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President's Opening Statement
Press Conference with Prime Minister Blair
February 24, 2001

It has been a real pleasure for Laura and me to spend time with Prime Minister Blair and his wife Cherie [sha-REE]. And it has been a great honor to have them as our first foreign guests here at Camp David.

The first foreign leader ever to visit Camp David was Winston Churchill, in May 1943. Overall, seven different American Presidents have hosted six different British Prime Ministers at Camp David. This reflects the close and unique bond that exists between our countries and our peoples. And it is because of this bond that we decided to meet early on in my Administration, in a personal setting, to discuss the important issues facing our nations.

The special bond between our nations is rooted in our common language, common history, and common values. But above all, it is rooted in our common interests. Our discussions here have spanned the full-range of these interests. And they have been infused with the warmth and affection, trust and candor that are hallmarks of this very special relationship.

The most important result of our talks is a reaffirmation by both our governments that NATO will remain the cornerstone of Transatlantic and European security -- and that we must strengthen our alliance to build a Europe that is whole, free and secure. We also discussed our support for European efforts to assume a greater responsibility for European security and how important it is that these efforts be closely coordinated with NATO.

We talked about our commitment to promoting peace and stability in the Balkans. And we agreed to work with our allies and partners so that peace there relies less on outside military forces, and more on local institutions and civil authorities.

Both our nations will also work closely to meet the growing threat of weapons of mass destruction and the missiles that can deliver them. We need a strategy that strengthens our efforts to prevent the spread of these weapons -- and one that deters and defends against their use. And we will consult early and often, together with our NATO allies, on this critical topic.

Our two nations also underscore our determination to stand firm against the threat posed by Saddam Hussein, even as we seek to ease the plight of those who suffer as a result of his brutal regime.

Finally, the Prime Minister and I talked about how important it was for our two nations to work closely to deepen the trade and economic ties that are so vital to prosperity on both sides of the Atlantic.

Today, the United States and the United Kingdom reaffirm our common reading of history: that each of our nations stands taller when we stand together. Our nations helped to write the history of the last century. We defeated two mortal threats to civilization: Nazism and Soviet Communism. A decade ago we joined forces to defeat Iraq. These were extraordinary accomplishments.

At the dawn of this new century, we face new threats and new challenges. And so we must rely on old friendships. Our task is to retain what Churchill called an "alert and vigilant frame of mind" and join together to do what we have always done: build a world that is more free, more peaceful, and more just. In that great task, the United States will continue to find no better friend and ally than the United Kingdom.
