These figures were obtained from Major Lee of OPD, and are as of February 22, the latest he could give me. The weekly Status Map of March 18 gives an overall strength in this theatre of 325,810.

Major Lee stated that the ratio between divisional units, non-divisional combat units, and service units in this area conforms to G-3 SOP, except for a slight preponderance of AA units due to the extended lines of communication.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF OF THE EUR-AFRICAN GROUP:

Subject: Estimated Strength of Fighting French
Forces in the Fessan Area.

1. Based on a report from a reliable source giving the composition of Fighting French forces now operating in the Fessan area of Libya under the command of General Le Clero, it is estimated that these forces number approximately 3000 officers and men.

2. All units are identified as having come from different bases in the Tchad region of French Equatorial Africa with the exception of one Battalion trained at Camp d'Ornano in the Cameroon and later moved to the Tchad.
