STATE DISTRIBUTION OF DEFENSE CONTRACT AWARDS

JUNE 1, 1940 TO MAY 31, 1941

During this period, contracts worth \$11,000 million in value were awarded by the War and Navy Departments. This is the total of public knowledge of which individual reports have been received according to the Federal Reserve, and services and including all contracts involving less than \$10,000. In addition, a total of \$7,470 million has been issued in the form of project orders and drawings to Army and Navy establishments. Since in large part these project order facts are subsequently carried as prime contracts by such establishments and included in this tabulation, project orders themselves have been omitted from the tabulation.

In the following table the category "Airplanes, Engines, and Equipment" includes airplanes, engines, spare parts, aircraft, and such items as personnel, flying helmets, and special clothing for air personnel. Airplane equipment is included. "Ship Construction and Equipment" includes not only the hull and machinery, but also the outfitting and parts used in construction.

Contracts were assigned to the States on the basis of location of the work. Whenever it was not possible to determine the State in which the work was to be performed, or when a contract could not be assigned to a specific plant of a company, or when more than one plant, the amount of the award was included in the "Unassigned" group presented at the end of the table.

It should be noted that as compared with the tabulation through April the data reflect not only the signing of new contracts but also the reassignment of contracts to other plants or companies and the modification and cancellation of previous awards.

STATE DISTRIBUTION OF DEFENSE CONTRACT AWARDS

In the year ending May 31, 1941 prime contracts aggregating \$11,956 million in value were awarded by the War and Navy Departments. This is the total of public-knowledge awards on which individual reports have been received excluding awards for fuels, foodstuffs, and services and excluding all contracts involving less than \$10,000. In addition, a total of \$2,472 million has been issued in the form of project orders and directives to Army and Navy establishments. Since in large part these project order funds are subsequently awarded as prime contracts by such establishments and included in this tabulation, the project orders themselves have been omitted from the tabulation.

In the following table the category "Airplanes, Engines, Parts and Equipment" includes airplanes, engines, spare parts, equipment, and such items as parachutes, flying helmets, and special clothing for air personnel. Airplane armament is excluded. "Ship Construction and Equipment" includes not only hulls and machinery, but also raw materials and parts used in ship construction.

Contracts have been assigned to the States on the basis of location of the producing plants. Whenever it was not possible to determine the site at which the work was to be performed, or when a contract could not be assigned to a specific plant of a company which has more than one plant, the amount of the award was included in the "Unassignable" group presented at the end of the table.

It should be noted that as compared with the tabulation through April the data reflect not only the awarding of new contracts but also the reassignment of contracts to other plants or companies and the modification and cancellation of previous awards.

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STATE DISTRIBUTION OF DEFENSE CONTRACT AWARDS

JUNE 1, 1940 TO JUNE 30, 1941

The following table shows the distribution of defense contracts awarded to the War and Navy Departments. This is the total of all contracts awarded in which individual persons have been named as contractors. A total of \$7,595 million was awarded in the form of project orders and allocations to War and Navy establishments. Since in large part these contracts were made not subsequently awarded as prime contracts by such establishments and included in this tabulation, the project orders themselves have been omitted from the tabulation.

In the following table the category "Aircraft, Engines, Parts and Equipment" includes: airplanes, engines, spare parts, equipment, and such items as parts, tools, building fixtures, and special machines for air production. "Aircraft, Engines" is separate. "Aircraft, Engines and Equipment" includes: airplanes, engines, tools and equipment, and such materials and parts used in ship building.

When assigned to the States on the basis of the preceding table, whenever it was necessary to determine the site at which the work was done, or when a contract could not be assigned to a plant of a company which has more than one plant, the amount of the award was included in the "Other" category presented at the end of the table.

This tabulation includes awards under the Defense and War Production Acts, and of the awards made in recent years were not reported in these for inclusion in this tabulation. This during June the Office of Production Management approved for award about \$4.5 billion of War and Navy prime contract proposals, including Defense and War contracts under the jurisdiction of the War and Navy Departments. Awards data for the state distribution show an increase of only \$1.5 million.

