Following from Chief's of Staff for General Wilson and Commanders-in-Chief Middle East. Following is text of Directive issued to Air Marshall Slessor. This has been agreed by General Eaker.

2. Request Algiers pass copy to Mr. Macmillan and Mideast pass copy to office of Resident Minister Cairo.

BEGINS

Directive to the British Deputy Air Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean Allied Air Forces

1. You have been appointed British Deputy Air Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean Allied Air Forces, in which capacity you will exercise such responsibility as may be delegated to you by the Air Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean Allied Air Forces.

2. You are also appointed Commander of the Royal Air Force in the Mediterranean Theater, and the Middle East command of the Royal Air Force, as at present constituted. For all Royal Air Force operations in the area of responsibility of the Allied Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean Theater, as defined in C.C.S. 387/3, you will be responsible to the Air Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean Allied Air Force. As regards the Middle East Command you will delegate the responsibility for air operations for the security of the Middle East base to the A.O.C.-in-C. Middle East, who will correspond direct on these matters with the British Chiefs of Staff, keeping you fully informed.

3. The units of the Middle East Command engaged in general reconnaissance and convoy escort duty in the Indian Ocean will be operated by the Air Commander-in-Chief, South East Asia, through the A.O.C. No. 222 Group.

4. You will be responsible to the Air Ministry for the organization and administration of all Royal Air Force formations under your Command. In this respect, Royal Air Force Middle East should be given the greatest measure of self-administration which you consider advisable.

5. The status of No. 216 Transport Group in relation to Mediterranean Allied Air Forces is defined in a memorandum forwarded to H.Q. Mediterranean Allied Air Forces under cover of Air Council Letter S.96570/S7 dated December 15. A copy the memorandum is attached.

6. The Royal Air Force in the South East Asia Command as well as in the Mediterranean and Middle East depends largely upon the onus in the Middle East for the supply of crew. You will be responsible to the Air Ministry for maintaining the efficiency of the operational training units and ensuring that they provide the necessary flow of aircrews. ENDS.

Plans for Commando Organization have progressed sufficiently so that the (2 #1) unit should be organized immediately. Attention operations Division. After consultation with Eisenhower, Clark and Truscott request following plan be presented to Chief of Staff: an American Commando Training and Demonstration unit to be immediately organized by this Headquarters of approximately 35 Officers and 450 enlisted men along lines of the existing British Organization. Purpose of the unit will be to train groupments from Divisions already here together with limited number of Commissioned and enlisted instructors to be returned to the United States for initiating similar training there. The unit will secure initial allotment of personnel from divisions now here and will thereafter transfer back to those divisions the bulk of this personnel to be replaced by new men. The normal training course will include actual participation in operations to maximum extent. The plans also including project for training and employing complete subordinate units of divisions reaching this country. Time is of the utmost importance. Consequently request that commanding General USEFBI be authorized to create immediately grades and ratings and activate unit of approximate size indicated, exact details to be reported to the War Department upon the completion of the organization.

In this connection, General Clark requests that the commanding General Army Ground Forces be directed to send Great Britain at earliest practicable date 18 officers and 60 noncommissioned Officers to be attached to the initial

Plan for reorganization Brit Arm and Inf Divs our 2272 has been officially approved your 1417. Project divided into 3 phases of which 1st (promulgated 12th May) calls for conversion 5 existing Arm Divs and 5 existing Inf Divs from old type to new type. Present estimate is that this phase will be completed by end of June.

Date of promulgation 2nd phase will be determined later but present expectation is that it will follow 1st phase quickly in which case 2nd phase may be completed by end of September according to present most optimistic estimate. This phase involves creation 3 new type Arm Divs and conversion 5 more existing Inf Divs from old type to new type.

3rd phase will be clean up phase for which no repeat no specific goal has yet been set. It will be promulgated only after thorough stock has been taken of strength which remains and situation which exists after completion of 2nd phase.

In order to accomplish 1st 2 phases (resulting in 8 Arm and 10 Inf Divs all of new type) it will be necessary to convert 2 existing Arm Brigs (only partially trained) and 1 existing Inf Brig AntiTank Brigs.

Tank Brigs of Inf Divs will be equipped with Inf tanks. Enough Churchills exist to meet 1st phase and enough now in sight for 2nd phase. Impracticable now to make estimate with respect to 3rd phase.

Attention invited to fact that our report 47,123 amplified and somewhat modified our report 47,097.
