## **President's Message**

NCNC members and their dogs were very active and successful during the past month. (Show results are listed elsewhere in the Newfs Paper.) Of note: Dexter (Joyce Taylor) won multiple Best of Breed awards and two Group 3 awards. Rocky (Kennard & Rubio) and Aspen (Rubio & Lange) finished their championships. Congratulations to all!

The **club picnic** was big success thanks to event chairs Elisa & John Morozumi and their helpers. We had a very large turnout of members and friends, including a large number of rescue dogs who were recognized individually in a large rescue ceremony. Then, Lori Littleford set up a rally course in one ring, and a second ring had various games for people and their dogs. The food was plentiful and delicious. Everyone seemed to have a great time.

As discussed before, NCA expressed interest in having a west coast National Specialty. At the April club meeting, after much discussion, the NCNC Board and membership voted to join the Seattle club to host the **2017 NCA National Specialty** with co-chairs Kevin Gallagher (NCNC) and Chris Lyden (Seattle). The specific site is not yet firm. Two potential sites were discussed, the Double Tree hotel in Rohnert Park (site of the 1998 National Specialty) and a Hood River site about 45 minutes from Portland, Oregon. At the National Specialty in Warwick,

Rhode Island, the NCA Board approved this effort. NCNC has hosted four previous National Specialties: Sacramento (1980), Santa Rosa (1991), Rohnert Park (1998) and Monterey (2006). The 2017 Specialty will be the 50 year anniversary of the first independent NCA National Specialty in 1967.

Water work season is upon us. **Water training sessions** have started at Folsom Lake (contact Cathy Sayre or Carol Chew) and at Lake Del Valle (contact John Pearson or Lori Littleford). If you are interested in participating, please contact the persons listed for details and schedules. Also, a **water training seminar** is scheduled for May 30 at Folsom Lake, followed on July 18-19 by the **NCNC early water tests** at Folsom Lake. (See the NCNC website for information.)

The next **NCNC meeting** will be held August 8 at the home of Hazel Jacoby in Castro Valley. On the agenda, we will discuss the **2016 Regional Specialty**, including show chair positions and judges (conformation and obedience). We will also have an update on the 2017 National Specialty. So, if you want a say in these matters come prepared to discuss and make your preferences known!

We have lots of activities planned for you and your dogs. As always, check the calendar section of the Newfs Paper or the NCNC website for more details. I hope to see you there!

## Committee Roles and Responsibilities – continued

The next "Role and Responsibilities" defined by the Board include: Web and Facebook committees.

The definitions used for this document are:

For example, the secretary of a water test and the chief steward of a draft test may be the same person. The steward role at a draft test has multiple people assigned.
