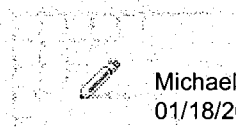

We have also received indications from around the country of multiple casings of sites such as these. You should remain alert to any unusual activity around such facilities, or questions about them. We request you also be alert and report any suspicious accesses to municipal, utility and other public Web sites, and review the security implications of infrastructure content posted to such Web sites.

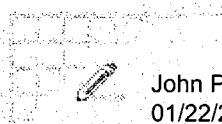

NATIONAL THREAT WARNING SYSTEM--TERRORIST THREAT ADVISORY; CALL FOR CONTINUED VIGILANCE.

THE FBI HAS RECEIVED UNCORROBORATED INFORMATION INDICATING THAT TERRORISTS MAY BE USING U.S. MUNICIPAL AND STATE WEB SITES TO OBTAIN INFORMATION REGARDING LOCAL ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURES, WATER RESERVOIRS, DAMS, HIGHLY-ENRICHED URANIUM STORAGE SITES, AND NUCLEAR AND GAS FACILITIES. ALTHOUGH THE FBI POSSESSES NO SPECIFIC THREAT INFORMATION, RECIPIENTS SHOULD REMAIN VIGILANT TO ANY UNUSUAL ACTIVITY AROUND SUCH FACILITIES.

SHOULD RECIPIENTS RECEIVE OR DEVELOP ANY INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THIS MATTER THEY SHOULD CONTACT THEIR LOCAL FBI OFFICE IMMEDIATELY.

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DOD COST OF THE WAR ON TERRORISM

A sample of the some of the costs of the war on terrorism that DoD has incurred since September 11, 2001:

- **COSTS FOR OPERATIONS ENDURING FREEDOM AND NOBLE EAGLE** - Approximately 40,000 additional DoD personnel were deployed to augment the 22,194 personnel already in the CENTCOM theater to support OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM. Total DoD costs through December 10 has averaged approximately \$1.5 billion per month.
- **MOBILIZATION OF RESERVES AND GUARD** – With the call up of over 70,000 reserve and guard forces for homeland defense, force protection missions and deployments the Department has incurred over \$1.5 billion in expenses.
- **AIR COMBAT PATROLS OVER THE UNITED STATES** – It has cost over \$430 million so far, and will cost over \$1.2 billion during fiscal year 2002 to fly air patrols over U.S. cities to prevent additional attacks. Over 11,800 DoD personnel are assigned to support air missions.
- **NATIONAL GUARD AT AIRPORTS** - The National Guard security support at the nation's airports is averaging approximately \$46 million per month. During this period the number of National Guard personnel assigned has ranged from 7,288 to a high of 9,110 during the holiday period and periods of higher threat.
- **AIRCRAFT LOSSES AND DAMAGE** – In conducting operations in OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM the Department has had losses of six aircraft – although none to enemy fire, including 1- bomber, 1- tanker aircraft, 2 – helicopters, and 2 - unmanned vehicles. The replacement costs for these losses is \$390 million.
- **CARRIER BATTLE GROUP** – The deployment of the additional Aircraft Carrier Battle Group, its Air Wing, and the Amphibious Ready Group to the theater will cost approximately \$900 million per year.
- **GLOBAL REACH** – Using B-2s from Whiteman AFB in Missouri, to Kabul, and back in over 40 hours - costs \$357,000 per round trip, excluding ordnance.
- **REPLACEMENT OF PRECISION GUIDED MUNITIONS** – Over \$373 million has been spent to date to replace only these precision munitions that are used to ensure the minimum number of collateral injuries or deaths during the bombing operations.
- **HUMANITARIAN RELIEF COSTS** - The US has spent \$85 million in operation ENDURING FREEDOM for 194 sorties for airdrops of 2,439,240 daily rations and for the delivery of over 3.48 million pounds of wheat, and 328,200 blankets.

- **PENTAGON REPAIRS** – Through December 1, 2001 the Department has spent over \$480 million in expenses for damage repair and recovery at the Pentagon.

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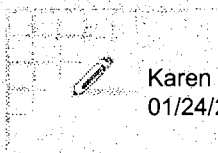

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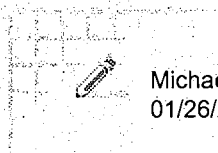
