35% Increase in Overseas Shipping

1. In the past nine months, there have been 243 departures of Spanish ships from home ports on overseas voyages, a traffic increase of 35% over the 180 Spanish overseas sailings for the same period of 1942. This increased volume and activity of Spanish shipping is especially noticeable in Spanish traffic to the United States and the River Plate. For Spanish economy, the most important services are the grain ships from Argentina and the tanker shuttle service bringing Spanish oil requirements from Aruba-Curacao.

2. Trade routes and volume of shipping activity are illustrated on chart appended which shows the relative volume of Spanish overseas shipping traffic for the current nine-month period, measured for each route by the number of departures from Spanish ports, from following tabulation:

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River Plate Grain Traffic

3. Spain-River Plate merchant traffic totaling 94 sailings for the first nine months of 1943, compared to 75 in 1942 period, remains the most active avenue for contraband and espionage open to the axis between Europe and America. Sailings of better than ten vessels per month in this service represents the largest and most important single Spanish trade route, and dissipates the general misconception that South America-Europe trade is of small consequence.

Brazilian Trade

4. Coffee and cotton cargoes have been the chief attraction for Spanish vessels in the Brazilian trade, in which there have been 16 sailings in 9 months. Recent arrangements for purchases of cotton in the United States account in part for 36% drop in this traffic. Vessels in this service, with the exception of the "Cabo" passenger liners, ordinarily trade no further south than Santos. Contraband on these vessels is being discouraged by more thorough searches by Brazilian authorities, which have resulted in offloading of contraband and excess stores.

West African Trade

5. The four sailings monthly to West Africa are largely for Spanish colonial trade, particularly with Fernando Po and Rio Muni, although occasional calls are made at non-Spanish ports. Traffic has remained fairly stable and is of minor consequence, although offering possible avenues for contraband smuggled across colonial borders.

Philadelphia and New Orleans Traffic

6. Sailings of 38 vessels to U.S. ports during first nine months of 1943 compares with 17 for all of 1942. Reduced 1942 traffic is partly explained by cancellation of sailings from February to May as result of sinking of NAVEMAR on 24 January, 1942, while en route from New York to Cadiz. Traffic was renewed on receipt of satisfactory guarantees from the Axis with regard to safety of Spanish ships in North American trade. Subsequent increases in this traffic results from Spain's increased demand for cargo from United States. Vessels departing United States ports have been loaded to 75-80% of capacity, whereas westbound cargoes have averaged only 20% of capacity. Westbound sailings have increased in part due to availability of Spanish pyrite ore cargo and attraction to this trade of former coastal vessels owing to high charter rates.

7. Traffic to New Orleans (16 sailings in 9 months) has expanded due to increased cotton loadings as result of an agreement between the United States and Spain. This traffic is additional to normal sailings of combination passenger and cargo vessels in this trade, inbound via Trinidad and Havana.

Curacao - Aruba Tanker Traffic

8. Of vital importance is the Spanish "life line" oil shuttle service from the Caribbean, regulated by U.S. control of oil loadings. An average of eight Spanish tankers have loaded monthly at Caribbean ports during the period under review, representing a regulated service resulting from the petroleum quotas established by the United States, and from the setting of specific loading dates to reduce time of neutral tankers in areas frequented by United Nation convoys. Any continued disruption of this tanker shuttle service would be well-high fatal to Spanish economy.

Georgetown Sugar Trade

9. Loadings approaching the 102,000 tons of sugar per annum allotted by the British have resulted in increased Spanish sailings (19 in 9-month period) to Georgetown, British Guiana and other British West Indian ports. Vessels usually make directly for Georgetown for partial cargoes, then top off at other British West Indian ports. Sailings to ports in addition to Georgetown are not shown on accompanying chart due to their small volume and space limitations.

West Indies Tramp Traffic

10. Irregular West Indies tramp traffic from Spain (19 sailings in 9 months) has been included in the Trinidad flow line on chart, for convenience, because of space limitations. Vessels in this trade have proceeded to Trinidad for asphalt, to Cuban ports for sugar, and to the Dominican Republic for tobacco.

Route of the "Cabo" Ships

11. Single lines from Trinidad to Buenos Aires on accompanying chart do not purport to show volume of traffic but only the route followed by the passenger liners CABO DE HORNOS and CABO DE BUENA ESPERANZA. These two ships made six voyages in the nine-month period, and are under British contraband control at Trinidad, both outward and home bound.

General Comment

12. Spain's economic existence depends on supplies of grain from Argentina and of oil from Caribbean. Any continued interruption of these shipping services would therefore be fatal, in the absence of adequate food and oil supplies from other sources. These factors underlie the original Spanish nonbelligerent status, as well as the newly adopted "vigilant neutrality" position. Spain's survival therefore depends on continuance of her merchant shipping services overseas. A blockade would be unendurable.

