ARMY CHINAIR AND CHEMICAL WARFARE PLANTS

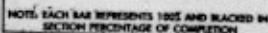

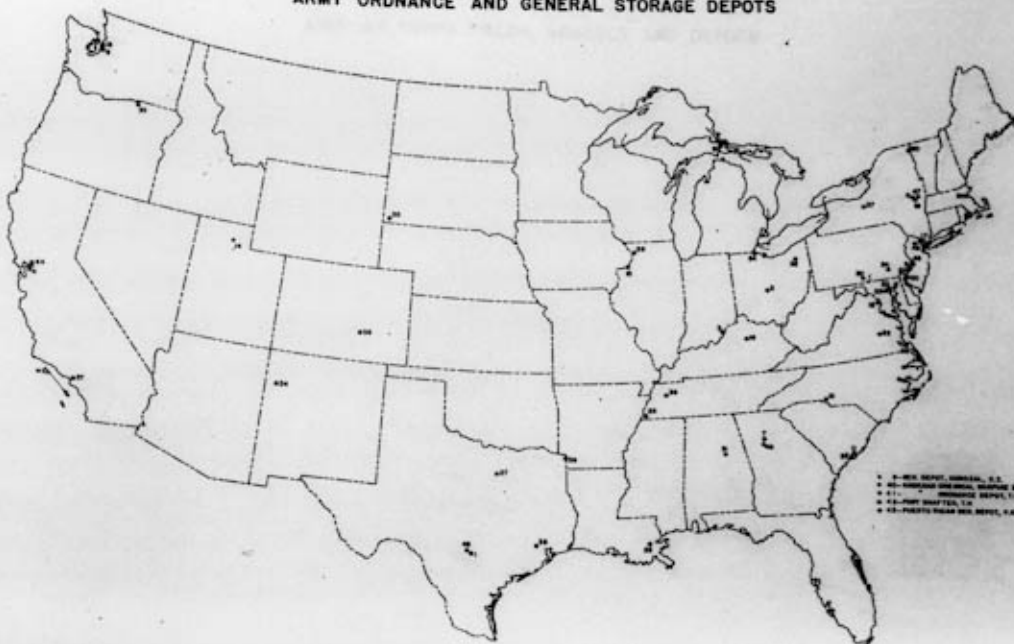

