Introduction

On March 10, 2016, Global Attain Advancement, LLC (GAA) became a formal signatory of the United Nations Global Compact with a letter of commitment address to former secretary-general H.E Ban Ki-moon which marked GAA recognition and determination to accept a voluntary commitment to implement the 10 principles governing the compact's mission, in which GAA undertakes to present an annual communication on progress report describing the efforts made to carry out the Principles signed as part of GAA commitment, particularly on environment.

The SheTrades initiative provides women entrepreneurs around the world with a unique network and platform to connect to markets. Through the SheTrades app, women entrepreneurs are able to share information about their companies, increase visibility, expand networks, connect and internationalize. SheTrades, which aims to connect one million women entrepreneurs to market by 2020, also helps corporations to include more women entrepreneurs in their supply chains.



Women-owned businesses (WOBs) represent between one-quarter and one-third of enterprises in the world. However, most WOBs are found in less productive sectors, and are largely invisible in global value chains and in corporate and government supply chains. At Global Attain Advancement, we have committed to take 500 women to the market by 2020.