STATE DISTRIBUTION OF DEFENSE CONTRACT AWARDS

Between June 1, 1940 and June 30, 1941 prime contracts aggregating \$13,083 million in value were awarded by the War and Navy Departments. This is the total of public-knowledge awards on which individual reports have been received excluding contracts involving less than \$10,000. In addition, a total of \$2,892 million has been issued in the form of project orders and directives to Army and Navy establishments. Since in large part these project order funds are subsequently awarded as prime contracts by such establishments and included in this tabulation, the project orders themselves have been omitted from the tabulation.

In the following table the category "Airplanes, Engines, Parts and Equipment" includes airplanes, engines, spare parts, equipment, and such items as parachutes, flying helmets, and special clothing for air personnel. Airplane armament is excluded. "Ship Construction and Equipment" includes not only hulls and machinery, but also raw materials and parts used in ship construction.

Contracts have been assigned to the States on the basis of location of the producing plants. Whenever it was not possible to determine the site at which the work was to be performed, or when a contract could not be assigned to a specific plant of a company which has more than one plant, the amount of the award was included in the "Unassignable" group presented at the end of the table.

This tabulation excludes awards under the Defense Aid program. Moreover, many of the awards made in recent weeks were not reported in time for inclusion in this tabulation. Thus during June the Office of Production Management approved for award about \$4.6 billion of War and Navy prime contract proposals, including Defense Aid awards under the jurisdiction of the War and Navy Departments, whereas data for the state distribution show an increase of only \$1.1 billion.

1/ About \$140 million of this increase results from the inclusion in the series of the data on awards for fuels, foodstuffs, and services since June 1, 1940.

STATE DISTRIBUTION OF DEFENSE CONTRACT AWARDS

The first of the following tables shows for each government agency the distribution by States of \$24½ billion in Federal defense contracts and allocations which were reported for the period June 1, 1940 through September 30, 1941.

The second table presents a breakdown by States of major War and Navy Department prime contracts showing three categories of supply contracts and the total of facility projects. The total value shown in this table, \$22,212 million, represents the total amount of individual War and Navy contracts (including their defense aid awards and Defense Plant Corporation commitments) reported to the Office of Production Management through September 1941. Awards having a value of less than \$50,000 and all awards for foodstuffs are excluded.

In addition to the amounts shown, a total of \$2,912 million has been issued in the form of manufacturing project orders to Army and Navy establishments. Inasmuch as a large part of these project orders are subsequently awarded as prime contracts by such establishments and included in this tabulation, the project orders themselves have been omitted from the tabulation.

Available over-all reports indicate for the War and Navy Departments, including their Defense Aid funds, a total of about \$31 billion of contract funds obligated through September 1941. A number of factors account for the difference between this figure and the \$22 billion total in the following State tabulation. Most important is the lag between obligation of funds and the award of contracts, and the further lag between award of contracts and reporting of the information on individual contracts. Secondly, project orders are included in the \$31 billion but only the prime contracts awarded from project order funds are in the \$22 billion. Also, contracts having a value of less than \$50,000 aggregate a substantial sum. On the other hand, only a part of the Defense Plant Corporation funds that are included in the \$22 billion are also included in the \$31 billion.

The definitions for the distribution of supply contracts by object differ somewhat from those previously used in this tabulation. The category "Aircraft" includes contracts for airframes; airplane engines, propellers, and other parts; and certain related equipment such as parachutes and aircraft pontoons. Armament, instruments, and communication equipment are excluded. The category "Ships" includes contracts for the construction of new vessels of all kinds; the purchase of used ships; and ship conversion, recommissioning, and repair. Propulsion machinery (when separately contracted for), armor, armament, navigation and radio equipment, parts, and materials are excluded.

Contracts have been assigned to the States on the basis of location of the producing plants. Whenever it was not possible to determine the site at which the work was to be performed, or when a contract could not be assigned to a specific plant of a company which has more than one plant, the amount of the award was included in the "Unassigned" group presented at the end of the table.

The category "Facilities" represents the latest estimate of final cost of each construction project for which a contract has been awarded or a letter of intent or project order issued, and is based on reports received through September 1941. Costs such as land purchase, architectural and engineering fees, construction materials, construction work, and manufacturing and maintenance machinery and equipment are included, with the entire estimated value assigned to the project site. New industrial facilities financed by the War and Navy Departments and Defense Plant Corporation commitments for plant expansion are included. Practically all of the latter facilities are sponsored by the War or Navy Departments.