NAVY AIRPLANE MANUFACTURING FACILITIES



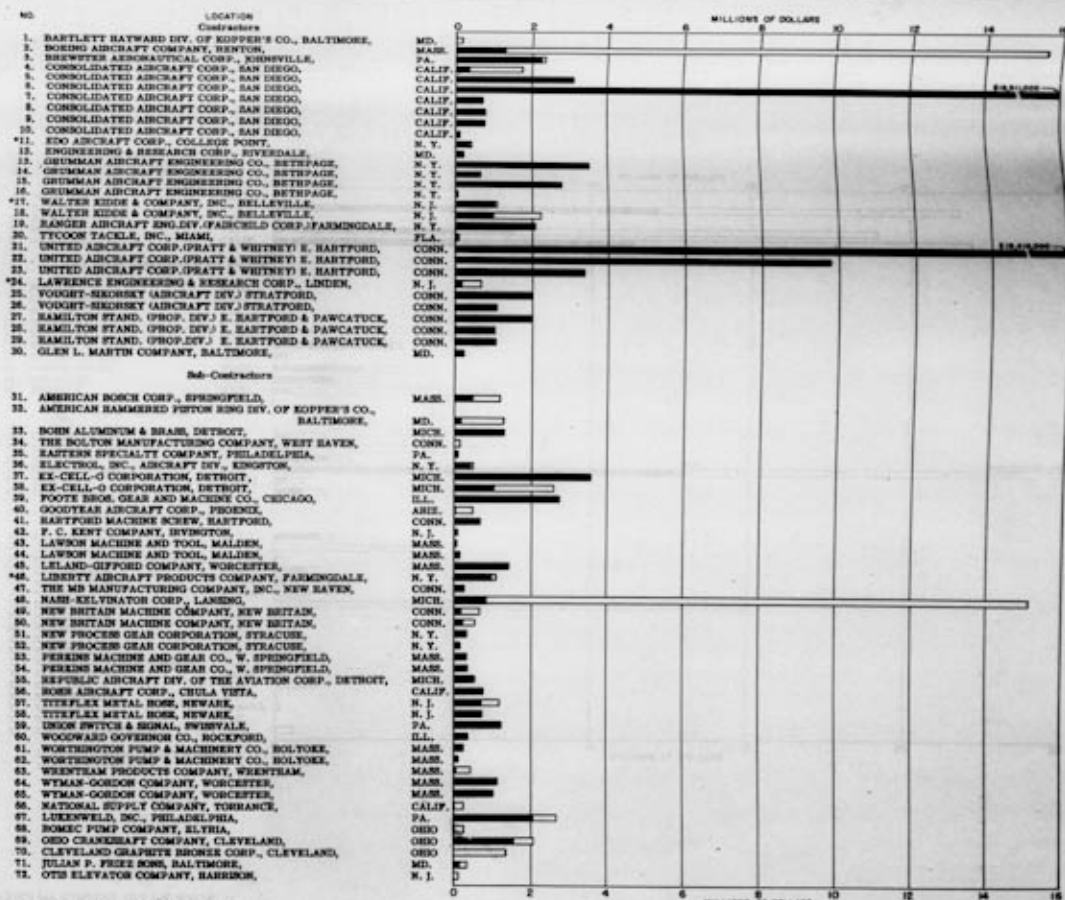

NAVY AIRPLANE MANUFACTURING FACILITIES

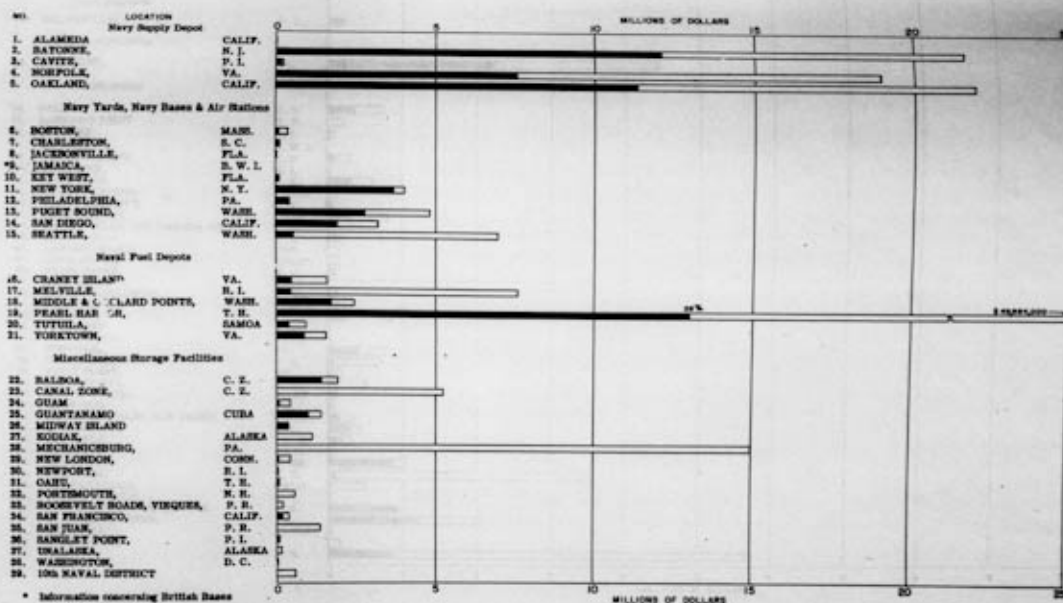

