Strikes in Italy reur 700 Mar 8th official communique admits 200,000 workers of which 120,000 in Milan declared strike on March 1st. Believed to be attempt at general strike which spread to Bergamo Bologna Brescia Como Cuneo Florence Genoa Las Pezzia Novara Turin and Milan.

Apparently started by Communist Socialist and Social Democrat Committees on initiative of Communist Ercoli (Born in Turin and known also as Palmiro Togliatti) formerly belonging to Executive Committee Third International said to have arrived recently from Switzerland.

Strike originally planned coincide with fall of Rome expected end Jan. Postponed for Mar 1st. Strike committee ordered resumption of work Mar 4th which Fascists consider marked failure.

According Minister of Interior expected nevertheless make great impression on Rome.

According to 206 50 Mar 4 Pirelli Plant Bicocca Milano and Fiat of Torino went on strike. Industrial plants of Varese and aviation factory of Sesto Calende did not.

The strike now seems to be nearing its end and laborers in all lines are resuming work so far as can be ascertained. It is now learned that the President received labor leaders 25th after breaking up of demonstration already reported and that they requested release of arrested leaders, dismissal of strike breakers and reemployment of strikers. It is probable that a compromise on these and additional demands regarding unions, minimum wage and social security was reached.

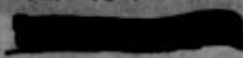
