ARREARS

The word "Arrears", if it appears in the space indicated by the ARROW, means that, as of December 31, 1937, previous TAXES, ASSESSMENTS or WATER CHARGES HAVE NOT BEEN RECORDED AS PAID. If these have not been paid since December 31, 1937, payment should be made IMMEDIATELY.

DISCOUNT

THE SECOND HALF OF THE TAX upon REAL ESTATE which is due on the FIRST DAY of OCTOBER may be paid on the FIRST DAY of APRIL, or at any time thereafter provided that the first half is paid.

Upon such payment of the SECOND HALF a DISCOUNT will be allowed from the date of payment to October 1st at the rate of four per centum per annum.

From the Charter of the City of New York

"Whenever any TAXES or ASSESSMENTS shall remain unpaid for THREE YEARS or any WATER RENT shall remain unpaid for FOUR YEARS the TAX LIEN on the PROPERTY will be SOLD to satisfy such ARREARS of TAXES, ASSESSMENTS or WATER RENTS up to a day to be named in the advertisement of sale as stated therein. The column for ARREARS indicates lots sold for ARREARS or to be sold therefor; ARREARS to be paid and lots redeemed at the Office of the City Collector."

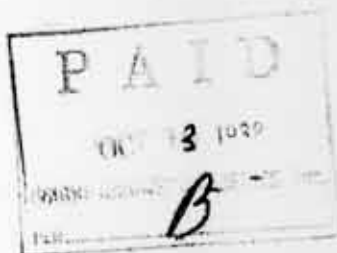