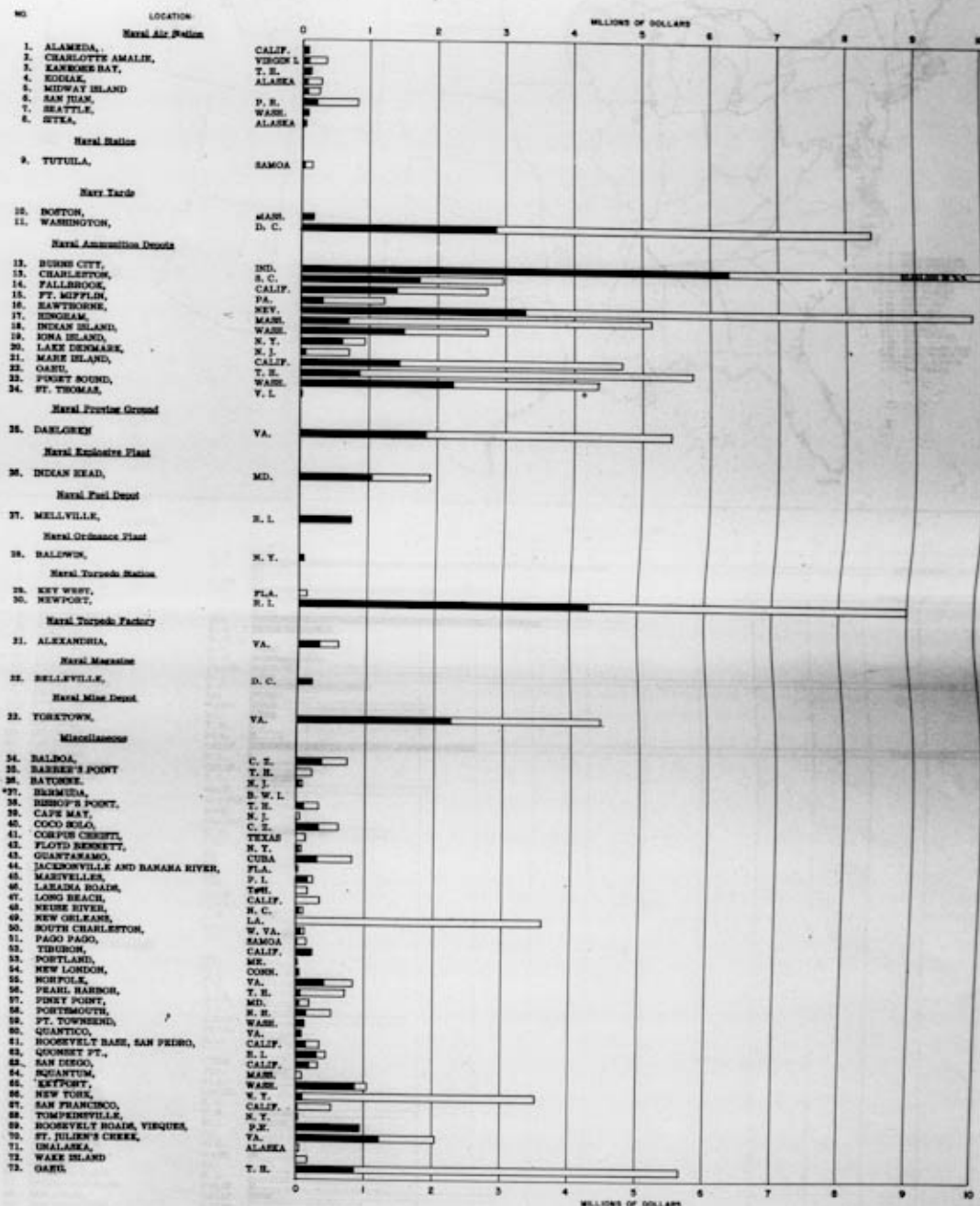

NAVAL STRUCTURES FOR PERSONNEL AND HOSPITALS

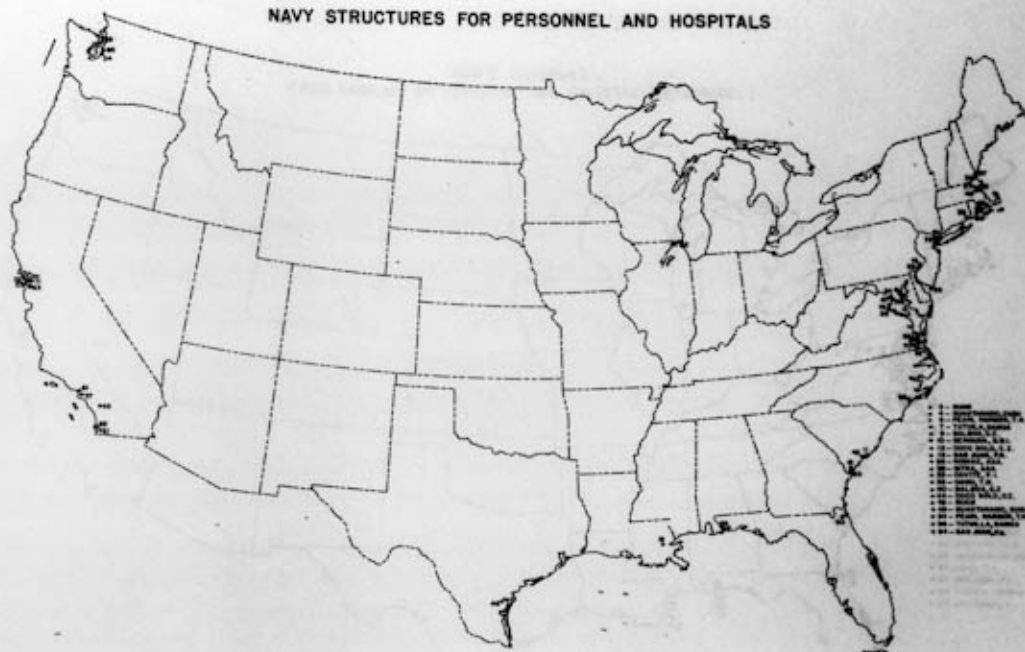

