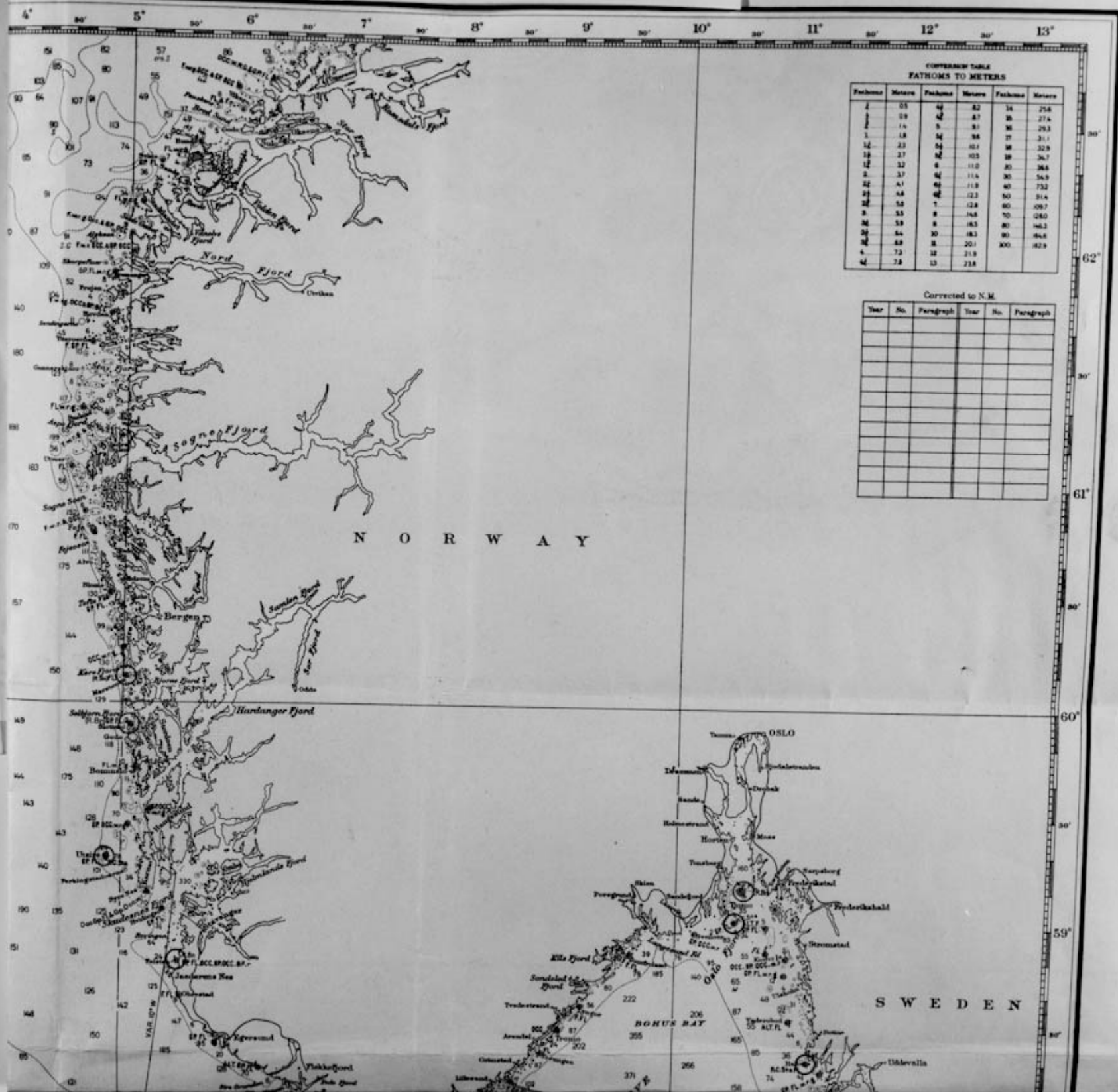

Magnetic variation curves are for 1935

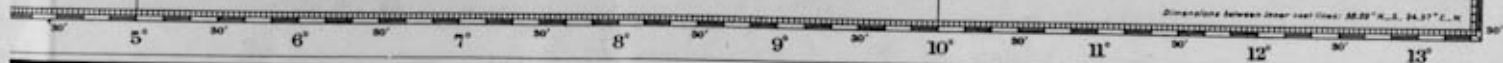
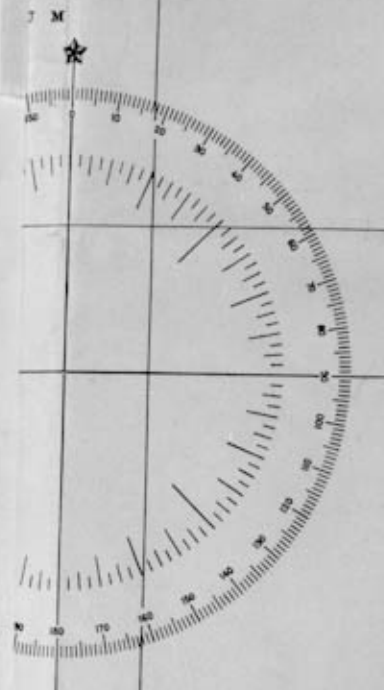
