### **NCNC DRAFT TEST AND ADVANCED DRAFT TEST**

November 12, 2017, Lagoon Valley Park, Vacaville, CA

Once again we met at Lagoon Valley Park for our fall draft tests. Because the course builder Steve Brown had preplanned the course and painted all the required lines on the ground the day before, set up was a snap and all was ready for an on-time start. Draft test judges Dawn Druge and Lanelle Warrick had a small entry of just three (no teams) but it was a big day for one of the entries. Jennifer Larsen and Tess had a flawless performance earning Tess's DD title. All three DD entries were clearly well prepared for the test. Mackenzie failed just the 90° right turn but otherwise did very well. Crew did an awe-inspiring job on maneuvering, but could not resist two small dogs that passed by during the freight

haul. In a public park, other dogs are to be expected, of course. During the DDX test we even had a group of horses go by just past the end of the maneuvering course. Our experienced DDX dogs were not fazed, however.

Thanks again to the pre-painted lines on the ground, the DDX course was set up and ready to go by the time the DD entries returned from the one-mile freight haul. It also helped that the DD and DDX maneuvering courses were nested so that several of the same obstacles were used for both tests. For instance, the same 90° turns were used; the inside barriers were simply moved out to change a 28" lane to an 18" lane.

There were five entries in the DDX test for judges Lanelle Warrick and John Pearson. All put in good performances. Jobs backed nicely out of the low narrows but then ran his cart into one of the barriers and moved it. He also had trouble with the driven figure 8. Malia had only been training for a few weeks but still did a very good job. She also had trouble with the figure 8. In addition her cart hit and moved one of the supports for the removable obstacle. Ramble had an off day failing the figure 8, moving stand (totally handler error) and weight exchange (took several steps forward during the exchange). But we had successes too! Page handled by Cherrie Brown put together the best performance of her life and earned her DDX. Jeter handled by Randy Robinson re-qualified for the fifth time. He had to work hard to pull off his figure 8, but Randy persevered and worked him through it. Note that I keep coming back to the figure 8. This exercise is truly difficult. Malia and Ramble both decided that since they knew the figure 8, they didn't need any input from their handlers. As a result they turned too close to the second post hitting and moving it.

As usual it takes a village to put on a draft test and this one almost didn't happen. Lori Littleford stepped in as test chair just two months before the event when the previous chair found she had other commitments. She put together a great group of helpers in a short period of time. Cherrie Brown was secretary, and Patti Sondgroth was third signer. Patti was also safety officer and prepared the judges' gifts. Steve Brown, John Pearson and Jerry Sayre set up the site. Kevin Gallagher was site coordinator and Laura was responsible for lunch and along with June Gibson the participants' gifts. Cathy Sayre provided the trophies. Hospitality for the judges was provided by Dawn Druge and Laura Gallagher. Cherrie arranged the pre-test dinner at Mary's Pizza Shack. Lori provided AM hospitality. Kathy Bracisco took photos of the event. John Pearson was chief steward, also a last minute replacement. Even at a small test it takes a crew of steward to keep things going. Thanks to stewards Lynne Baker, Dee Brilz, Steve Brown, Colleen Cahill, Laura Gallagher, Lori Littleford, John Pearson, Marylyn Rhodes, and Jerry Sayre everything moved along efficiently.

All donations to NH&R between November 1, 2017, and December 15, 2017, up to \$1,000, will be matched 50% by members of the NH&R Board.

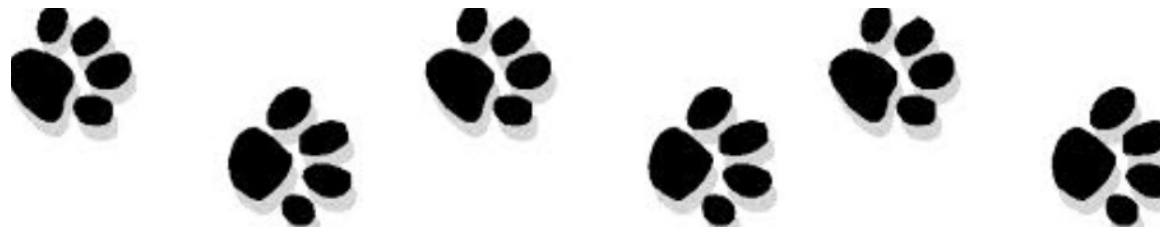

## NCNC Carting Seminar

The Newfoundland Club of Northern California - (NCNC) is happy to announce they will have a carting seminar in Walnut Creek on Saturday, January 13, 2018, weather permitting. (If weather becomes a problem, those folks registered will be contacted.)

Directions to the seminar site will be provided with registration confirmation.

The faculty will consist (at press time) of the usual group of NCNC draft and carting experts.

At this time the tentative list of subjects will include;

**Beginning Carting** - This class is for the beginner and covers, carts, harnesses and how to get your dog involved.

**Intermediate Carting** - This class is for graduates from the beginning class. It'll cover sharp turns, negotiating narrows, and teaching your dog to backup.

**Draft Test Preparation** - This class helps people train for a Newfy draft test but would probably be helpful for people going to other breed's draft tests.

Other subjects will be added depending upon the information received with your applications.

A delicious hot lunch is provided for pre-registered participants.

### Carting Seminar Signups

1. Fill out the registration form and send it to the person and address shown. Please do register ahead of time so we can plan accordingly & let you know if there are any schedule changes.
2. The \$30.00 fee is per handler. One handler can work as many dogs as they wish. Students without dogs will be charged \$10.00.
3. Please give us as much information as possible. The more we know about what you want to learn the better we can meet your needs.
4. Additional lunches for non-participants will be available for \$7.00 but we must know by at least four days prior to the seminar. (January 9, 2018)
5. We must receive pre-sign up applications 4 days prior to each seminar. This will give us time to send you a confirmation note and instructions on how to get to the site and to make sure we have enough instructors and helpers.

### Event Safety

1. Any dog who is aggressive will be requested to leave.
2. All participants including instructors and other helpers will be asked to sign the club's hold harmless agreement.
3. Handlers will be asked to either have their dogs on leash or in a crate except when they are actually working with the dog such as in the maneuvering course.
4. On freight hauls we will ask people to keep a minimum of 5 foot distance between dogs and when passing let the person ahead know that you are passing.

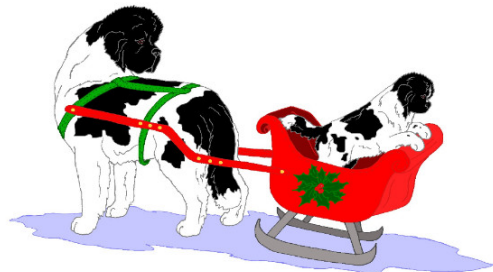
