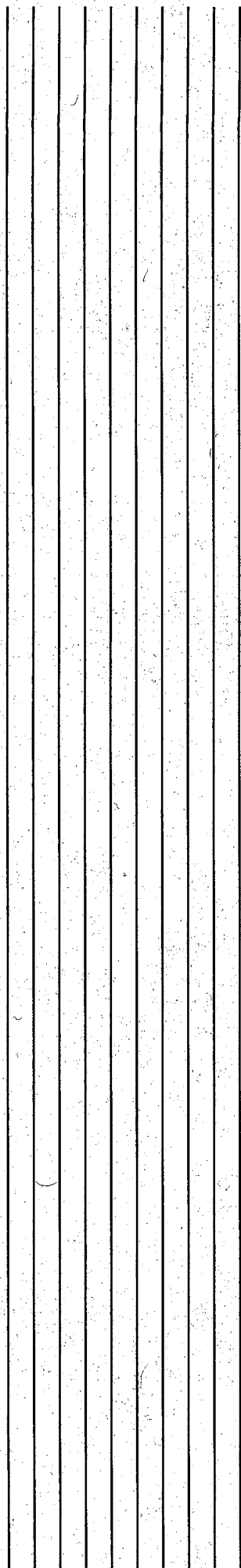

Theme: Visit the Studio of Sesame Street India (*Gali Gali Sim Sim*) and Participate in an Episode

Purpose:

1. To participate in a pre-school educational milestone for India – the broadcast of Sesame Street India, *Gali Gali Sim Sim*, to India's broad viewing public. It is suggested that Mrs. Bush film a segment of an episode with Indian muppet characters and actors (to be confirmed with producers).
2. To learn how a public-private partnership of U.S. and Indian investors supported the Indian version of the educational media program. USAID was a prime player in helping Sesame Street Workshop enter the Indian broadcast market. Production is expected to begin in February and first airing expected in late Spring.

Background: With USAID India support *Gali Gali Sim Sim* is being introduced to India. Through a partnership with Sesame Street Workshop, USAID helped the program enter the local television market and develop high quality, country-appropriate educational content. The objective is to provide an educational program that will give a head start to Indian children ages 3-6 on basic skills to prepare them for school. This increases chances for success and retention in school, and builds productivity in a country with one of the largest populations of young children in the world. Using a broadcast medium, it will connect underserved and hard-to-reach children in urban and rural settings with basic educational skills.

A "spin-off" of the beloved, American "Sesame Street" format and approach is carried out through the help of specially designed characters and Muppets that reflect India's cultural and educational needs. Storylines encompass Indian topics, issues and cultural mores. *Gali Gali Sim Sim* will prompt children to be active learners by focusing on fundamentals such as literacy and numeracy, emphasizing critical thinking, and instilling a love of learning. It will celebrate the child by presenting youngsters from diverse backgrounds with positive images and stories. It will emphasize the abilities of girls to promote their literacy and encourage their school attendance. (Note: There are no formal pre-school education programs under the Indian Ministry of Education. Literacy rates in

India are 76 percent for males compared to 54 percent for females, per the 2001 All India Census data.)

Description of the event:

(To be confirmed) Upon arrival, the First Lady will be introduced to senior producers and be given a tour of the studio – meeting Indian muppet characters, seeing the sound stage and meeting characters/actors briefly. This will be followed by the filming of the episode (of a pre-approved script). A select group of pre-schoolers will be invited to view the filming. After filming is complete, light refreshments will be served and Mrs. Bush will have a brief question-and-answer period with the children about the lesson of the piece, or to share her thoughts.

Dignitaries invited to the studio will be determined.
