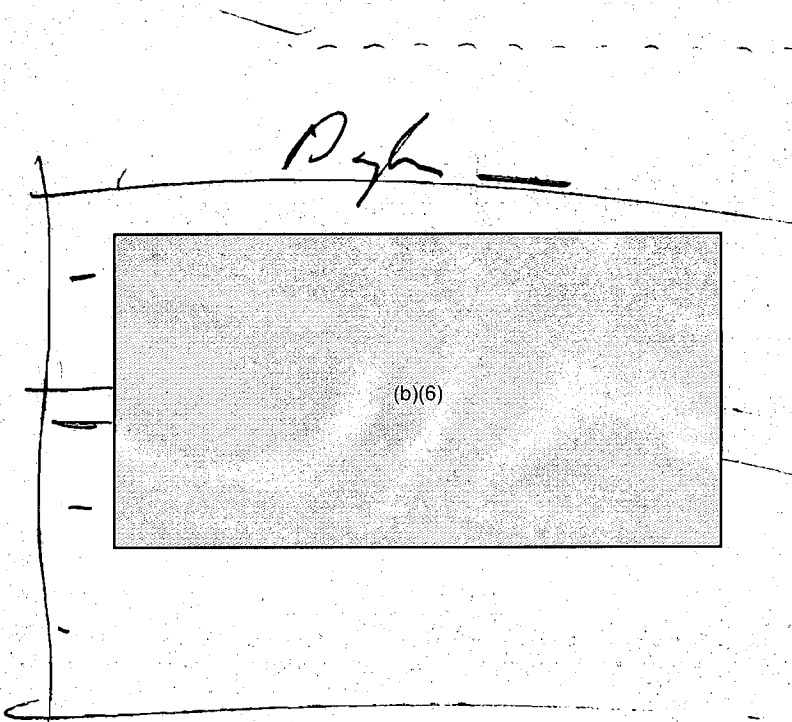

Re transporting British press by helos, Tom Gould, Mil Aide, has researched this with HMX and found that at least in the last 6-8 years this has not been done. HMX is still attempting to research records even further back, but it will take a few days, even if records can be found.

Info from Cathy Fenton, Social Office: She has been in touch with Camp David Commander, Mike Girogine, re the recon of Camp David on Tuesday. Cathy has arranged for a van Tuesday morning, departing from East Executive Avenue at 9:45 a.m., with a 11:15 a.m. arrival at Camp David. Upon arrival Commander Girogine will give a 40 minute tour of the facilities, then everyone will gather in one of the cabins to discuss the visit. Lunch (sandwiches, etc) will be provided.