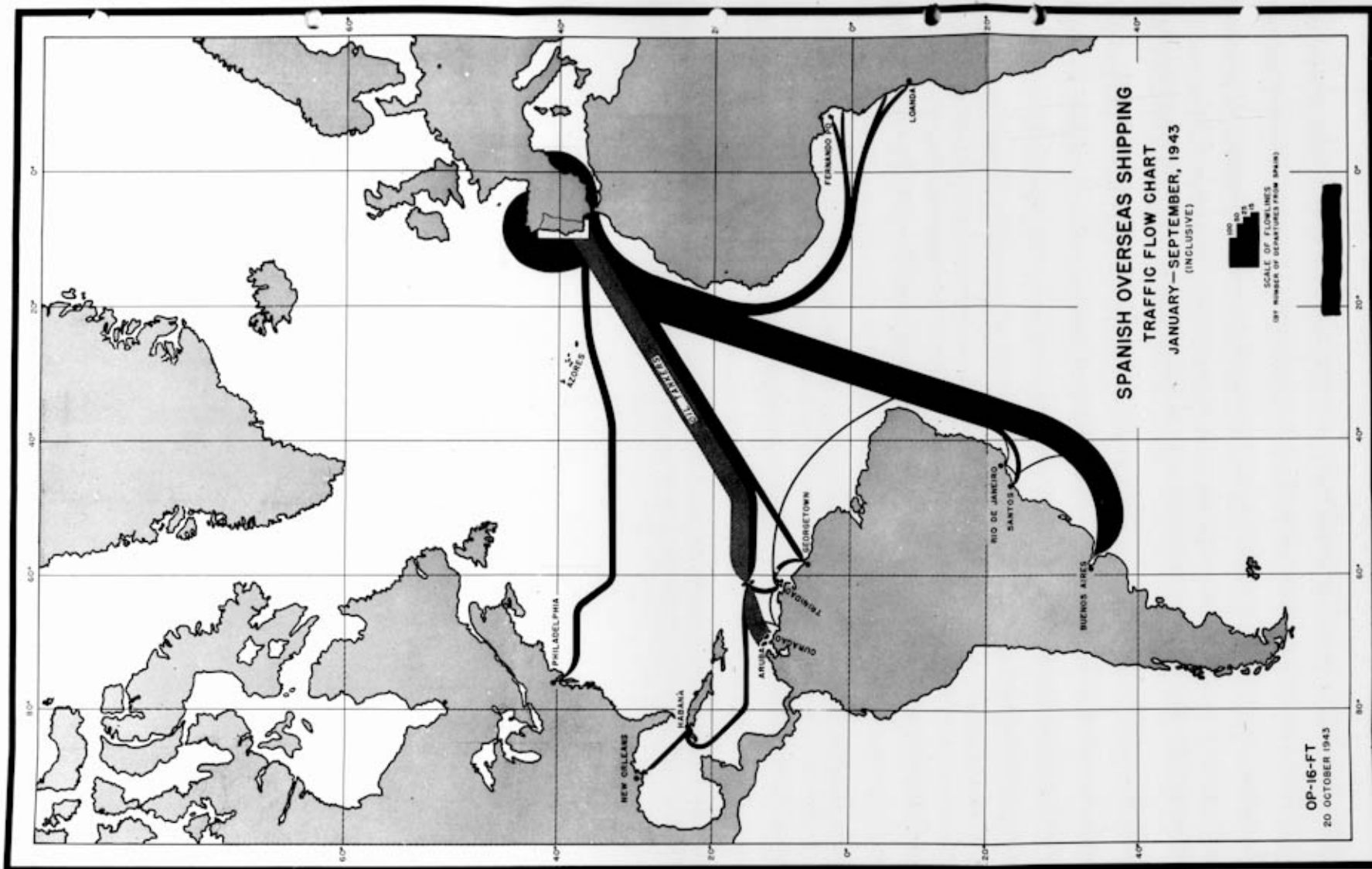
13. Imports from the United States are not decisive. Shipping traffic to U.S. ports could be cut off completely, without seriously affecting Spain's basic situation.

14. Spanish overseas trade is "one way" in character: imports are of paramount importance, while exports are negligible in amount and value.

15. Increased activity in River Plate traffic, which now averages better than 10 sailings per month from Argentine ports, has been a sore point to United Nations intelligence services because of continuous successful running of high-value contraband and intelligence by Axis intermediaries aboard Spanish merchant ships, whose legitimate cargoes are covered by British Navicerts.

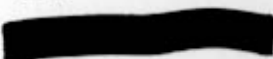

In reply to your memorandum of August 1, 1942 in which the Department of State suggests to the Navy Department that it is advisable to endeavor to stop the Cabo de Buena Esperanza at sea and inaugurate a search at sea to ascertain whether it is carrying large quantities of diamonds or other commodities of direct military use to the Axis, the following action has been initiated.

A search for the Cabo de Buena Esperanza is being directed. The officers conducting search are being instructed that if strategic materials not covered by navicert are found or suspected to be on board the ship is to be sent into an allied or United States port for further action.
