The early **Summer Water Test** is scheduled at Folsom Lake on July 22-23, 2017. Hopefully the debris in the lake will be removed by then. Each day will have a WD/WRD test, and Saturday will also include WRDX. Again, check the website or the Newfs Paper for updates. Also, please contact Lynne Baker (Chair) if you want to help, or contact Dawn Druge (Chief Steward) if you are interested in stewarding.

So far, **water training** has been very limited due to the debris in Folsom Lake and worries about blue green algae at Lake Del Valle. (So far, toxins from the algae are reported to be very low at Del Valle and people have been allowed to swim. However, Park management has not given us approval for training sessions with the dogs.) For updated information on Folsom Lake training, contact Cathy Sayer. For updated information on Lake Del Valle training, contact John Pearson.