DEFENSE HOUSING FOR CIVILIANS (NAVY PLANTS)

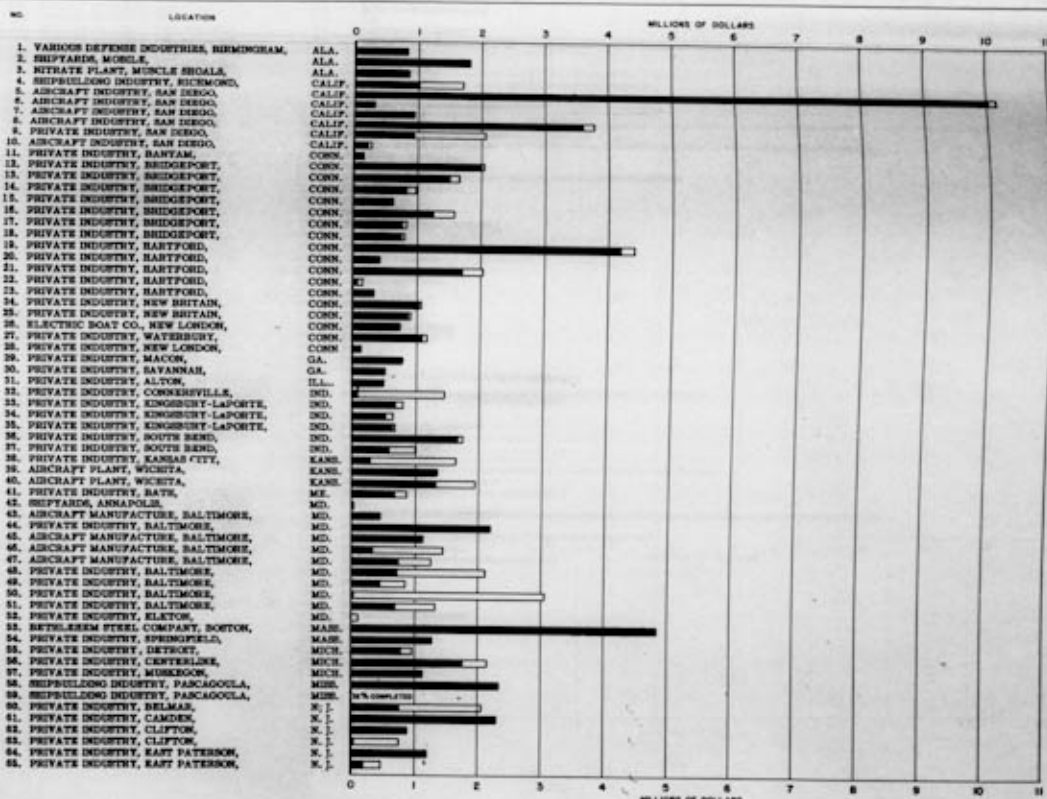

DEFENSE HOUSING FOR CIVILIANS (PRIVATE INDUSTRY)

