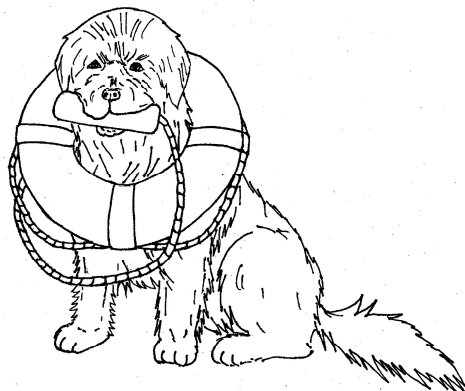

## **NCA Approved**

**Entry Opening and Closing Dates:** Entries open for NCA members on July 23, 2018 (if the dog is co-owned, then either all co-owners of the dog must be NCA members OR the handler must be an NCA member) and open for everyone on August 1, 2018. Entries of NCA members received after August 1st will not be given priority over those of non-NCA members. Entries post marked prior to July 23, 2018 for NCA members and August 1, 2018 for non-NCA members will not be accepted. Closing date for entries is August 22, 2018.

**Entry Limits:** Saturday's WRDX test will be limited to 5 (minimum 3) entries. The WD/WRD test on Saturday will be limited to a total of 20 unless the WRDX does not fill, in which case additional WD/WRD entries will be accepted up to a total of 25 (minimum 4) for all three divisions.

**Post entries and move-ups:** Dogs earning titles in junior division at each test may post-enter senior division on the same day and may move up to senior division on Sunday if they pass junior of Saturday. Dogs earning WRD titles on Saturday may NOT post enter the WRDX test.

**Re-qualifiers:** Re-qualifiers will be accepted as space allows and will be judged last in their class. Dogs may be entered in more than one division on the same day but only if they have already qualified at previous tests in all of the divisions entered. Re-qualifiers in junior division may not post-enter senior division. Check the appropriate boxes on the entry form for the classes entered. If the entry of the test exceeds its limit and a lottery is necessary, the dog may get into each division entered. There will be no substitutions for dogs to change divisions if their entry is chosen for one division but not for the other in a lottery. Judges must excuse any dog not in condition to finish the division entered and if so the dog will not be able to continue in any other division entered that day. Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are excused. Entrants are discouraged from pushing their dogs beyond their limits.

**Entry Fee: \$45.00** per entry \$30.00 for post-entries. For dogs with WRDs re-qualifying in both junior and senior divisions on the same day, the entry fee is \$75.00 each day. All fees are payable to the NEWFOUNDLAND CLUB OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA or NCNC.

**Required Forms:** Entries must be made on an official NCA entry form, and a copy of the entered dog's AKC,ILP/PAL, or foreign registration paper must be attached.

**Water Test Regulations:** These tests are conducted in accordance with the NCA Water Test Regulations effective January 1, 1999 and updated March 2018. Exhibitors are responsible for reading and understanding the current regulations in their entirety. Test Regulations are available at a cost of \$4.00 per copy from the NCA Working Dog Committee Publications Contact Dwight Gorsuch, at 6282 Burris Road, Rock Hall, MD 21661-1100. ## **Additional Information**

**Pre-Test Practice:** Participants may practice at the test site on Friday time TBD and after the conclusion of judging on September 8, 2018

**Test Site:** Folsom Lake in the Granite Bay area has a sloping shoreline with numerous coves. The bottom is granite covered by sand which provides clear water. Swimming depth will be within 20ft. of shore. There may be little or no shade close to the water. Some shade will be provided but exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own. **There is a \$12.00 park entry fee.**

**Directions to Test Site:** Exit I-80 at Douglas Blvd. in Roseville east of Sacramento and go south. Douglas Blvd., ends at the park entrance. Continue past the park entrance and stay on the same road for 2.5 miles. There will be a sign directing cars to the beach on the right.

**Where to Stay:** There are a number of motels in the area (Roseville and Folsom) that accept well behaved pets. RV sites may be available at Reserve America Beals Point State Park (916)791-1531

**Dinners:** A pretest dinner will be held Friday evening around 6:00pm site TBD.

**Morning Hospitality:** A continental breakfast will be provided for participants, stewards and judges the morning of the test

**Lunch:** All entrants will be provided lunch on the day they are tested at no charge. Additional lunches may be purchased for \$10/adult \$5/childs. Please indicate these on your entry form.

**Photographs:** Photographs will be available online after the test.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. I (we) agree that I (we) will uphold the AKC Code of Sportsmanship, the NCA Code of Ethics, and (if applicable) the NCA Judges Code of Ethics. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises or grounds and the employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss of the dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person or any other causes. ## Waiver of Rights ó Animals In Distress

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc, and the regional club hosting this event reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this dog event hereby waives any claim for damages against the Club for such removal. This NCA regards the health, safety and life of any dog on the event grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights. If the owner cannot be found in a timely manner, we will take whatever action is necessary for the safety of the dog, which may include breaking windows to enter a vehicle. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress, or in harmø way (for example, left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress, or harms way is considered mistreatment and subject to appropriate discipline.
