President's Message

NCNC members and their dogs were very active and successful during the past month. (Show results are listed elsewhere in the Newfs Paper.) Of note: Dexter (Joyce Taylor) won multiple Best of Breed awards, Group 1 and Group 3 awards, and a RBIS. Georgia (O'Brien & O'Donoghue) won two Best of Breed awards and a Group 4. Congratulations to all!

As discussed before, NCA expressed interest in having a west coast National Specialty. Membership in both NCNC and the Seattle Newf Clubs voted to join forces to submit a proposal to host the **2017 NCA National Specialty** with co-chairs Kevin Gallagher (NCNC) and Chris Lyden (Seattle). At the National Specialty in Warwick, Rhode Island, the NCA Board approved this joint effort. Two potential sites were identified. I'm now told that the site near Mount Hood in Oregon is no longer available because the property was recently sold and the new owners are not interested in hosting dog shows. The Double Tree hotel in Rohnert Park (site of the 1998 National Specialty hosted by NCNC) is still interested. I visited the Double Tree with Kevin -- the hotel is very nice and the outside areas for rings and tentage are essentially the same as in 1998. The area which was used for RVs is no longer available, so Kevin and Chris are checking on other possible nearby RV sites. They are also working with the Double Tree on

Water work season is upon us. **Water training sessions** are ongoing at Folsom Lake (contact Cathy Sayre or Carol Chew) and at Lake Del Valle (contact John Pearson or Lori Littleford). If you are interested in participating, please contact the persons listed for details and schedules. The **water training seminar** at Folsom Lake was very successful with a large participation of both new dogs and those preparing for the July 18-19 **NCNC early water tests** at Folsom Lake. (See the NCNC website for information.) The **Fall NCNC water test** is scheduled at Lake Del Valle for September 12-13. Currently, the water level at Del Valle is excellent for training, and hopefully the water level will remain good through the scheduled test dates like last year.

The next **NCNC meeting** will be held August 8 at the home of Hazel Jacoby in Castro Valley. On the agenda, we will discuss the **2016 Regional Specialty**, including show chair positions and judges (conformation and obedience). We will also have an update on the 2017 National Specialty effort and other important club business. So, come prepared to participate.

We have lots of activities planned for you and your dogs. As always, check the calendar section of the News Paper or the NCNC website for more details. I hope to see you there!

Committee Roles and Responsibilities – continued

The next "Role and Responsibilities" defined by the Board include: Dog Show related committees.

The definitions used for this document are:

"Role" - A set of activities or job functions. Not necessarily a single person – one person may have several "roles", one "role" may be supported by several people. For example, the secretary of a water test and the chief steward of a draft test may be the same person. The steward role at a draft test has multiple people assigned.

"Responsibility" - An outcome to be achieved by a "role". This does not mean that the person(s) assigned to the role must complete the task(s) for the responsibility, only that they must ensure it is completed.

We hope you will see something of interest and volunteer to help out! You do not need to be a Chair, but if you would like to help with one or more responsibilities you can contact the appropriate Chair to volunteer.

Role: Supported Entry