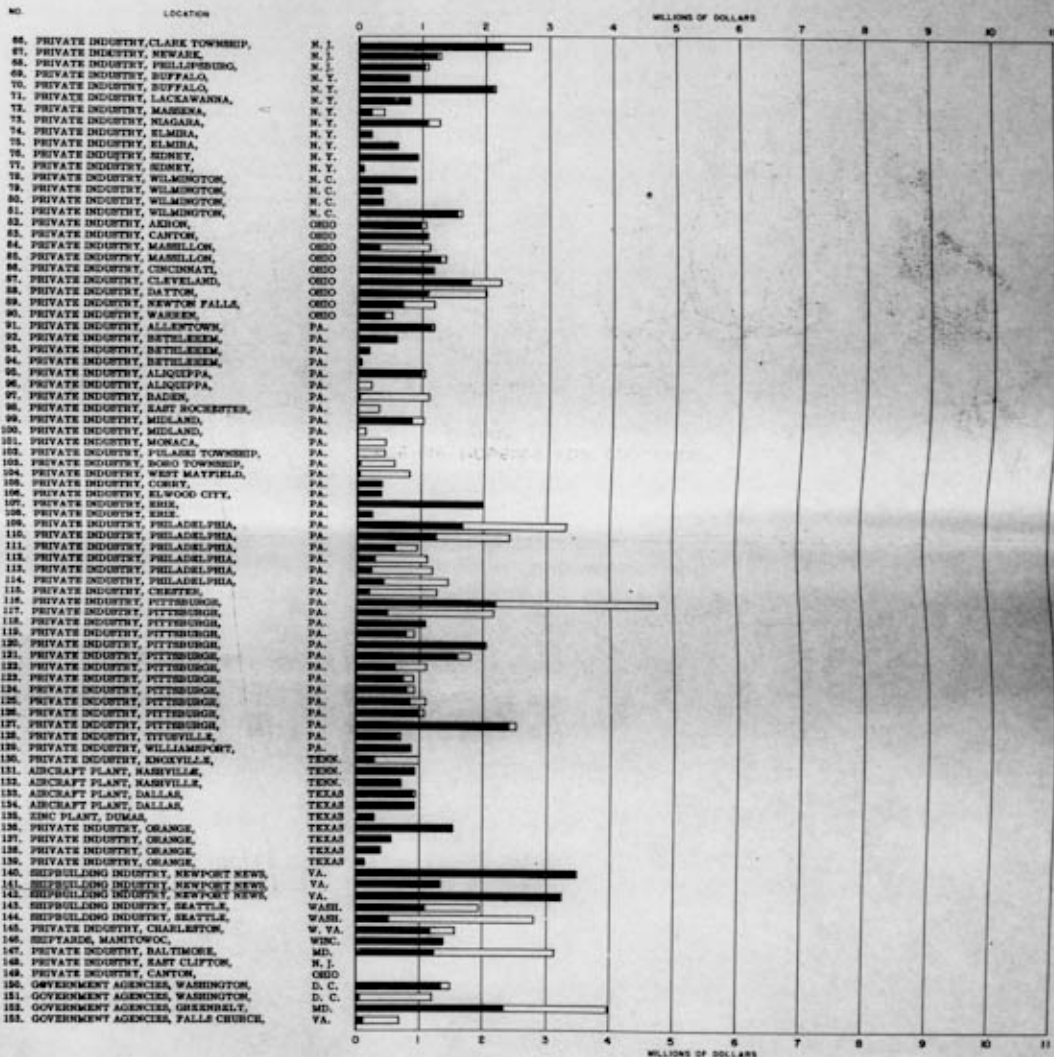
