlook.

Data released on Wednesday showed the economy had shrunk for the first time in eight years and was probably in recession, confirming that the "events of September 11th have really shocked the nation," Bush said in a speech.

On the diplomatic front, the United States and Britain set about the task of cementing international support for their campaign with renewed vigor.

Rumsfeld will travel to Moscow then visit central Asia, Pentagon spokeswoman Victoria Clarke said.

And pressing home the diplomatic offensive, British Prime Minister Tony Blair flew in to Saudi Arabia for talks with King Fahd and Jordan, after earlier differing sharply with Syrian President Bashar al-Assad on the meaning of terrorism during a visit to Damascus.

A key thrust of the US campaign has appeared designed to fracture the unity of the Taliban, its military cohesion, and various alliances with local Afghan warlords.

"I can say that their command and control has been cut, severely degraded," said Stufflebeem. "They

are having extreme difficulty communicating one to the other."

But the Taliban Foreign Minister, Wakil Ahmed Mutawakel, dismissed speculation of a schism in the militia.

"There is no split in the Taliban. This is the claim of our opponents. The decisions of our government are in the hands of our people," he said.
