United States Military Mission to Moscow for Deane for
action from Lee signed Eisenhower EX 19531 to American
Embassy Paris for information (by hand).

Geodetic group proposes to go into captured cities
to investigate museums, libraries, educational institutions,
government agencies, and so forth, for additional and/or
new map material and survey control urgently needed, partic-
ularly for work accomplished since the beginning of hostili-
ties. Typical places to be visited are "Deutsche Heeresbuecherei",
"Reichsamt Fuer Landesaufnahme", and so forth in Berlin;
"Saechsisches Landesvermessungsamt" Dresden, and so forth.
If sufficient copies of maps, material or survey control data
are available they will attempt to obtain copies. Otherwise
they will microfilm the material for record and immediate
transmission to our headquarters.

We are informed that the London Coal Committee
dispatched a cable to the Washington Coal Committee on 24
February paragraph 15 of which stated that they proposed
to send a technical mission consisting of mining and
transportation experts to the continent to confer with SHAEP
and Nationals in order to assist in the production and
movement of continental indigenous coal. While the
assistance of technical experts may be desired by SHAEP
from time to time it is considered that such a mission
could serve no useful purpose but would only complicate
an already delicate situation. It is accordingly desired that
such a mission be not dispatched.

In this connection reference is made to our FWD
16201 dated 29 September 1944.

TOPSEC book message to SHAEF Rheims for Eisenhower for action,
to AMSSC pass to British Chiefs of Staff for information, FACS
148 from the Combined Chiefs of Staff.

1. French Air Ministry have requested permission from Foreign Office and State Department to despatch a mission to United Kingdom and United States to survey field of aeronautical production with view to technical collaboration, purchase of equipment and obtaining of licences for manufacture of allied products in France.

2. French have been informed by State Department and Foreign Office that such a mission would be acceptable, but Combined Chiefs of Staff consider it essential that before mission is authorized to proceed agreement should be reached between U.S. and U.K. as to what extent items on secret list should be disclosed to French, and are urgently examining this problem.

3. Until you receive further instructions from Combined Chiefs of Staff you should therefore not permit departure of French Mission.

Supplementing my message Z 601, Marshal Voroshilov and
entire Russian staff were especially cordial to all American
officers and representatives attending Red Army celebration.

Also present were Prime Minister and his government
at Voroshilov's invitation as well as Major General Edgecombe,
head of British Military Representation, with several members
of his staff, and British minister designate, Mr Gasgoynes, who
arrived 23 February.

In conversation with Squires Prime Minister reported
sufficient progress at Budapest to justify the hope of accom-
modating the government and ACC there in about two weeks.
Voroshilov confirmed to me his tentative plan to transfer
commission to Budapest in two to three weeks.

In same conversation Prime Minister reported about
80,000 Hungarians to be held by Russia as prisoners of war.
Of these about 40,000 may be considered as possibly available
for Hungarian troops to be furnished under armistice terms.
So far about 10,000 have been released by Russia. Hungarian
government and Russia are negotiating for release of second
10,000. Consideration of releases beyond these groups is
apparently not yet in view. Attention invited to Squires radio
message number 2 this date.

(3) FURTHERMORE ALTHOUGH THERE WAS UNANIMOUS AGREEMENT THAT PRIORITY SHOULD BE AFFORDED AFTER OPERATIONAL SALVAGE

TO SALVAGE OF INTEREST TO THE WAR EFFORT GENERALLY AS DISTINCT FROM SCAEF'S IMMEDIATE EUROPEAN OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS. IT WAS AGREED THAT SCAEF HAS NO AUTHORITY TO BACK ANY PRIORITY EXCEPT TO MEET HIS OWN REQUIREMENTS.

(4) FOR THESE REASONS THE MEETING DECIDED THAT A CENTRAL

SHAEF COMMITTEE WAS NEITHER WORKABLE NOR DESIRABLE AND THAT A BODY CAPABLE OF MEETING YOUR REQUIREMENTS MUST BE

SITUATED ON LONDON WHERE CONSIDERATIONS OF THE ENTIRE WAR EFFORT COULD ALONE BE GIVEN DUE WEIGHT.

(5) IT WAS AGREED THAT INFORMATION AS TO BOTH WRECKS AND SALVAGE FACILITIES WAS LARGELY AVAILABLE ALREADY TO PSVO

AND THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT BUT THAT ADVISORY BOARDS IN EACH COUNTRY WERE ESSENTIAL FOR CONSIDERATION OF THIS INFORMATION

AND ENSURING ITS TRANSMISSION TO THE PROPOSED LONDON SALVAGE COMMITTEE. THESE BOARDS WOULD HAVE MWT/WSA NAVAL MILITARY

REPRESENTATION THE LATTER BEING PROVIDED PROBABLY BY THE SHAEF MISSIONS. THERE WOULD PRESUMABLY BE A FRENCH ADVISORY

BOARD IN PARIS AND BOARDS FOR BELGIUM, HOLLAND, AND OTHER NATIONS AS REQUIRED.

(6) AS REGARDS PRIORITIES OUR IDEA WAS THAT THE LONDON COMMITTEE SHOULD DETERMINE GENERAL POLICY AND MAKE SPECIFIC

RECOMMENDATIONS WHERE NECESSARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH INSTRUCTIONS OR GUIDANCE FROM THE COMBINED CHIEFS OF STAFF AND WITH INFORMATION

FROM THE NATIONAL ADVISORY BOARDS.

(7) WE CONSIDER THAT AN ORGANIZATION ON THESE LINES WOULD

PROVIDE THE BEST MEANS OF COORDINATION WITH THE MINIMUM DISTURBANCE OF EXISTING MACHINERY. IN ADDITION IT WOULD AFFORD

THE SIMPLEST BASIS FOR AN EVENTUAL CHANGE OVER TO POST SHAEF OPERATIONS.

To AGWAR. [REDACTED] CRICKET 33. In response to radio S 76892 SCAF 189 dated 28th January to AGWAR pass to Eisenhower for action, to AMSSO for British Chiefs of Staff and to Navy for information from the Combined Military Transportation Committee.

Relative to Combined Shipping Control Board, this board was intended to supplement the United States Shipping Control Board already formed by your theater and not to supplant it.

It is believed that the authority might well be given to the present CAO organization in your theater which now embraces all parties in interest to act on shipping matters on a combined basis and such an arrangement would meet in full the proposal contained in wire of the Combined Chiefs of Staff to you on this subject.

Advise if this will be satisfactory.

Execution of instructions to Rumanian Government
was witnessed today by my executive officer.

Observation of first entrainment was partially
restricted by Russian sentries but following was ascertained.

Loading of about 20 box cars was started at 0730 this
morning. Deportees were loaded directly from trucks into
boxcars. Between 40 and 50 persons of mixed sexes were put
in each car. Immediately upon filling each car was closed,
locked and sealed. Wooden benches, stoves and some ventil-
ation were provided. No water nor latrine facilities.

Deportees were of age ranges specified and appeared
to be of poor classes without exception.

Trucks and railyard heavily guarded. Deportations
supervised by Russian General. Much confusion and distress
at station. Many appeals for intercession were made to

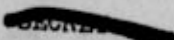
